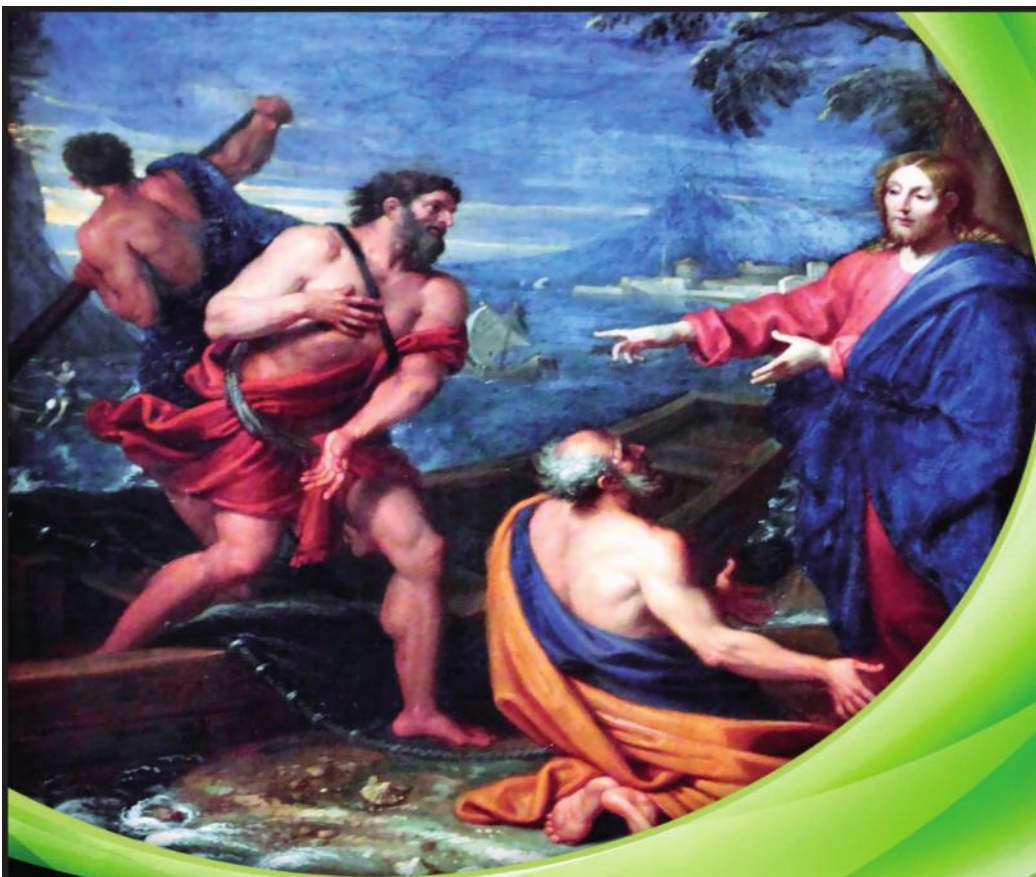

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OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

Experts in organizational communication say that there is almost no such thing as overcommunication. It is almost impossible to share important information too many times with the people who need to hear it. Overcommunication is not an annoyance, but an important tool!

Despite “learning” this truth about communication, I fall short in my implementation of it.

Most (or perhaps some) parishioners in the Anderson-Alexandria Pastorate are aware that there is a pastorate plan of some sort being formulated. That may be the extent of the knowledge of the plan for many people. This is not necessarily their fault. We (and I) have not communicated with enough frequency about the plan, despite how essential the plan will be for our parishes and the pastorate. This is not a plan about surviving but about thriving.

So in something like a New Year’s Resolution, I am committing to “over communicate” about the plan, officially called the Pastorate Vision Plan, starting this weekend. (And I need YOU, our parishioners, to hold me to this commitment!)

Our plan will soon be finalized. The process of finalizing the plan is taking longer than expected, which in itself is a good lesson about implementing the plan after it is finalized.

The plan was submitted to the diocese, where it was accepted with a good deal of enthusiasm and affirmation. We did, however, receive a suggestion in the form of an observation: This plan is very robust and ambitious, and we may want to trim it down a bit!

So our second-to-last step is an exercise in suggesting names of parishioners (in all three parishes) as potential team members for specific elements in the plan. For the Pastorate Leadership Team, this may help us to trim down the plan. If there are few or no suggestions for a specific item in the plan, that item may be eliminated or postponed. Then we can focus on the items that will seem to have more support and participation.

This is also a message for all our parishioners. The plan is not “theirs,” but “ours.” Much of the plan comes directly from feedback provided by you (remember the surveys in the fall of 2021?), and if the plan is to be successful, it will require participation and support by you, our parishioners! Everyone, literally, will have some responsibility in implementing our Pastorate Vision Plan: A plan for thriving, not for surviving.

PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE TOM

Los expertos en comunicación organizacional dicen que casi no existe el exceso de comunicación. Es casi imposible compartir información importante demasiadas veces con las personas que necesitan escucharla. ¡La comunicación excesiva no es una molestia, sino una herramienta importante!

