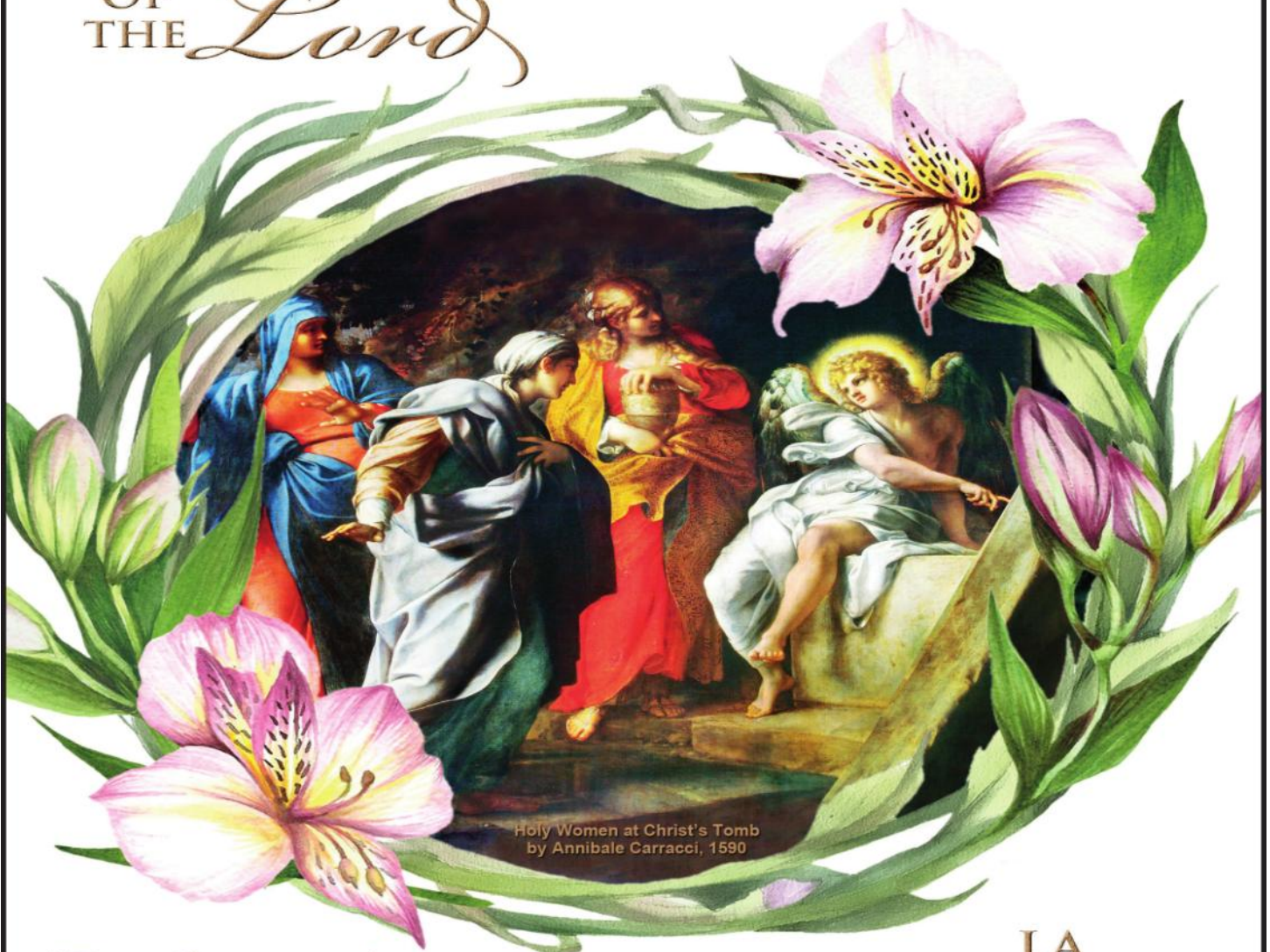

OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

Christ is Risen! Alleluia!

Risen indeed! Alleluia!

“Happy Easter” is not enough! Our greeting on this Easter Sunday must be more than just a greeting. It must be a proclamation: “Christ is Risen! Risen indeed! Alleluia.”

Christ’s resurrection is not a past event. We do not say that “Christ has risen,” but that “Christ is risen.” Christ has not risen to the Father to leave us behind. Christ is risen and is present among us.

It’s impossible to deny the bad news that we encounter so easily and so frequently. To put our faith in the Risen Christ is not to close our eyes to all that bad news. To believe in the Risen Christ means to be convinced that he has come to save the world, not by enabling our escape from that world, but by transforming it.. And in transforming the world, he invites us to be part of his saving work of transformation.

Today many of us will gather with family and loved ones, ending Lenten fasts with Easter feasts. Enjoy those feasts. Pray for those who are still fasting - because they have no choice. Greet one another with more than a greeting, a proclamation: Christ is Risen! Alleluia! Risen indeed! Alleluia!

