OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

We will continue announcing the Saturday Vigil Mass schedule change in the Anderson parishes until the actual change takes place: Effective August 5, the one Saturday Vigil Mass in Anderson will be at 4:00 pm. From October through March, the Mass will be celebrated at St. Mary's Anderson; from April through September, at St. Ambrose.

The next question, of course, is, "What about confessions?"

Beginning August 5, the 1:00pm Confession time at St. Mary Anderson will be discontinued. Confessions will be heard from 2:30pm to 3:30pm at the Church where the 4:00pm Mass is being celebrated.

None of this affects the Alexandria schedule, where Saturday Confessions and Mass at St. Mary's will continue at 3:30pm and 4:30pm, respectively.

Another change in the schedule begins Thursday, July 6: Every Thursday at St. Mary Anderson, we will conduct Eucharistic Adoration from 6:00pm to 6:45pm, during which a priest will also be available to hear confessions (in Spanish or English). Adoration will conclude with simple Reposition of the Blessed Sacrament. Then we will celebrate Mass in Spanish at 7:00pm.

While the need for more opportunities for Eucharistic Adoration and the Sacrament of Reconciliation may seem evident, the need for an additional weekday Mass in Spanish may not have occurred to everyone.

And, while we are eliminating one Mass, why add another to the schedule? There is a big difference between the weekday and weekend schedules, and, ironically, one of the reasons (but not the only one) for consolidating two Mass times into one is to improve the quality of the liturgy through fuller participation.

In the case of the Spanish weekday Mass, the need is obvious to anyone who attends weekday Masses at either of the Anderson parishes. At some of these Masses, the majority of the congregation is Spanish-speaking, but the Mass is in English. So this Thursday evening change gives our Hispanic community the opportunity to celebrate Mass in their own language. (Of course, English speakers are welcome and invited!)

If experience tells me anything, there will be some sort of unanticipated problem with the upcoming changes. Despite best efforts, there will be at least one imperfection. So your patience is appreciated!

I look forward to the changes we will be making this summer as we continue to worship together as a community.

PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE TOM

Seguiremos anunciando el cambio de horario de la Misa de Vigilia del sábado en las parroquias de Anderson hasta que se produzca el cambio real: A partir del 5 de agosto, la Misa de Vigilia del sábado en Anderson será a las 4:00 p. m. De octubre a marzo, la misa se celebrará en St. Mary Anderson; de abril a septiembre, en St. Ambrose.

La siguiente pregunta, por supuesto, es: "¿Qué pasa con las confesiones?"

A partir del 5 de agosto, se suspenderá el horario de confesiones de la 1:00pm en St. Mary Anderson. Las confesiones se escucharán de 2:30pm a 3:30pm en la Iglesia donde se vaya a celebrar la Misa de las 4:00pm.

Nada de esto afectará el horario de Alexandria, donde las Confesiones y la Misa del sábado en St. Mary continuarán a las 3:30pm y 4:30pm, respectivamente.

Otro cambio en el horario comienza el jueves 6 de julio: todos los jueves en St. Mary Anderson, realizaremos la Adoración Eucarística de 6:00pm a 6:45pm, durante la cual un sacerdote también estará disponible para escuchar confesiones (en español o inglés). La adoración concluirá con la simple Reposición del Santísimo Sacramento. Luego celebraremos Misa en español a las 7:00pm.

Si bien la necesidad de más oportunidades para la Adoración Eucarística y el Sacramento de la Reconciliación puede parecer evidente, la necesidad de una misa adicional en español entre semana puede no haber ocurrido para todos.

Y, mientras estamos eliminando una misa, ¿por qué agregar otra al horario? Hay una gran diferencia entre los horarios de los días de semana y los fines de semana e, irónicamente, una de las razones (pero no la única) para consolidar dos tiempos de Misa en uno es mejorar la calidad de la liturgia a través de una participación más plena.

En el caso de la Misa entre semana en español, la necesidad es obvia para cualquiera que asista a Misas entre semana en cualquiera de las parroquias de Anderson. En algunas de estas Misas, la mayoría de la congregación es de habla hispana, pero la Misa es en inglés. Así que este cambio de jueves por la noche le da a nuestra comunidad hispana la oportunidad de celebrar Misa en su propio idioma. (¡Por supuesto, los angloparlantes son bienvenidos e invitados!)

Si la experiencia me dice algo, habrá algún tipo de problema inesperado con los próximos cambios. A pesar de los mejores esfuerzos, habrá al menos una imperfección. ¡Así que su paciencia es muy apreciada!

Espero con interés los cambios que haremos este verano mientras continuamos adorando juntos como comunidad.