A pesar de “aprender” esta verdad sobre la comunicación, me quedo corto en mi implementación de la misma.

La mayoría (o quizás algunos) de los feligreses del pastorado de Anderson-Alexandria saben que se está formulando algún tipo de plan pastoral. Ese puede ser el alcance del conocimiento del plan para muchas personas. Esto no es necesariamente su culpa. Nosotros (y yo) no nos hemos comunicado con suficiente frecuencia sobre el plan, a pesar de cuán esencial será para nuestras parroquias y el pastorado. El plan no se trata sólo de sobrevivir sino de prosperar.

Entonces, en algo así como una Resolución de Año Nuevo, me comprometo a “comunicar en exceso” sobre el plan, oficialmente llamado Plan de Visión Pastoral, a partir de este fin de semana. (¡Y necesito que USTEDES, nuestros feligreses, me mantengan firme en este compromiso!)

Nuestro plan pronto estará finalizado. El proceso de finalización del plan está tardando más de lo esperado, lo que en sí mismo es una buena lección sobre la implementación del plan una vez finalizado.

El plan fue presentado a la diócesis, donde fue aceptado con mucho entusiasmo y afirmación. Sin embargo, recibimos una sugerencia en forma de observación: este plan es muy sólido y ambicioso, ¡y es posible que queramos recortarlo un poco!

Así que nuestro penúltimo paso es un ejercicio de sugerencia de nombres de feligreses (en las tres parroquias) como posibles miembros del equipo para elementos específicos del plan. Para el Equipo de Liderazgo Pastoral, esto puede ayudarnos a recortar el plan. Si hay pocas o ninguna sugerencia para un elemento específico en el plan, ese elemento puede eliminarse o posponerse. Luego podemos centrarnos en los elementos que parecerán tener más apoyo y participación.

Este es también un mensaje para todos nuestros feligreses. El plan no es “de ellos”, sino “nuestro”. Gran parte del plan proviene directamente de los comentarios proporcionados por usted (¿recuerda las encuestas del otoño de 2021?), y para que el plan tenga éxito, ¡requerirá la participación y el apoyo de ustedes, nuestros feligreses! Todos, literalmente, tendrán alguna responsabilidad en la implementación de nuestro Plan de Visión Pastoral: Un plan para prosperar, no para sobrevivir.

To the Anderson-Alexandria Pastorate:

As promised, below you will find our new Weekly and YTD Financial reporting format for each parish. The financial results reflect collection activity only (including online) versus what was budgeted for collections and reflects our results from July 1, 2022 to the present (fiscal year). If collections reach or exceed our budget, then we can cover our anticipated expenses with the money in hand. However, if collections do not reach our budget, then we will have to draw from existing savings to cover our expenses.

Si las colecciones alcanzan o exceden nuestro presupuesto, entonces podemos cubrir nuestros gastos anticipados con el dinero disponible. Sin embargo, si las recaudaciones no llegan a nuestro presupuesto, tendremos que recurrir a los ahorros existentes para cubrir nuestros gastos.

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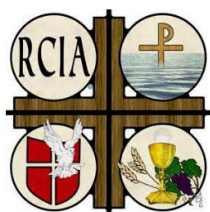

FOOD PANTRY UPDATE

THANK YOU to all who brought hams and turkeys to give away to neighbors who needed help in December! THANKS to all who donate food and money! Your donations and generosity make a HUGE difference in the lives of real people. Folks can come to our pantry once every thirty days. We help from what we have.



Who comes to the neighborhood pantry? Mostly it's the working poor! People who have jobs, usually more than one! Right now we're seeing a lot of home health care aides whose hours have been drastically cut. We have friends who've fallen ill and lost jobs, as well as those on disability and social security. There are many first time families. People are often embarrassed to be here, and grateful, so grateful to receive help without judgment or proof of need. All these families are holy, whether they know it or not. God is loving them with canned fruits and vegetables!

In December, we helped 616 people through Second Harvest School and Neighborhood distribution, and the St. Mary Neighborhood Pantry. We have had 389 people come as of January 13, 2023.

We need canned fruits & vegetables, and spaghetti sauce & tomatoes! OR, if the Holy Spirit asks you to bring something else, DO IT! Thank you, and God bless us all!

En diciembre, ayudamos a 616 personas a través de la distribución de Second Harvest School and Neighborhood y St. Mary Neighborhood Pantry. Hemos tenido 389 personas viniendo al 13 de enero de 2023.

DISHWASHER DRIVE:

For the past three years our school cafeteria has been using disposable tableware for student lunches because the dishwasher is out of service. This has been and continues to be a tremendous cost to the school. The average monthly cost to provide students with tableware and the trash bags to bag up garbage (tray, bowls, cups, spork kits, napkins, straws and trash bags) is \$866.91 MONTHLY. This may seem like a huge expense but prices have increased and this is at a competitive cost for bulk.

Long story short we need to replace the dishwasher unit as it is no longer able to be serviced due to its age. The cost for a high temp dishwasher (required by federal guidelines for the federal hot lunch program) is \$7000.00. Please help us by donating to this cause!
