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OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

“When are we going to get rid of masks and open up all the pews?”

I’m hearing that question more and more often lately, and while I don’t want to make any false promises, I think we are getting closer to making that change.

I know that other parishes in the area have removed all restrictions and it’s certainly legitimate to wonder why that hasn’t happened in the Anderson-Alexandria Pastorate. One reason, beyond my cautious nature, is that our parish populations in general tend to be older than those of some other parishes. This means that our parishioners are automatically at higher risk of contracting Covid, which is still causing an average of ten deaths per week in Indiana.

Even so, as Madison County’s data continue to improve, it’s reasonable to consider less restrictive anti-infection measures. To repeat, I don’t want to promise too much too soon, but I do want parishioners to know that reasonable changes are being considered.

In addition to changes in our mask requirements and social distancing practices, we can also ask about the return of various practices that have been removed or restricted: Full holy water fonts, Communion on the tongue and from the cup, physical contact during the Sign of Peace, passing the collection basket at all the Masses, and probably a few others that I missed.

And, of course, some of these will require the restoration of liturgical ministries. We will need to have altar servers, ushers/ministers of hospitality, and, eventually, more Communion Ministers at all Masses.

And that leads to the need for Communion Ministers to the sick, homebound, and nursing home residents.

First things first, of course. I hope to be able to announce the lifting of some restrictions on masks and social distancing sooner rather than later. (And I’m still holding out for a mask-burning party!)

MENSAJE DEL PADRE TOM...

“¿Cuándo vamos a deshacernos de las máscaras y abrir todos las bancas?”

Últimamente escucho esa pregunta con más frecuencia y, aunque no quiero hacer falsas promesas, creo que nos estamos cerca de hacer ese cambio.

Sé que otras parroquias en el área han eliminado todas las restricciones y ciertamente es legítimo preguntarse por qué eso no ha sucedido en la Pastoral de Anderson-Alexandria. Una razón, más allá de mi naturaleza cautelosa, es que la población de nuestras parroquias en general tiende a ser mayor que la de otras parroquias. Esto significa que nuestros feligreses corren automáticamente un mayor riesgo de contraer el Covid, que sigue causando un promedio de diez muertes por semana en Indiana.

Aun así, a medida que los datos del condado de Madison continúan mejorando, es razonable considerar medidas antiinfecciosas menos restrictivas. Para repetir, no quiero prometer que pronto, pero sí quiero que los feligreses sepan que se están considerando cambios razonables.

Además de los cambios en nuestros requisitos de máscaras y prácticas de distanciamiento social, también podemos preguntar sobre el regreso de varias prácticas que han sido eliminadas o restringidas: como las fuentes de agua bendita llenas, Comunión en la lengua y del cáliz, contacto físico durante el Signo de Paz, pasando la canasta de la colecta en todas las Misas, y probablemente algunas otras que me perdieron. Y, por supuesto, algunos de estos requerirán la restauración de los ministerios litúrgicos. Necesitaremos tener monaguillos, ujieres/ministros de hospitalidad y, eventualmente, más Ministros de la Comunión en todas las Misas.

Y eso lleva a la necesidad de Ministros de la Comunión para los residentes enfermos, confinados en el hogar y de hogares de ancianos.

Lo primero es lo primero, por supuesto. Espero poder anunciar el levantamiento de algunas restricciones sobre máscaras y distanciamiento social Pronto.

(¡Y todavía espero una fiesta de quema de máscaras!)

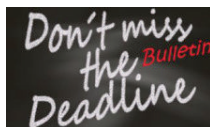

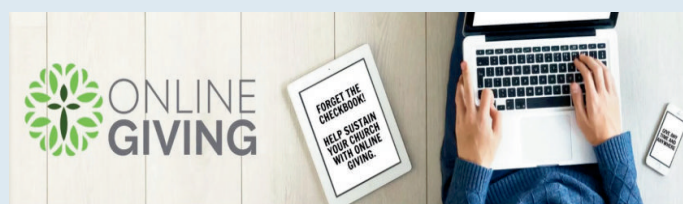

After the past two years, the one thing all of us learned is that things are bound to change, and we will have to change with them. I ask for your continued support and look forward to being of service to you all.

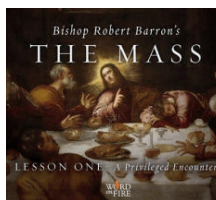

ST. MARY ALEXANDRIA LIBRARY INFORMATION

As we begin Lent, many of you might be planning to learn about our Catholic faith, the life of a particular saint, or what Catholics believe. To help guide you towards content that aligns to our church teachings, you might see these notations in the front of books:

Nihil Obstat: is Latin for "nothing stands in the way." This notation indicates a certification by an official censor of the Roman Catholic Church that a book has been examined and found to contain nothing opposed to faith and morals.

Imprimatur: is Latin for "let it be printed." This notation indicates a license granted to print or publish content especially by Roman Catholic episcopal authority.

Imprimi potest: is Latin for "it may be printed." This phrase indicates an official approval by a religious superior (or their representative) of a member of a Roman Catholic religious order that allows a work to be published.

In general, having these approvals should assure the Catholic faithful that the content of the books will not cause harm to their faith. Books or other writings approved in this way should not contradict the doctrines of our faith. However, an Imprimatur doesn't indicate that these recommendations and opinions are infallible.

Also keep in mind that the absence of these notations does not mean that the content is not enriching or appropriate for the Catholic faithful. Just bear in mind that the content without these notations contain personal reflections, opinions, and spiritual thoughts that have not undergone a review by church authorities.

Be sure to check out a book or two during Lent from the shelves in the St. Mary Alexandria narthex. Lots of content available for children as well!

PHYSICAL EDUCATION
