OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

In last week's column, I summed up the Catholic Church's teaching on why abortion is, to quote the Catechism of the Catholic Church, "gravely contrary to the moral law." (#2272)

The immorality of abortion is a clear and definite teaching of the Catholic Church. But should it therefore be enshrined in the law? The Catechism continues its teaching about abortion with these words: "The inalienable right to life of every innocent human individual is a constitutive element of a civil society and its legislation...Among such fundamental rights one should mention...every human being's right to life...from the moment of conception until death." (#2273)

But what about the separation of church and state mandated by the U.S. Constitution? In fact, the Constitution does not mandate such a separation. The First Amendment of the Constitution does guarantee freedom of religion and forbids "an establishment of religion." This means that the government cannot give any religion, or religion in general, preference or privilege in directing public policy.

A few months ago, a U.S. Representative from another state proclaimed that "the church is supposed to direct the government, the government is not supposed to direct the church." As a government official who has sworn to "preserve, protect, and defend the Constitution of the United States," this representative seems to be disavowing her own oath of office.

Currently, other than the Vatican City State, there are a few other nations whose governments are directed by religion, including Iran and Afghanistan. Or we can look back in history just a few centuries to where Catholic kingdoms and Protestant kingdoms went to war against each other. Catholicism was outlawed and Catholics were persecuted in kingdoms where Protestantism was the established religion (and vice versa). (This is one of the realities that led to the First Amendment of the Constitution!)

Even in the U.S. under the Constitution, one of the reasons for the establishment of Catholic schools was that public schools were basically "Protestant schools," and the children of Catholic immigrants were being taught how to become Protestants, and to assimilate to the dominant Protestant American culture.

If it seems that I am muddying the waters here, let's acknowledge that the waters are already muddied. To state the simple and the obvious, this is a very complicated issue!

PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE TOM

En el boletín de la semana pasada, resumí la enseñanza de la Iglesia Católica sobre por qué el aborto se considera, por citar el *Catecismo de la iglesia católica*, "gravemente contrario a la ley moral." (#2271)

La inmoralidad del aborto es una enseñanza clara y definitiva de la Iglesia Católica. ¿Debería, por lo tanto, estar plasmada esta doctrina en la ley? El Catecismo continúa su enseñanza sobre el aborto con estas palabras: "El derecho inalienable de todo individuo humano inocente a la vida constituye un elemento constitutivo de la sociedad civil y de su legislación."

"Los derechos inalienables de la persona deben ser reconocidos y respetados por parte de la sociedad civil y de la autoridad política...Entre tales derechos fundamentales es preciso recordar...el derecho de todo ser humano a la vida... desde la concepción hasta la muerte". (#2273)

Pero, ¿qué pasa con la separación de iglesia y estado que exige la Constitución de los Estados Unidos? En realidad, la Constitución no requiere tal separación. La Primera Enmienda de la Constitución garantiza la libertad de religión y prohíbe "un establecimiento de religión". Esto significa que el gobierno no puede dar a ninguna religión, o a la religión en general, preferencia o privilegio en la dirección de la política pública.

Hace unos meses, un representante del Congreso de otro estado proclamó que "la iglesia debe dirigir al gobierno; el gobierno no debe dirigir a la iglesia". Como funcionaria del gobierno que ha jurado "preservar, proteger y defender la Constitución de los Estados Unidos," esta representante parece estar negando su propio juramento del cargo.

Actualmente, además del Estado de la Ciudad del Vaticano, existen algunas otras naciones cuyos gobiernos están dirigidos por la religión, incluidos Irán y Afganistán. Recordamos también la situación de hace unos cuantos siglos cuando los reinos católicos y los reinos protestantes entraban en guerra entre sí. Se proscribía el catolicismo y se perseguían a los católicos en los reinos donde el protestantismo era la religión establecida (y viceversa). (¡Esta es una de las realidades que llevaron a la creación de la Primera Enmienda de la Constitución!)

Incluso en los Estados Unidos, según la Constitución, una de las razones para el establecimiento de las escuelas católicas fue que las escuelas públicas eran básicamente "escuelas protestantes" y a los hijos de inmigrantes católicos se les enseñaba cómo convertirse en protestantes y asimilarse a la cultura estadounidense protestante dominante.

Si acaso parece que con esto estoy enturbiando las aguas, reconozcamos que las aguas ya están enturbiadas. Es aparente que, sencillamente, ¡el asunto es muy complicado!

WHAT'S GOING ON IN THE FOOD MINISTRY?

A LOT!

- ⇒ In August, 472 people came to us - 242 to the food pantry and 230 for the Second Harvest give-aways.
- ⇒ Twice a month, volunteers unpack and bag the food Second Harvest brings in the morning and volunteers come in the afternoon to deliver food to the families who drive up.
- ⇒ Four volunteers alternate picking up Panera bread on each Friday of the month.
- ⇒ Sixty gallons of soup were made by sixty volunteers and other volunteers delivered to Alternatives and the Christian Center.
- ⇒ This month we will start being a pick-up agency for Anderson and Frankton Elementary schools, and in October we will begin with Anderson High School. That means that once a month at the end of their Big Idea Event providing food to their school population, whatever is left will be for us to pick up, store and distribute. It could be anything from nothing to a lot, frozen, canned, boxed - we won't know. **I COULD USE SOME HELP WITH THIS ONE!**
