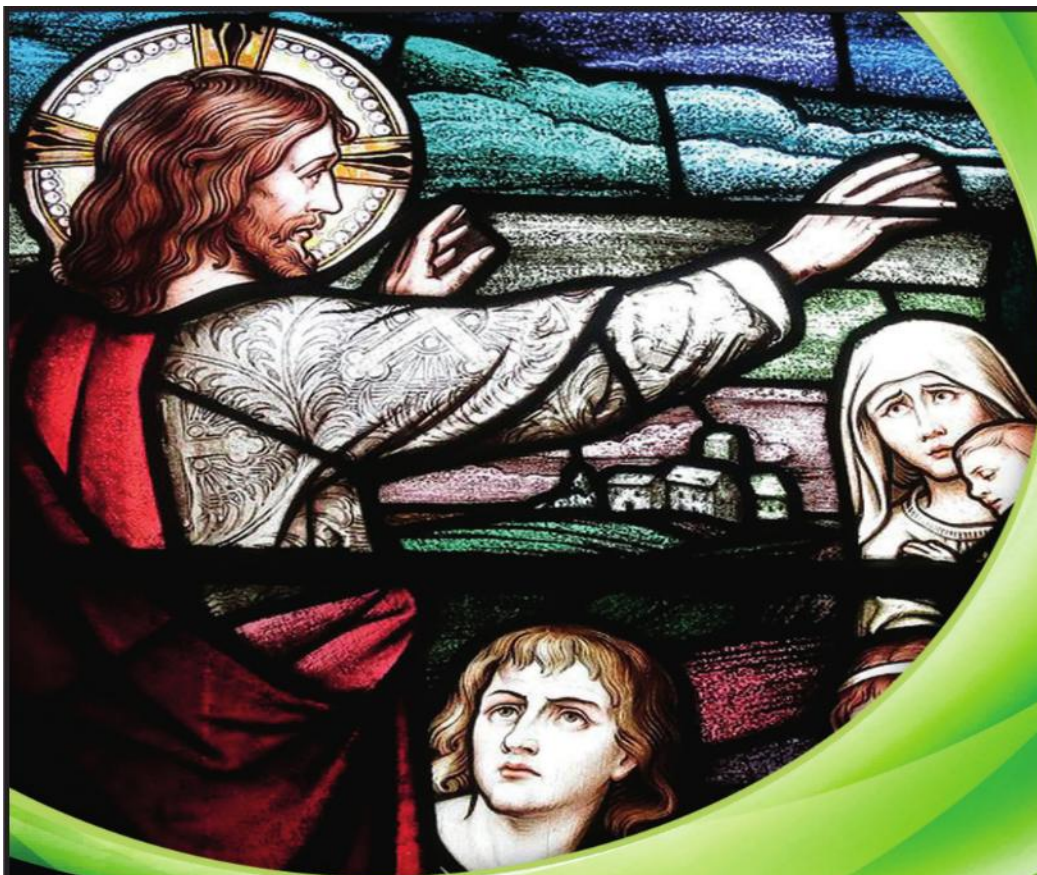

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## OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

Lent begins this Wednesday! Ash Wednesday Masses are at the following times:

- ⇒ 8:00 am—St. Mary Alexandria (*with school students*)
- ⇒ 8:10 am—St. Ambrose (*with school students*)
- ⇒ 8:30 am—St. Mary Anderson (*with school students*)
- ⇒ 11:30 am—Ascension St. Vincent Hospital (*limited seating; social distancing and masks are required*)
- ⇒ 6:00 pm—St. Mary Alexandria
- ⇒ 6:00 pm—St. Ambrose
- ⇒ 7:00 pm—St. Mary Anderson (SPANISH)

Who may receive ashes?

- You do not have to be Catholic to receive ashes. (In past parishes I served, non-Catholic clergy came to Ash Wednesday services to receive ashes!)
- You do not have to be in a state of grace to receive ashes.
- You do not have to be married in the Church to receive ashes.

