## OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

My July 3rd column referred to the recent U.S. Supreme Court decision which declared that there is no constitutional right to abortion in the United States. I posted the statement of the Diocese of Lafayette in Indiana as the major part of the column, and promised to address this topic in the future.

Today's column will be the first of several addressing several aspects of the Supreme Court decision, the reality of abortion, and what it means to be pro-life.

The Catholic Church teaches that abortion involves the termination of a human life, and is therefore a serious sin, or, to quote the Catechism of the Catholic Church, "gravely contrary to the moral law." (#2272) Since the first century, the Church has condemned abortion, which it understood to be the moral equivalent of infanticide (the killing of an infant after birth).

Catholic teaching does not only condemn abortions performed late in the pregnancy or after some specific point during the pregnancy. The Church teaches: "Human life must be respected and protected absolutely from the moment of conception." (#2270) Why does this teaching make sense?

When does the fetus become a human person? When there is a recognizable brain? When the heartbeat begins? When the fetus is viable (it can live outside the womb)? When the newborn takes its first breath? Each of these criteria can be defended from its own perspective, but is very subjective.

But at the moment of conception, a new being comes into existence. Science shows us that the newly formed reality within the mother's body is genetically different from the mother. By contrast, if a tumor is removed from a person's body, that tumor's DNA is the DNA of the patient. But, after conception, the DNA of the newly formed cells is NOT the DNA of the mother (nor of the father). So these new cells are not just a clump of tissue, but a newly formed, distinct human life, a human being which "must be recognized as having the rights of a person..." (Catechism, #2270)

This teaching is not accepted by everyone, including some Catholics. And for Catholics who do accept it, simply stating the teaching does not address the complexity of the entire issue. And neither will a few columns of 400 words each! But I hope to look at several aspects of the issue in the coming weeks.

## PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE TOM

Mi columna del 3 de julio se refería a la reciente decisión de la Corte Suprema de los Estados Unidos que declaró que no existe el derecho constitucional al aborto en los Estados Unidos. Publiqué la declaración de la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana como la parte principal de la columna y prometí abordar este tema en el futuro.

La columna de hoy será la primera de varias que abordarán varios aspectos de la decisión de la Corte Suprema, la realidad del aborto y lo que significa ser pro-vida.

La Iglesia Católica enseña que el aborto implica la terminación de una vida humana y, por lo tanto, es un pecado grave o, para citar el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, "gravemente contrario a la ley moral". (#2272) Desde el primer siglo, la Iglesia ha condenado el aborto, que entendía como el equivalente moral del infanticidio (la muerte de un bebé después del nacimiento).

La enseñanza católica no solo condena los abortos practicados al final del embarazo o después de algún punto específico durante el embarazo. La Iglesia enseña: "La vida humana debe ser respetada y protegida de manera absoluta desde el momento de la concepción". (#2270) ¿Por qué tiene sentido esta enseñanza?

¿Cuándo se convierte el feto en una persona humana? Cuando hay un cerebro reconocible? ¿Cuándo comienza el latido del corazón? ¿Cuándo el feto es viable (puede vivir fuera del útero)? ¿Cuándo respira el recién nacido por primera vez? Cada uno de estos criterios puede defenderse desde su propia perspectiva, pero es muy subjetivo.

Pero en el momento de la concepción, surge un nuevo ser. La ciencia nos muestra que la realidad recién formada dentro del cuerpo de la madre es genéticamente diferente de la madre. Por el contrario, si se extirpa un tumor del cuerpo de una persona, el ADN de ese tumor es el ADN del paciente. Pero, después de la concepción, el ADN de las células recién formadas NO es el ADN de la madre (ni del padre). Entonces, estas nuevas células no son solo un grupo de tejido, sino una vida humana distinta y recién formada, un ser humano que "debe ver reconocidos sus derechos de persona..." (#2270)

Esta enseñanza no es aceptada por todos, incluidos algunos católicos. Y para los católicos que la aceptan, simplemente declarar la enseñanza no aborda la complejidad de todo el asunto. ¡Y tampoco unas pocas columnas de 400 palabras cada una! Pero espero analizar varios aspectos del problema en las próximas semanas.


