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OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

Last week's bulletin included an announcement about the celebration of Advent Vespers on December 20. Unfortunately, I gave the correct date but the wrong day of the week. Advent Vespers will be celebrated on Tuesday, December 20, at 7:00 pm at St. Mary's in Anderson. All are invited. Please note that incense will be used. And I like incense so I won't be skimping on it!

This year, Advent lasts four full weeks, which gives us more days than usual to prepare for the coming of Christ. Next year, Christmas falls on a Monday, so the Fourth Sunday of Advent is Sunday, December 24. This means, in effect, that the Fourth Week of Advent in 2023 will have a duration of about 6 hours!

Although Christmas falls on a weekend, we will NOT be following the customary Christmas schedule. This week's bulletin includes that schedule so take a good look.

Although the commercial holiday season begins sometime in October if not before, the true Christmas season begins on Christmas Eve with the first Mass of Christmas. And while some will take down their decorations on December 26, for us the Christmas season is just beginning then. It includes the Feast of the Holy Family (Friday, December 30), the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, (December 31-January 1), the Feast of Epiphany (January 7-8), and the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord (Monday, January 9).

In other years, when Christmas and January 1 fall on a day other than Sunday, the Feasts of the Holy Family, Epiphany, and the Baptism of the Lord fall on Sundays. That gives us three things to note:

First, the traditional "12th day of Christmas," January 6, was celebrated as the Feast of the Epiphany, the last day of the Christmas Season, for centuries. Recently, in various areas of the world including the United States, the feast was moved to the weekend after January 1st. This was for the purpose of making this important feast better known and celebrated.

Second, now the last day of Christmas is no longer Epiphany, but the Baptism of the Lord, which involves the adult Christ, not the baby Jesus. That shakes up our understanding of what Christmas is!

Third, although two of our primary Christmas feasts are celebrated on weekdays this year, participating in Mass on those days is a wonderful way to celebrate the "true meaning of Christmas."

PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE TOM

El boletín de la semana pasada incluía un aviso sobre la celebración de las Vísperas de Adviento el 20 de diciembre. Desafortunadamente, di la fecha correcta pero el día de la semana equivocado. Las Vísperas de Adviento se celebrarán el martes 20 de diciembre a las 7:00 p. m. en St. Mary's en Anderson. Todos están invitados. Tenga en cuenta que se utilizará incienso y que la celebración se llevará a cabo en inglés.

Este año, el Adviento dura cuatro semanas completas, lo que nos da más días de lo habitual para prepararnos para la venida de Cristo. El próximo año, la Navidad cae en lunes, por lo que el cuarto domingo de Adviento será el domingo 24 de diciembre. ¡Esto significa, en efecto, que la Cuarta Semana de Adviento en 2023 tendrá una duración de aproximadamente 6 horas!

Aunque la Navidad cae en fin de semana, NO seguiremos el horario habitual de Navidad. El boletín de esta semana incluye ese horario, así que échale un buen vistazo.

Aunque la temporada navideña comercial comienza en algún momento de octubre, si no es que antes, la verdadera temporada navideña comienza en Nochebuena con la primera Misa de Navidad. Y mientras que algunos quitarán sus adornos el 26 de diciembre, para nosotros la temporada navideña apenas comienza entonces. Incluye la Fiesta de la Sagrada Familia (viernes, 30 de diciembre), la Solemnidad de María, Madre de Dios, (31 de diciembre-1 de enero), la Fiesta de la Epifanía (7 y 8 de enero) y la Fiesta del Bautismo de el Señor (lunes 9 de enero).

En otros años, cuando la Navidad y el 1 de enero caen en un día que no sea domingo, las Fiestas de la Sagrada Familia, la Epifanía y el Bautismo del Señor caen en domingo. Eso nos da tres cosas a tener en cuenta:

Primero, el tradicional "día 12 de Navidad", el 6 de enero, se celebró como la Fiesta de la Epifanía, el último día de la temporada navideña, durante siglos. Recientemente, en varias partes del mundo, incluido Estados Unidos, la fiesta se trasladó al fin de semana posterior al 1 de enero. Esto fue con el propósito de dar a conocer y celebrar mejor esta importante fiesta.

Segundo, ahora el último día de Navidad ya no es la Epifanía, sino el Bautismo del Señor, que involucra al Cristo adulto, no al niño Jesús. ¡Eso sacude nuestra comprensión de lo que es la Navidad!

Tercero, aunque este año dos de nuestras principales fiestas navideñas se celebran entre semana, participar en la Misa en esos días es una forma maravillosa de celebrar el "verdadero significado de la Navidad".

FOOD MINISTRY

We think about food a lot during the holiday months - and it's *good* to think about the foods our families gather around! Fun memories! And we also know that some of our neighbors struggle with food. Your generosity in donating products and/or money to the Soup Kitchen, the Food Pantry and to purchase food from Second Harvest gives hope and help to families. I get to see their faces. They are treated with dignity and respect, and we do everything we can. They thank you quite sincerely. I hope you "hear" their voices!

In November, over ten pantry days, we served 192 families. 84 were first time families. We shared food with 708 people. This does not count the unseen numbers who eat meals provided by our Soup Kitchen volunteers. What you do matters! What you teach your children about generosity and dignity for all matters! It is an honor to get to feed Christ in the hungry.

I have been surprised to discover how many pantries are closed in December. We are open. The needs remain, no matter the season. Our Food Pantry needs rice, canned chili, and applesauce - or anything else, and a lot of it! God bless and help us all! Thank you!



MINISTERIO DE ALIMENTACION
