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OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

Every year it seems that the transition from the Christmas season to the Lenten season moves a little more quickly. That has happened again this year. I literally JUST finished writing my last Christmas thank you note, and now Ash Wednesday is just around the corner!

Ash Wednesday is on February 22, just 10 days away, and now is the time for all of us to think about WHAT we will be doing as our Lenten practices, and, more importantly, WHY.

What are these Lenten practices? To quote the United States Council of Catholic Bishops' website, "During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting."

So there are three Lenten practices: Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving or works of charity. The Church invites us not to choose one of the three but to choose all three!

The Church has very few rules concerning Lenten practices, namely regarding fasting and abstinence. Everyone over age 14 is required to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent. Everyone between the ages of 18 and 59 is required to fast, which means eating no more than one full meal and two smaller meals, with no snacks in between meals. Of course, those whose health does not allow fasting can modify these regulations, but they are not too demanding by any means. (On the other hand, Lent does not call us to excessive penance or self-punishment.)

And people of ANY age can participate more fully in works of charity and prayer.

But why do we take these practices on?

To quote the U.S. Bishops again, "We are called not only to abstain from luxuries during Lent, but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully. We recall the waters of baptism in which we were also baptized into Christ's death, died to sin and evil, and began new life in Christ."

So choose your three Lenten practices wisely, asking, "Are these practices aimed at conversion of heart, more faithful discipleship, and a renewal of the grace of baptism?"

And have a holy and blessed Lent!

PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE TOM

Cada año parece que la transición del tiempo de la Navidad al tiempo de Cuaresma avanza un poco más rápido. Lo mismo ha vuelto a suceder este año. Literalmente ACABO de terminar de escribir mi última nota de agradecimiento de Navidad, ¡y ahora el Miércoles de Ceniza está a la vuelta de la esquina!

El Miércoles de ceniza cae el 22 de febrero. Sólo faltan 10 días y ahora es el momento para que todos pensemos en CUÁLES prácticas adoptaremos durante la Cuaresma y, lo que es más importante, POR QUÉ.

¿Cuáles son las prácticas de Cuaresma? Para citar el sitio web del Consejo de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos, "Durante la Cuaresma, buscamos al Señor en oración leyendo la Sagrada Escritura; servimos dando limosna; y practicamos el dominio propio a través del ayuno".

Así que hay tres prácticas de Cuaresma: Oración, Ayuno y Limosna u obras de caridad. ¡La Iglesia nos invita a elegir no uno de las tres, sino más bien las tres!

La Iglesia tiene muy pocas reglas sobre las prácticas de Cuaresma, es decir, sobre el ayuno y la abstinencia. Todos los mayores de 14 años deben abstenerse de comer carne el Miércoles de ceniza y todos los viernes de Cuaresma. Todas las personas de entre 18 y 59 años deben ayunar, lo que significa no comer más de una comida completa y dos comidas más pequeñas, sin bocadillos entre comidas. Por supuesto, aquellos cuya salud no les permita ayunar pueden modificar estas normas, pero no son demasiado exigentes ni mucho menos. (Por otro lado, la Cuaresma no nos llama a la penitencia excesiva o al autocastigo).

Y las personas de CUALQUIER edad pueden participar más plenamente en obras de caridad y oración.

Pero, ¿por qué adoptamos estas prácticas?

Para citar nuevamente a los obispos de EE. UU., "Estamos llamados no solo a abstenernos de los lujos durante la Cuaresma, sino a una verdadera conversión interna del corazón a medida que buscamos seguir más fielmente la voluntad de Cristo. Recordamos las aguas del bautismo en las que también fuimos bautizados en la muerte de Cristo, morimos al pecado y al mal, y comenzamos una nueva vida en Cristo".

Por lo tanto, elija sabiamente sus tres prácticas de Cuaresma y pregúntese: "¿Estas prácticas tienen como objetivo la conversión del corazón, un discipulado más fiel y una renovación de la gracia del bautismo?"

¡Y que tengan una santa y bendita Cuaresma!

Ash Wednesday, Good Friday

Fasting is obligatory from age 18 until age 59 (unless medically unable to fast). When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meatless meal, as well as two smaller meatless meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted.