Here are two pieces of more “finite” good news: Our Pastorate Vision Plan has been finalized and will be mailed to all the households in the Anderson-Alexandria Pastorate. In the coming weeks we will review the first year’s elements of this plan AND invite participation. This will be an invitation to move forward together with God’s help and in God’s Spirit so that our parishes can better respond to our mission - with the Risen Christ.

Second, Bishop Doherty has announced that Communion Cup should be offered at parish Masses beginning June 11, the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. We can rejoice in the restoration of the Communion Cup after a long absence caused by the Covid pandemic.

A side note: We are inviting parishioners to become (or continue as) Communion Ministers to the sick. You can find information in this bulletin about our formation sessions for this ministry, which will take place in English the week of April 16 and in Spanish at a later date.

La resurrección de Cristo no es un evento pasado. Cristo no ha resucitado al Padre para dejarnos atrás. Cristo ha resucitado y está presente entre nosotros.

Es imposible negar las malas noticias que nos encontramos con tanta facilidad y frecuencia. Poner nuestra fe en Cristo Resucitado no es cerrar los ojos a todas esas malas noticias. Creer en Cristo Resucitado significa estar convencidos de que ha venido a salvar al mundo, no permitiéndonos escapar de ese mundo, sino transformándolo. Y al transformar el mundo, nos invita a ser parte de su obra salvadora de transformación.

Hoy muchos de nosotros nos reuniremos con familiares y seres queridos, terminando los ayunos de Cuaresma con las fiestas de Pascua. Disfruten de esas fiestas. Oren por aquellos que todavía ayunan porque no tienen otra opción. Salúdense unos a otros con más que un saludo, un anuncio: ¡Cristo ha Resucitado! ¡Aleluya! ¡Verdaderamente ha resucitado! ¡Aleluya!

Aquí hay dos buenas noticias más “finitas”: Nuestro Plan de Visión Pastoral ha sido finalizado y será enviado por correo a todos los hogares en el Pastorado Anderson-Alexandria. En las próximas semanas revisaremos los elementos del primer año de este plan e invitaremos a la participación. Esta será una invitación a avanzar juntos con la ayuda de Dios y en el Espíritu de Dios para que nuestras parroquias puedan responder mejor a nuestra misión—juntos con Cristo Resucitado.

En segundo lugar, el obispo Doherty ha anunciado que la Copa de la Comunión debe ofrecerse en las Misas parroquiales a partir del 11 de junio, la Fiesta del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. 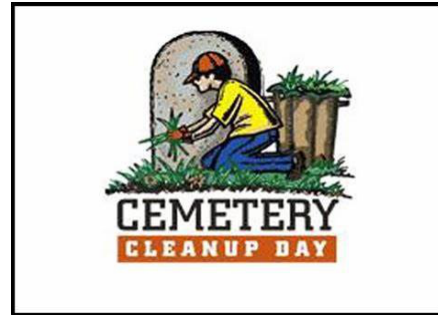

