Re: Official Statement of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana regarding the U.S. Supreme Court Ruling on the Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization

Date: June 24, 2022

The U.S. Supreme Court ruling in the case of Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization presents a correction for understanding Constitutional process and the proper relation of government branches. The Dobbs decision and overturning Roe v. Wade tells us there is no federal constitutional right to abortion on demand. The states are now left to legislate for or against procuring abortion. Some have already done so. While the Supreme Court's decision offers an important moment for us to bolster life protections for the unborn, it does not end the public debate. We now need to turn our attention to our Indiana state legislators to urge them to enact or preserve sustainable laws to protect the rights of the unborn.

The Catholic Church in the United States has been steadfast in its support for protections of human life from conception until natural death. We can be proud of our consistent teaching, but our local actions speak louder than words when we support care provided to families, mothers and children by various institutions and agencies. Among these are the Catholic sponsored health systems, St. Vincent de Paul sites, and community based outreaches such as Birthright or Women's Care Centers.

Roe v. Wade's effects have changed our culture and laws in more ways than we can fully comprehend. This took a long time, and now our personal attitudes and social structures will take time to adjust. People who are not used to voicing support for life and conversing with their state legislators should know that truth and charity go hand in hand. Our faith, patience, and steadfastness will support the Culture of Life, and we commit to doing so peacefully. Our Christian witness must be persistent and civil.

May we enter the upcoming conversations by praying to God fervently for the conversion of hearts, for prudent ways to promote human life in our laws and our personal choices, for active compassion for those who question their pregnancies, and for gratitude for the men and women whose Respect Life activities have carried all of us across the years.

Re: Declaración oficial de la Diócesis de Lafayette-en-Indiana con respecto a la decisión de la Corte Suprema de EE. UU. sobre *Dobbs vs. Jackson Women's Health Organization*

Fecha: 24 de junio de 2022

La decisión de la Corte Suprema de los EE. UU. en el caso de *Dobbs vs. Jackson Women's Health Organization* presenta una corrección para comprender el proceso constitucional y la relación adecuada de las ramas del gobierno. La decisión de *Dobbs* y la anulación de *Roe vs. Wade* nos dice que no existe un derecho constitucional federal al aborto solicitado. Ahora se deja que los estados legislen a favor o en contra de procurar el aborto. Algunos ya lo han hecho. Si bien la decisión de la Corte Suprema ofrece un momento importante para que reforcemos la protección de la vida de los no nacidos, no pone fin al debate público. Ahora debemos centrar nuestra atención en los legisladores del estado de Indiana para instarlos a promulgar o preservar leyes sostenibles para proteger los derechos de los no nacidos.

La Iglesia Católica en los Estados Unidos ha sido firme en su apoyo a la protección de la vida humana desde la concepción hasta la muerte natural. Podemos estar orgullosos de nuestra enseñanza constante, pero nuestras acciones locales hablan más que las palabras cuando apoyamos la atención brindada a las familias, madres y niños por diversas instituciones y agencias. Entre estos se encuentran los sistemas de salud patrocinados por católicos, los sitios de St. Vincent de Paul y los alcances comunitarios como *Birthright* o *Women's Care Centers*.

Los efectos de *Roe vs. Wade* han cambiado nuestra cultura y leyes en más formas de las que podemos comprender por completo. Esto tomó mucho tiempo, y ahora nuestras actitudes personales y estructuras sociales tomarán tiempo para adaptarse. Las personas que no están acostumbradas a expresar su apoyo a la vida y conversar con los legisladores de su estado deben saber que la verdad y la caridad van de la mano. Nuestra fe, paciencia y constancia apoyarán la Cultura de la Vida, y nos comprometemos a hacerlo de manera pacífica. Nuestro testimonio cristiano debe ser persistente y civil.

Que entremos en las próximas conversaciones orando a Dios con fervor por la conversión de los corazones, por caminos prudentes para promover la vida humana en nuestras leyes y nuestras opciones personales, por compasión activa por aquellos que cuestionan sus embarazos y por gratitud por los hombres y mujeres cuyas actividades de Respeto a la Vida nos han llevado adelante a todos a lo largo de los años.

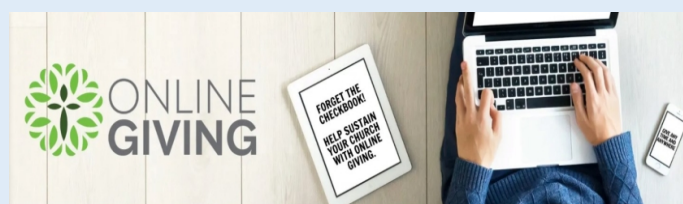

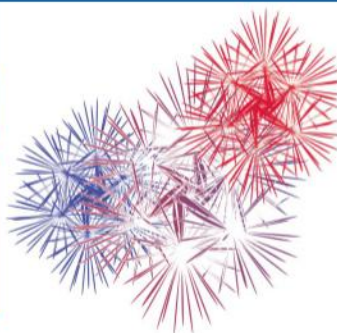

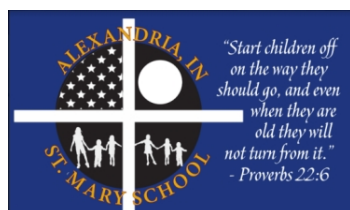
