Off the Top of My Head...

Merry Christmas! I am blessed to share excerpts from a Christmas homily of St. John Chrysostom, a Father of the Church and the Patriarch of Constantinople in the fourth century. The entire homily is at <http://ww1.antiochian.org/node/21955>.

Behold a new and wondrous mystery.

My ears resound to the Shepherd's song, piping no soft melody, but chanting full forth a heavenly hymn. The Angels sing. The Archangels blend their voice in harmony. The Cherubim hymn their joyful praise. The Seraphim exalt His glory. All join to praise this holy feast, beholding the Godhead here on earth, and man in heaven. He Who is above, now for our redemption dwells here below; and he that was lowly is by divine mercy raised.

Bethlehem this day resembles heaven; hearing from the stars the singing of angelic voices; and in place of the sun, enfolds within itself on every side, the Sun of justice. And ask not how: for where God wills, the order of nature yields. For He willed; He had the power; He descended; He redeemed; all things yielded in obedience to God. This day He Who is, is Born; and He Who is, becomes what He was not. For when He was God, He became man; yet not departing from the Godhead that is His. Nor yet by any loss of divinity became He man, nor through increase became He God from man; but being the Word He became flesh, His nature, because of impassability, remaining unchanged.

God is now on earth, and man in heaven; on every side all things commingle. He became Flesh. He did not become God. He was God. Wherefore He became flesh, so that He Whom heaven did not contain, a manger would this day receive. He was placed in a manger, so that He, by whom all things are nourished, may receive an infant's food from His Virgin Mother. So, the Father of all ages, as an infant at the breast, nestles in the virginal arms, that the Magi may more easily see Him. Since this day the Magi too have come, and made a beginning of withstanding tyranny; and the heavens give glory, as the Lord is revealed by a star.

To Him, then, who out of confusion has wrought a clear path, to Christ, to the Father, and to the Holy Spirit, we offer all praise, now and forever. Amen.

¡Observo un nuevo y admirable misterio! Mis oídos resuenan en torno con las voces de los pastores, que no silban con suaves sonidos, sino que cantan un himno celestial! ¡Cantan los ángeles, tocan los arcángeles, ensalzan los Querubines, glorifican los Serafines; y todos hacen fiesta, cuando miran a Dios en la tierra y al hombre en el cielo! Porque a Aquel que vive en las alturas, por una providencia particular, lo ven ahora acá abajo, y al que estaba acá abajo lo ven allá arriba a causa de la benevolencia de Dios. Hoy Belén es reflejo de los cielos; pero en vez de estrellas tiene ángeles cantores, y ha encerrado en su seno de una manera no limitada en vez del sol al Sol de justicia.

Y en este punto, no te pongas a investigar cómo ha sucedido eso, porque en donde entra la voluntad de Dios ahí cede el orden natural. ¡El quiso, pudo, descendió, redimió! ¡todo obedece a la voluntad de Dios! ¡Hoy El que es, es engendrado; El que es, se hace aquello que no era! Porque siendo Dios se hace hombre, pero sin dejar la divinidad que tenía. No se hace hombre con pérdida de la divinidad, ni tampoco por añadiduras consecutivas se ha hecho de hombre, Dios; sino que existiendo como Verbo y permaneciendo sin cambio en su propia naturaleza a causa de su impasibilidad, se ha hecho carne.

¡Ha venido Dios a la tierra y el hombre ha subido a los cielos, y todas las cosas se han entremezclado! Siendo Dios se ha hecho hombre sin negar su divinidad. Siendo el Verbo impasible, se ha hecho carne, y se ha hecho carne para habitar entre nosotros. Porque en cuanto Dios ya existía y no se ha hecho. Se ha hecho hombre a fin de que a Aquel a quien los cielos no podían encerrar, hoy un pesebre lo recibiera. Y se le pone en un pesebre para que Aquel por quien todos los seres son alimentados, reciba de la Virgen el alimento propio de los niños. Por esto el Padre del siglo futuro, en forma de un infante que pende de los pechos virgíneos no rehusa los brazos de la Virgen, con el objeto de hacer más fácil el acceso a Él.

A este, pues, que de tal manera hizo posibles las cosas imposibles, a este Cristo y Señor, démosle la gloria, juntamente con el Padre y el Espíritu santo, ahora y siempre y por los siglos de los siglos. Amén.

- 1897 Families received furniture, household goods, non-food items and emergency food.
- 623 Families received help with city utilities, gas and rent.
- The equivalence of \$47,059 was given to clients in the form of furniture, household goods, non-food items and emergency food.
- On the average by the month, we assist 158 families; give \$1,629 in furniture; \$1,604 in soaps, cleaners and household goods; \$239 in emergency food; and provide \$8,344 in utilities, gas and rent.
- For the year, we have provided \$100,133 to clients for utilities, gas and rent.
- 29 Families received a Christmas basket including 86 children (12 and under).

No act of kindness and generosity is insignificant. Each “pays forward” to aid those who are in need. The Society of St. Vincent de Paul in Anderson is truly grateful for your support. Here are some ways that your light has shown for others.

Food Ministry

We would like to thank everyone for their donations of food or money for our Christmas and Thanksgiving baskets. We prepared 10 baskets for Thanksgiving and 10 baskets for Christmas. The baskets for Thanksgiving included turkey's, stuffing, 5# bag of potatoes, corn, green beans, cream of mushroom soup, crispy onions, a dozen eggs, dinner rolls, chicken broth, cool whip, pound of butter, turkey gravy and frozen pies.

The Christmas baskets contained spiral hams, sweet potatoes, scalloped potatoes, green beans, corn, macaroni and cheese, Hawaiian rolls, brownie mix, 1 dozen eggs, 1 bottle of vegetable oil, bag of rice and a bag of pinto beans so they could have another meal from the ham bone. We were also able to give turkeys and non perishable food items for 3 other families that come to our Food Pantry and 1 family requesting last minute Christmas Dinner. **We would not be able to do this without your generous donations and we are truly grateful.**