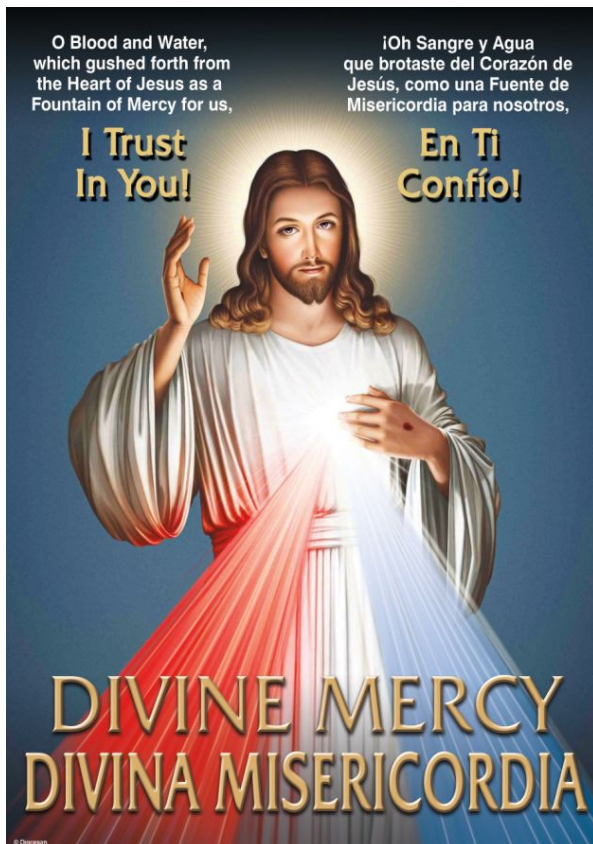


ST. MARY'S CEMETERY SPRING CLEANUP

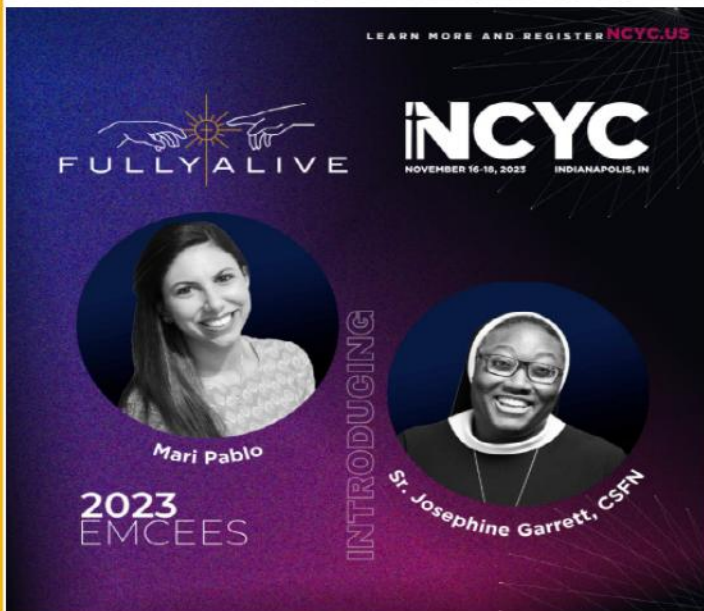

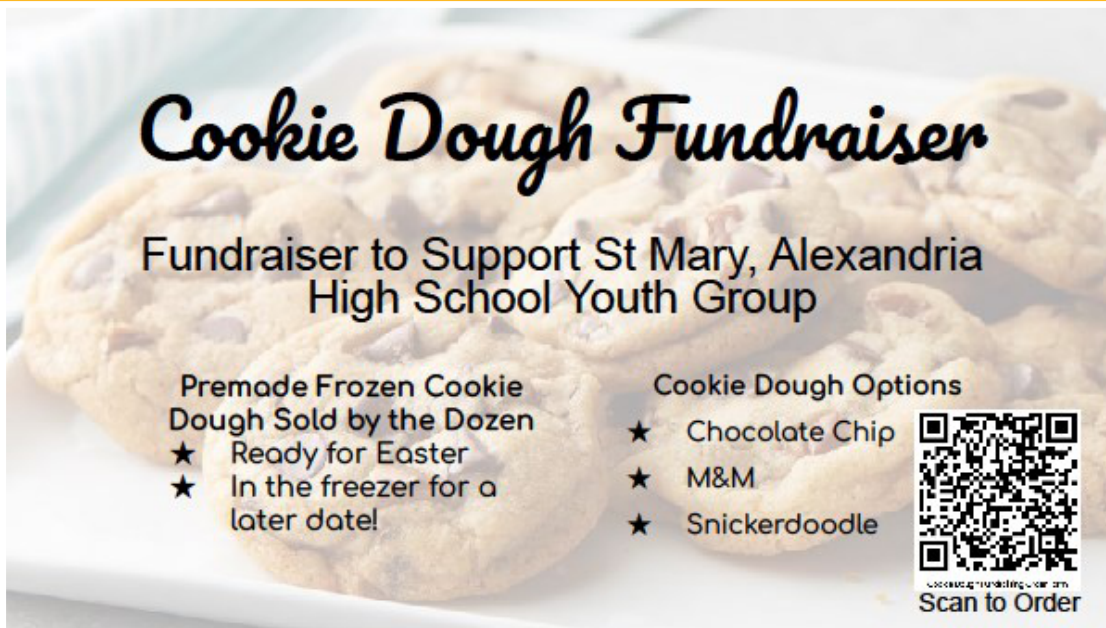
What your teens can expect:

BETHLEHEM CHRISTIANS OLIVEWOOD SOUVENIRS

APRIL 15 & 16

Next weekend, representatives from Bethlehem Christians will be selling handmade Olivewood religious items made by families in the Holy Land after all Masses at St. Ambrose & St. Mary, Anderson.

Bethlehem Christians' goal is to spread the word about Christians in the Holy Land and to give them financial support by offering their artistic work for sale (i.e., religious olivewood carvings). The sales they generate help keep these artists in business and remain living in their homeland. Christians used to account for nearly 20% of the entire population, but today, less than 2% remain. The main reason for this decline is economic hardship caused by political instability.

Today, more than six hundred Christian families, mostly Catholics, living in Bethlehem rely completely on the hand carved olive wood figures to make their living.

We would like to encourage all of you to take a look at the display and see if there is something you would like to purchase from them. Remember, by doing so, you are helping to protect the many Christians in the Holy Land and getting a piece of artwork from the land of Christ.

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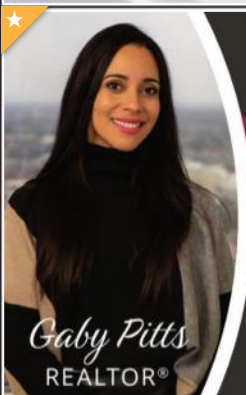
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