A Spiritual Approach to Temporal Change

Humans dislike change—we crave stability and continuity. We become dependent on habits and routines. And there is often a good reason for this. But when it comes to our spiritual growth, we need to change; we need to become

more Christ-like. As the old saying goes, “no pain, no gain.” Change is essential and something that we are constantly called to do in the Gospels. Jesus tells us that our hearts must change to bring us closer to God’s love.

Change is challenging. We cannot simply move past things sometimes—change does take work. It takes sacrifice or humility. It can enable us to feel the loss or the emptiness, which also brings us closer to those who are sick, homeless, addicted, depressed, hungry, or marginalized; those, as St. Mother Teresa noted, who are “the poorest of the poor.”

Our Church in the diocese is facing significant challenges; with that comes the need for change and modification. With challenges and change also come opportunities. For us, this includes reaching out to our neighbors through new evangelization strategies, physical space and geographical changes to accommodate these new realities, and

moving our “favorite” pastors and priests. But this occasion enables our Church’s mission of spreading the Good News and will bring us all closer to the Trinity, as long as we open our hearts.

The Hebrew word for change is *mûwr*—it also means “to alter” or “to exchange.” Giving up our own desires and opening up our hearts to the changes that are to be announced for the diocese is an important part of being a believer. We must exchange our personal needs for those of our brothers and sisters; we must alter our expectations to ensure that we are willing and happy givers; and we must want to bring the hope of the Gospel to others in and through ways that we may not understand. That is the beauty of our faith.

Let us pray for the strength to welcome and be open to the changes in our diocese, and across the Universal Church, that are needed to bring more people together in the love of our Lord, Jesus Christ.

Un enfoque espiritual para el cambio temporal

A los humanos no les gusta el cambio; anhelamos la estabilidad y la continuidad. Nos volvemos dependientes de hábitos y rutinas. Y a menudo hay una buena razón para ello. Pero cuando se trata de nuestro crecimiento espiritual, necesitamos

cambiar; necesitamos llegar a ser más como Cristo. Como dice el viejo refrán, “sin dolor, no hay ganancia”. El cambio es esencial y es algo que constantemente estamos llamados a hacer en los Evangelios. Jesús nos dice que nuestro corazón debe cambiar para acercarnos al amor de Dios.

El cambio es desafiante. A veces no podemos simplemente dejar atrás las cosas; el cambio requiere trabajo. Se necesita sacrificio o humildad. Puede permitimos sentir la pérdida o el vacío, lo que también nos acerca a aquellos que están enfermos, sin hogar, adictos, deprimidos, hambrientos o marginados; aquellos, como señaló Santa Madre Teresa, que son “los más pobres de los pobres”.

Nuestra Iglesia en la diócesis enfrenta importantes desafíos; con eso viene la necesidad de cambio y modificación. Con los desafíos y el cambio también vienen las oportunidades. Para nosotros, esto incluye llegar a nuestros vecinos a través de nuevas estrategias de evangelización, espacio físico y cambios geográficos

para acomodar estas nuevas realidades y mover a nuestros pastores y sacerdotes “favoritos”. Pero esta ocasión posibilita la misión de nuestra Iglesia de difundir la Buena Nueva y nos acercará a todos a la Trinidad, siempre que abramos nuestros corazones.

La palabra hebrea para cambio es *mûwr*—también significa “alterar” o “intercambiar”. Renunciar a nuestros propios deseos y abrir nuestros corazones a los cambios que se anunciarán para la diócesis es una parte importante de ser creyente. Debemos cambiar nuestras necesidades personales por las de nuestros hermanos y hermanas; debemos modificar nuestras expectativas para asegurarnos de que seamos dadores dispuestos y felices; y debemos querer llevar la esperanza del Evangelio a otros en ya través de formas que tal vez no entendamos. Esa es la belleza de nuestra fe.

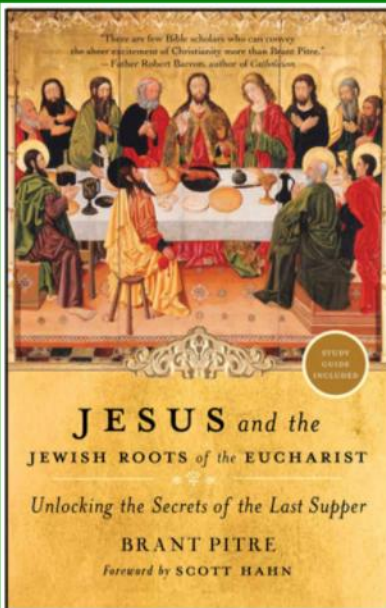

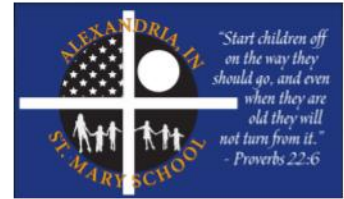
St. Mary School is seeking a dynamic Kindergarten teacher with proven classroom management skills who:
