OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

Recently, I wrote about some of the liturgical “functions” that were formerly reserved to priests that have been assumed by lay Communion Ministers. Today I’d like to discuss other areas of parish ministry where similar changes are in progress.

While the practical reason for this change is the smaller number of priests than in the past, there’s also more emphasis on the essential ministry of priests, which falls basically into three areas: proclaiming the Word, celebrating Mass and the Sacraments, and leadership. “Leadership” has different interpretations, but it is not a catch-all category for “everything else besides Word and Sacrament.” And when priests spend time doing what is not our responsibility, our actual responsibilities will not receive the attention they deserve.

At the same time, there is a growing understanding that baptized, lay members of the Church are just as responsible for the ministry, life, and well-being of the Church (and parish) as the clergy are.

So it’s important for me to point out the areas of parish life and ministry for which I am not responsible. The following words may sound blunt, but be sure to read through to the end!

If you notice a problem with a facility (e.g. broken window) the grounds (a chuckhole in the parking lot), or any appliances or machinery (a refrigerator that doesn’t refrigerate), or if you have questions about parish finances or your parish contributions, please contact Buddy LeRose, our Director of Operations. His email is dlrose@parish.dol-in.org.

Regarding baptismal or sacramental preparation for an infant, child, or young person, please contact Christine Vincent-Rodas, our Director of Evangelization, at cvincent-rodas@parish.dol-in.org.

If you want to inform the priests/Pastorate of someone who is homebound or in the nursing home or hospital, contact your parish office. The number is on the bulletin cover.

I make these requests (demands?) not for pity, or because the priests are “too important to be bothered,” but because priests often don’t have the information that is needed, or because we would refer the questioner to the appropriate person anyway, or because (certainly in my case), it will take longer to address the issue if the priest is the one who addresses it!

And this is not a comprehensive list but it gives some of the most common examples of “misplaced attention.”

Priests are human after all (just in case you wondered)!

PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE TOM

Recientemente escribí sobre algunas de las “funciones” litúrgicas que antes estaban reservadas a los sacerdotes y que han sido asumidas por ministros laicos de la Comunión. Hoy me gustaría hablar sobre algunas otras áreas del ministerio parroquial donde se están llevando a cabo cambios similares.

Si bien la razón práctica de este cambio es un número menor de sacerdotes que en el pasado, también hay más énfasis en el ministerio esencial de los sacerdotes, mismo que se divide básicamente en tres áreas: proclamar la Palabra, celebrar la Misa y los Sacramentos, y el liderazgo. “Liderazgo” tiene diferentes interpretaciones, pero no es una categoría que abarque todo “todo lo demás además de la Palabra y los Sacramentos”. Y cuando los sacerdotes dedican tiempo a hacer lo que no es nuestra responsabilidad, nuestras responsabilidades reales no recibirán la atención que merecen.

Al mismo tiempo, existe una comprensión cada vez mayor de que los miembros laicos bautizados de la Iglesia son tan responsables del ministerio, la vida y el bienestar de la Iglesia (y de la parroquia) como lo son los clérigos.

Por eso es importante para mí señalar las áreas de la vida y el ministerio parroquial de las cuales no soy responsable. Las siguientes palabras pueden parecer demasiado directas, ¡pero asegúrese de leerlas hasta el final!

Si usted nota un problema con las instalaciones (por ejemplo, una ventana rota), el terreno (un bache en el estacionamiento) o con cualquier electrodoméstico o maquinaria (un refrigerador que no enfría), o si tiene preguntas sobre las finanzas de la parroquia o sus contribuciones, comuníquese con Buddy LeRose, nuestro Director de Operaciones. Su correo electrónico es dlrose@parish.dol-in.org.

Con respecto a la preparación baptismal o sacramental para un bebé, niño o joven, comuníquese con Christine Vincent-Rodas, nuestra Directora de Evangelización, en cvincent-rodas@parish.dol-in.org.

Si desea informar a los sacerdotes o al pastorado de alguien que está confinado en su casa o en un asilo de ancianos u hospital, comuníquese con su oficina parroquial. El número siempre aparece en la portada del boletín.

Hago estas solicitudes (¿exigencias?) no para inspirar lástima ni porque los sacerdotes son “demasiado importantes para ser molestados,” sino porque los sacerdotes a menudo no tienen la información necesaria, o porque de todos modos referiríamos al que hace la pregunta a la persona más apropiada, o porque (ciertamente en caso mío), ¡llevará más tiempo abordar el tema si es el sacerdote quien lo aborda!

Y esta no es una lista exhaustiva, pero ofrece algunos de los ejemplos más comunes de “atención fuera de lugar”.

¡Los sacerdotes somos humanos después de todo (en caso de que usted se lo haya preguntado)!

HOW ARE YOU BEING CALLED TO SERVE AT MASS?

"In the celebration of Mass the faithful form a holy people, a people of God's own possession and a royal Priesthood, so that they may give thanks to God...and so that they may learn to offer their very selves." (General Instruction of the Roman Missal #95)

As Baptized Christian people we have a right and a duty to as well as a call to conscious, active, and full participation, in body and in mind, at Mass. The very nature of the celebration of the Mass requires of us a fervent participation with faith, hope, and charity. Some people are called to serve in more particular ways as Liturgical ministers, assisting the priest and the community gathered to worship.

All of our Masses are in need of additional people to serve as Liturgical Ministers. Next weekend everyone will have the opportunity to respond to God's call and offer your service. If you already are a liturgical minister, thank you for your service!
