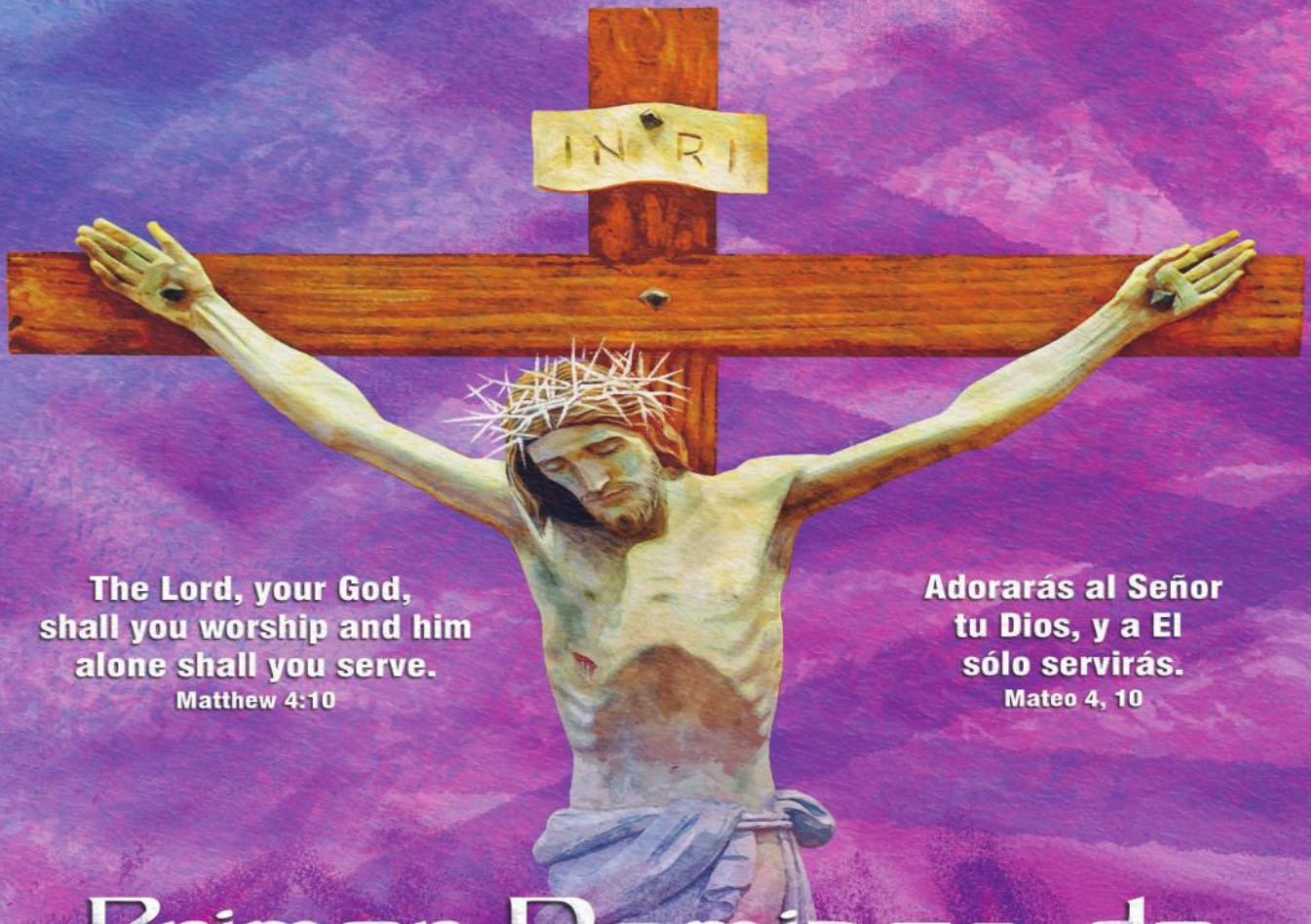

## **OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...**

Recently, I was asked by the diocesan newspaper, *The Catholic Moment*, to respond to three or four questions about the Sacrament of Reconciliation (confession).. I don't know if I'm the only priest who received this request or when the responses will be published, but responding to the questions led me to think about how we celebrate the sacrament in the Anderson-Alexandria Pastorate.