In short, because the reception of ashes is all about the call to repentance, anyone who is willing to hear and answer that call is welcome to receive ashes.

(It may not be most appropriate for infants or toddlers to receive ashes, as they are too young to repent. But the preference of parents is the final criterion.)

Ash Wednesday begins our forty-day season of Lenten discipline. As mentioned in last week's bulletin column, these disciplines include fasting/sacrifice, prayer, and almsgiving/good works. The Church calls us to all three practices, not one or two! Our Lenten practices should "stretch" us, getting us out of our comfort zone, but they should not be extreme.

The RULES for Lent are actually quite minimal: Ash Wednesday is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence, and Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

"Fasting," in this specific case, means eating one full meal and two smaller meals with no snacks in between the meals. This is required of Catholics between ages 18 and 59 (inclusive). "Abstinence" means abstaining from meat, and is required of all Catholics from age 14 onwards. Of course, these practices (especially fasting) may need to be adapted for health reasons.

The rules are minimal, but the call to repent and to be transformed goes beyond the minimum. May we choose our Lenten practices of prayer, sacrifice, and good works with care!

## PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE TOM

¡Este miércoles comienza la Cuaresma! Las misas del Miércoles de Ceniza son en los siguientes horarios:

- ⇒ 8:00 am—St. Mary Alexandria (*con estudiantes de la escuela*)
- ⇒ 8:10 am—St. Ambrose (*con estudiantes de la escuela*)
- ⇒ 8:30 am—St. Mary Anderson (*con estudiantes de la escuela*)
- ⇒ 11:30 am—Hospital Ascension St. Vincent (*asientos limitados; se requiere distanciamiento social y máscaras*)
- ⇒ 6:00pm—Santa María Alexandria
- ⇒ 6:00pm—San Ambrosio
- ⇒ 7:00pm—St. Mary Anderson (ESPAÑOL)

¿Quién puede recibir las cenizas?

- No es necesario ser católico para recibir las cenizas. (¡En las parroquias anteriores en las que serví, el clero no católico vino a los servicios del Miércoles de Ceniza para recibir cenizas!)
- No es necesario estar en estado de gracia para recibir las cenizas.
- No es necesario estar casado por la Iglesia para recibir las cenizas.

En resumen, debido a que la recepción de las cenizas tiene que ver con el llamado al arrepentimiento, cualquiera que esté dispuesto a escuchar y responder a ese llamado es bienvenido a recibir las cenizas.

(Puede que no sea lo más apropiado para bebés o niños pequeños recibir cenizas, ya que son demasiado pequeños para arrepentirse. Pero la preferencia de los padres es el criterio final.)

El miércoles de ceniza comienza nuestra temporada de cuarenta días de disciplina cuaresmal. Como se mencionó en la columna del boletín de la semana pasada, estas disciplinas incluyen ayuno/sacrificio, oración y limosna/buenas obras. ¡La Iglesia nos llama a las tres prácticas, no a una o dos! Nuestras prácticas de cuaresma deben "estirarnos", sacándonos de nuestra zona de confort, pero no deben ser extremas.

Las REGLAS para la Cuaresma son en realidad bastante mínimas: el Miércoles de Ceniza es un día obligatorio de ayuno y abstinencia, y los viernes durante la Cuaresma son días obligatorios de abstinencia.

"Ayunar", en este caso específico, significa comer una comida completa y dos comidas más pequeñas sin bocadillos entre comidas. Esto se requiere para los católicos entre las edades de 18 y 59 años (inclusive). "Abstinencia" significa abstenerse de comer carne y se requiere de todos los católicos a partir de los 14 años. Por supuesto, estas prácticas (especialmente el ayuno) pueden necesitar ser adaptadas por razones de salud.

Las reglas son mínimas, pero el llamado al arrepentimiento ya la transformación va más allá del mínimo. ¡Que escojamos con cuidado nuestras prácticas cuaresmales de oración, sacrificio y buenas obras!

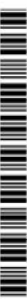
