Off the Top of My Head...

Several people have asked, so I will report that I had a nice, relaxing vacation and I hope you did too!

A few important odds and ends this weekend...

First, Bishop Doherty, in an October 1st memo to priests and deacons, affirmed that "...distributing and receiving Communion in the hand should continue to be the standard practice...not simply one option..."

He continues, "Our interests are not only for our own personal health, but so that we can minister in multiple parishes, visit our schools and religious education classes, and...minister in hospitals and nursing homes."

Eventually the option of receiving on the tongue will be restored, but in the meantime, for the sake of each other, the only option for receiving Communion will continue to be in the hand. Exceptions will be extremely rare.

Second: People have been asking about adult faith formation opportunities, and I'm happy to report that we will be offering three such opportunities in the next few months. In October or November, I'll be presenting a couple of sessions on the Gospel of Luke, which will be proclaimed during the upcoming year of worship (beginning on November 28). In December, Fr. Marty will present two sessions on the Sunday readings during the Advent Season. And in January, Fr. Dave will be presenting a brief series on Catholic Identity. Obviously, more details are needed and they will be available soon.

Unfortunately, these sessions will be available in English only. I know that adult faith formation for the Hispanic community is an essential priority as well, and we won't be ignoring that priority!

Finally, I want to mention a pastorate-wide survey that we are inviting all parishioners (of St. Mary's, Alexandria; St. Mary's, Anderson; and St. Ambrose) to complete.

As part of the diocesan Uniting in Heart pastoral planning process, our pastorate will be creating a three-year Pastoral Vision Plan, and part of that process includes gathering feedback from as many parishioners as possible regarding many areas of parish life. To that end, we will make the survey available – through the parish website, by email, at Masses, in the parish offices, and in other ways that we are still developing. The survey process will begin next weekend, October 16-17 and will close on November 3. The survey will be in both Spanish and English and will take about 15 minutes to complete. Your feedback matters!

Pensamiento del Padre Tom...

Varias personas me han preguntado, así que les informaré que tuve unas vacaciones agradables y relajantes y espero que ustedes también las hayan tenido.

Algunos puntos importantes para este fin de semana ...

Primero, el obispo Doherty, en un memorando el 1 de octubre a sacerdotes y diáconos, afirmó que "... distribuir y recibir la Comunión en la mano debe continuar siendo la práctica estándar ... no simplemente una opción ...". Continúa: "Nuestros intereses no son sólo para nuestra propia salud personal, sino para que podamos servir en varias parroquias, visitar nuestras escuelas y clases de educación religiosa, y ... ministrar en hospitales y hogares de ancianos".

Eventualmente se restaurará la opción de recibir en la lengua, pero mientras tanto, por el bien de los demás, la única opción para recibir la Comunión seguirá estando en la mano. Las excepciones serán extremadamente raras.

Dos: La gente ha estado preguntando acerca de las oportunidades de formación en la fe para adultos y me complace informar que ofreceremos tres de esas oportunidades en los próximos meses. En octubre o noviembre, presentaré un par de sesiones sobre el Evangelio de Lucas, que se proclamarán durante el próximo año de adoración (a partir del 28 de noviembre). En diciembre, el P. Marty presentará dos sesiones sobre las lecturas dominicales durante la temporada de Adviento. Y en enero, el P. Dave presentará una breve serie sobre identidad católica. Obviamente, se necesitan más detalles y estarán disponibles pronto.

Lamentablemente, estas sesiones estarán disponibles solo en inglés. Sé que la formación de adultos en la fe para la comunidad hispana también es una prioridad esencial, ¡y no ignoraremos esa prioridad!

Finalmente, quiero mencionar una encuesta de todo la pastoral que estamos invitando a todos los feligreses (de St. Mary's, Alexandria; St. Mary's, Anderson y St. Ambrose) a completar.

Como parte del proceso de planificación pastoral diocesano Unidos en el corazón, nuestro pastorado creará un Plan de Visión Pastoral de tres años, y parte de ese proceso incluye la recopilación de comentarios de tantos feligreses como sea posible con respecto a muchas áreas de la vida parroquial. Con ese fin, pondremos la encuesta a disposición, a través del sitio web de la parroquia, por correo electrónico, en las misas, en las oficinas parroquiales y de otras formas que aún estamos desarrollando. El proceso de encuesta comenzará el próximo fin de semana, del 16 al 17 de octubre, y la encuesta se cerrará el 3 de noviembre.

La encuesta estará tanto en español como en inglés y solo se tomará unos 15 minutos en completarse. ¡Tus comentarios son importantes!