We have confessions scheduled every Saturday in each parish, and during the Advent and Lenten seasons (especially Lent) we schedule additional opportunities for confessions. In the past, we have scheduled most of these confession times during the day, because many of our parishioners are not comfortable driving at night.

A week or so ago, someone pointed out to me that we have NO extra Lenten confessions scheduled for the evening hours, and we have quickly remedied that.

On all the Fridays of Lent (which began February 24 and end March 31), confessions will be scheduled at 6:00 pm, one hour before the Way of the Cross begins at 7:00. Confessions will conclude at about 6:45. So you can go to confession and then participate in the Way of the Cross!

Lent is the ideal time for the Sacrament of Reconciliation (or Penance, or simply "confessions"), because of the important Lenten emphasis on repentance. Of course, this sacrament is appropriate whenever needed, but Lent is a particularly fitting season, especially if one has not been to confession in awhile.

And if that last phrase describes you, don't worry! You will be welcomed to the sacrament no matter when your most recent confession was. And if you can't remember what to say or do, the priest can help you with the procedures. The important thing is receiving the gift of forgiveness and celebrating it in this sacrament!

Another late addition to the Lenten schedule is the addition of a weekly second collection at all the Masses in the ANDERSON parishes. This collection will be shared with the St. Vincent de Paul Society and the Anderson Parishes Food Ministries.

St. Mary's in Alexandria will again participate in the Catholic Relief Services' Rice Bowl collection. Of the funds collected, 25% will remain in our diocese, and 75% will be used to help alleviate hunger and poverty worldwide. For more information, go to <https://www.csricebowl.org/>.

## **PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE TOM**

Recientemente el periódico diocesano, *The Catholic Moment*, me pidió que respondiera a tres o cuatro preguntas sobre el Sacramento de la Reconciliación (confesión). No sé si sea el único sacerdote que recibió esta solicitud ni cuándo se publicarán las respuestas, pero el responder a las preguntas me llevó a pensar en cómo celebramos este sacramento en el Pastorado de Anderson-Alexandria.

Tenemos confesiones programadas todos los sábados en cada parroquia, y durante las temporadas de Adviento y Cuaresma (especialmente la Cuaresma) programamos oportunidades adicionales. En el pasado, hemos programado la mayoría de estos tiempos de confesión durante el día porque muchos de nuestros feligreses no se sienten cómodos conduciendo de noche.

Hace más o menos una semana, alguien me señaló que NO tenemos confesiones adicionales de Cuaresma programadas para las horas de la tarde, y lo hemos solucionado rápidamente.

Todos los viernes de Cuaresma (que comenzó el 24 de febrero y termina el 31 de marzo), las confesiones se programarán a las 6:00 p. m., una hora antes de que comience el vía crucis a las 7:00 p. m. Las confesiones concluirán alrededor de las 6:45. ¡Así que puedes ir a confesarte y luego participar en el Vía Crucis!

La Cuaresma es el momento ideal para el Sacramento de la Reconciliación (o Penitencia, o simplemente "confesión"), debido al importante énfasis cuaresmal en el arrepentimiento. Por supuesto, este sacramento es apropiado cuando sea necesario, pero la Cuaresma es una temporada particularmente adecuada, especialmente si uno no se ha confesado por un tiempo.

Y si esa última frase describe a usted, ¡no se preocupe! Será bienvenido al sacramento sin importar cuándo fue su confesión más reciente. Y si no puede recordar qué decir o hacer, el sacerdote puede ayudarlo con los procedimientos. ¡Lo importante es recibir el don del perdón y celebrarlo en este sacramento!

Otra adición tardía al horario de Cuaresma es la de una segunda colecta semanal en todas las Misas en las parroquias de ANDERSON. Esta colecta se compartirá con la Sociedad de San Vicente de Paúl y los Ministerios de Alimentos de la Parroquia de Anderson.

St. Mary's en Alexandria participará nuevamente en la colecta del Plato de Arroz de Catholic Relief Services. De los fondos recaudados, el 25 % permanecerá en nuestra diócesis y el 75 % se utilizará para ayudar a aliviar el hambre y la pobreza en todo el mundo. ## **THE FOOD MINISTRIES STORY**

It's a little confusing because we tend to interchange names! There are currently four food distributions.

