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OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

Merry Christmas!

In mid-December we celebrated the funeral Mass of a 95-year old man who had been a member of the parish since 1955.

His daughter told me that her dad could not attend Mass so he watched the Mass on TV regularly. I was glad that he could connect in that way, but sad that we were never able to bring him Communion. We didn't know about him.

Unfortunately, these kinds of discoveries are more common than might be expected.

If you are aware of a Catholic in our Pastorate who is no longer able to come to Mass because of health, mobility issues, or some other serious issue, please contact your parish office and supply the following information: Your name and contact information, the name of the homebound person, street address/location (e.g. nursing home, care center etc.), phone number, and any other relevant information.

Upon receiving this information, one of the priests will follow up in order to set up monthly visits by our priests. We will bring them Communion, celebrate the Sacraments of Reconciliation or the Anointing of the Sick as needed/requested, and simply spend time with these folks.

We currently visit between 55-60 people every month who are homebound or residents of a care facility. As I ask for your help in making this list longer, I realize that continually increasing this number will ultimately make these monthly visits more difficult to complete.

For that reason, and to make Holy Communion more accessible than simply once each month, I am asking for parishioners to consider becoming Communion Ministers to these parishioners. There are a few basic requirements, but "worthiness and perfection" are not included among them. And those who are not already Communion Ministers are most welcome to be a part of this ministry.

According to my very fallible math, we have about 40 parishioners who do not receive Communion more than once a month because they are not visited by a lay minister.

Please consider this ministry. I would like to find lay ministers to serve those 40 (or more) folks who now receive Communion only once a month.

Please call the office if you are interested. (Your interest does not automatically mean you are committing!) I hope that we can address this urgent need in January.

PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE TOM

¡Feliz Navidad!

A mediados de diciembre celebramos la misa de funeral de un hombre de 95 años, feligrés de la parroquia desde 1955.

Su hija me dijo que su padre ya no podía asistir a misa, por lo que veía la misa en la televisión con regularidad. Me dio gusto el hecho de que pudiera conectarse de esa manera, pero me entristeció que nunca pudimos llevarle la Comunión. No sabíamos de él.

Desafortunadamente, este tipo de descubrimientos es más común de lo que se podría pensar.

Si conoce a un católico en nuestro pastorado que ya no puede asistir a Misa debido a problemas de salud, movilidad u otro problema grave, comuníquese con la oficina de su parroquia y proporcione la siguiente información: Su nombre e información de contacto (de usted), el nombre de la persona confinada en el hogar, dirección/ubicación (por ejemplo, hogar de ancianos, centro de atención, etc.), número de teléfono y cualquier otra información relevante.

Al recibir esta información, uno de los sacerdotes hará el seguimiento para programar visitas mensuales de nuestros sacerdotes. Les llevaremos la Comunión, celebraremos los Sacramentos de la Reconciliación o la Unción de los Enfermos según sea necesario/solicitado, y simplemente pasaremos tiempo con estas personas.

Actualmente los tres sacerdotes del pastorado visitamos a entre 55 y 60 personas cada mes que están confinadas en sus hogares o que residen en un centro de atención. Mientras pido su ayuda para hacer esta lista más larga, me doy cuenta de que aumentar continuamente este número finalmente hará que estas visitas mensuales sean más difíciles de completar.

Por esa razón, y para que la Sagrada Comunión sea más accesible que simplemente una vez al mes, les pido a los feligreses que consideren convertirse en Ministros de la Comunión para estos feligreses. Hay algunos requisitos básicos, pero "dignidad y perfección" no están incluidos entre ellos. Y aquellos que aún no son Ministros de Comunión son bienvenidos a ser parte de este ministerio.

Según mis cálculos muy falibles, tenemos unos 40 feligreses que no comulgan más de una vez al mes porque no reciben la visita de un ministro laico.

Por favor considere este ministerio. Me gustaría encontrar ministros laicos para servir a esas 40 (o más) personas que ahora reciben la Comunión solo una vez al mes.

Por favor llame a la oficina si está interesado. (¡Su interés no significa automáticamente que se está comprometiendo!) Espero que podamos abordar esta necesidad urgente en enero.