- One is the **Soup Kitchen** with Ron Cole and his crew of volunteers who hold soup kettles to collect funds at Mass, prepare bags, make soup and deliver it to Women's Alternatives and the Christian Center three times a month. The soup kitchen is supplied by requested foods and funds donated by **you**!
- The **Neighborhood Food Pantry** is open Mondays, Thursdays and Fridays for people to come once a month. Our pantry is available more hours than any other food distribution I know of in Madison County. In January we served 400 people. With three pantry days left in February, we have given food to 308 people. This is supplied by foods YOU bring (873 items in January!) or purchased with funds **you** share. We have recently partnered with a company in Indy who can provide greatly discounted items so your dollars go further.
- We also have a food distribution that is supplied by **Second Harvest**. A truck brings the food that we ordered, it's unpacked, bagged, and distributed by volunteers after school on certain Mondays. This is also discounted food purchased with funds **you** share. In January we served 432 people. We also partner with Second Harvest to pick up free leftover food from Anderson High School after their once a month food distribution. This is always an unknown product and quantity. In January we picked up 1000 lbs. of honeydew melons!
- We are pick-up partners for **Panera Bread**. On Friday evenings, volunteers go to the store at closing and pick up all the bakery items that weren't sold that day. On Saturday morning a volunteer cuts and bags the items to give. This bread is free!

We are helping A LOT of people. This Lent, there will be more opportunities for almsgiving/donations, to be shared between St. Vincent de Paul and our Food Ministries. ALL of us are grateful and aware of being careful with your donations. Even though you don't usually see the eyes of the ones we help, I wish you could. You are only two or maybe three steps removed from them. It's an honor to be a go-between. Thank **YOU**!

## **LA HISTORIA DEL MINISTERIO DE ALIMENTOS**

¡Es un poco confuso porque tendemos a intercambiar nombres! Actualmente hay cuatro distribuciones de alimentos.

- Uno es el **Comedor de Beneficencia** con Ron Cole y su equipo de voluntarios que sostienen ollas de sopa para recolectar fondos en la Misa, preparan bolsas, hacen sopa y la entregan a Alternativas de Mujeres y al Centro Cristiano tres veces al mes. ¡El comedor de beneficencia se abastece con alimentos solicitados y fondos donados por **usted**!
- La **Despensa de Alimentos del Vecindario** está abierta los lunes, jueves y viernes para que las personas vengan una vez al mes. Nuestra despensa está disponible más horas que cualquier otra distribución de alimentos que conozco en el condado de Madison. En enero atendimos a 400 personas. A falta de tres días de despensa en febrero, hemos dado de comer a 308 personas. Esto es proporcionado por los alimentos que USTED trae (¡873 artículos en enero!) o comprados con fondos que comparte. Recientemente nos asociamos con una empresa en Indy que puede ofrecer artículos con grandes descuentos para que su dinero rinda más.
- También tenemos una distribución de alimentos proporcionada por **Second Harvest**. Un camión trae la comida que pedimos, los voluntarios la desempacan, empaquetan y distribuyen después de la escuela ciertos lunes. También se trata de alimentos con descuento comprados con los fondos que comparte. En enero atendimos a 432 personas. También nos asociamos con Second Harvest para recoger los restos de comida gratis de Anderson High School después de su distribución de alimentos una vez al mes. Este es siempre un producto y una cantidad desconocida. En enero recogimos 1000 lbs. de melones dulces!
- Somos socios de recogida de Panera Bread. Los viernes por la noche, los voluntarios van a la tienda al cierre y recogen todos los artículos de panadería que no se vendieron ese día. El sábado por la mañana, un voluntario corta y embolsa los artículos para dar. ¡Este pan es gratis!

Estamos ayudando a MUCHAS personas. Esta Cuaresma, habrá más oportunidades para dar limosnas/donaciones, para ser compartidas entre San Vicente de Paúl y nuestros Ministerios de Alimentos. TODOS estamos agradecidos y conscientes de tener cuidado con sus donaciones. Aunque normalmente no ves los ojos de aquellos a quienes ayudamos, me gustaría que pudieras. Estás a solo dos o tal vez tres pasos de distancia de ellos. Es un honor ser un intermediario. ¡Gracias!
