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OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

By the time you are reading this column, I will have finalized the membership of the Anderson-Alexandria Pastorate Pastoral Council, which begins meeting in January. Due to an early deadline, I am not yet ready to announce the names of the members.

The discernment process has included conversations with sixteen members of the Pastorate, who were recommended by fellow parishioners, indicated an interest on their own, or whom I directly invited into the process. From those conversations, I am choosing eight members of the council, including two from each parish and two from the Hispanic Community.

I originally intended to appoint nine members, three from each parish, but it made sense to proactively seek members of the Hispanic community, not as a “separate parish,” but as a very large and active group within the larger Pastorate.

The Pastorate Pastoral Council will provide consultation to me as Pastor in areas having to do with the mission and ministry of the Pastorate. Much of this will consist of monitoring and updating the Pastorate Vision Plan. Other areas of discussion will have to do with Pastorate-wide practices, policies, and programs. Occasionally, the council will discuss issues or concerns having to do with a specific parish or school.

The council, in accord with Church law, will provide a consultative voice to me as Pastor. The council will advise, not legislate. Members will need to have a good understanding of the issue at hand, and perhaps some study; seeking wisdom from other members of the Pastorate, interacting and collaborating with the Pastorate Leadership Team and Staff; building consensus within the council, and supporting the ultimate decision made by me as Pastor.

As Pastor, the consultative process requires entrusting them with important, not trivial, pastoral matters for discussion; providing clarity about the issue at hand; providing appropriate tools and resources for their work; taking seriously the process and the result(s) of the council’s consultation; and, if I don’t accept a recommendation on a particular issue, to share with the council my reasons for not doing so. (As I will be involved in the process of consultation and consensus from beginning to end, it’s unlikely that the council will make a recommendation that I am not generally comfortable with, however.)

In next week’s bulletin, I hope to announce the council members’ names.. Meanwhile, please keep them, and the upcoming work of the council, in your prayers.

PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE TOM...

Ya para cuando usted esté leyendo esta columna, habré finalizado la selección de miembros del Consejo Pastoral del Pastorado de Anderson-Alexandria, el cual comenzará a reunirse en enero. Debido a la fecha límite anticipada, todavía no estoy preparado para anunciar los nombres de los miembros.

El proceso de discernimiento ha incluido conversaciones con dieciséis miembros del Pastorado, quienes fueron recomendados por otros feligreses, indicaron un interés propio o a quienes invité directamente al proceso. De esas conversaciones, estoy eligiendo ocho miembros del consejo, incluidos dos de cada parroquia y dos de la comunidad hispana.

Originalmente tenía la intención de nombrar nueve miembros, tres de cada parroquia, pero tenía sentido buscar proactivamente miembros de la comunidad hispana, no como una “parroquia separada”, sino como un grupo muy grande y activo dentro del Pastorado en general.

El Consejo Pastoral del Pastorado me brindará consultas como Pastor en áreas que tengan que ver con la misión y ministerio del Pastorado. Gran parte de esto consistirá en monitorear y actualizar el Plan de Visión del Pastorado. Otras áreas de discusión tendrán que ver con las prácticas, políticas y programas a nivel de todo el pastorado. Ocasionalmente, el consejo discutirá temas o inquietudes que tengan que ver con una parroquia o escuela específica.

El consejo, de acuerdo con la ley de la Iglesia, me proporcionará una voz consultiva como párroco. El consejo asesorará, no legislará. Los miembros necesitarán tener una buena comprensión del asunto en cuestión y tal vez algo de estudio; buscar sabiduría de otros miembros del Pastorado, interactuar y colaborar con el Equipo y el Personal de Liderazgo del Pastorado; generar consenso dentro del consejo y apoyar la decisión final que tome como párroco.

Como párroco, el proceso de consulta requiere confiarles asuntos pastorales importantes, no triviales, para su discusión; proporcionar claridad sobre el tema en cuestión; proporcionar herramientas y recursos adecuados para su trabajo; tomar en serio el proceso y los resultados de la consulta del consejo; y, si no aceptara una recomendación sobre un tema en particular, compartir con el consejo mis razones para no hacerlo. (Sin embargo, como estaré involucrado en el proceso de consulta y consenso de principio a fin, es poco probable que el consejo haga una recomendación con la que en general no me sienta cómodo).

En el boletín de la próxima semana espero anunciar los nombres de los miembros del consejo. Mientras tanto, manténganlos a ellos y al próximo trabajo del consejo en sus oraciones.

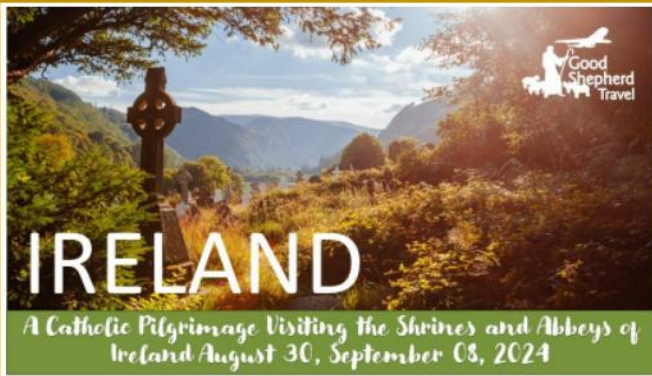
SE NECESITAN VOLUNTARIOS PARA COMMUNITY CARE DAY

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL UPDATE

St. Vincent de Paul had a very successful year in helping people in the greater Anderson area. We helped many people because of your generosity both financially, and with donations of furniture, household goods, etc. Thank you again for your assistance in helping so many.

In the last twelve months, St. Vincent de Paul has completed the following:

- Furnished over \$36,000 in household goods and non-food items to poor people.
- Provided over \$32,000 in furniture, beds, chests, lamps, etc. to the less fortunate.
- Aided over 800 poor families with approx. \$120,000 for delinquent utility and rent.
- St. Vincent de Paul volunteers made over 1,000 home visits to families in need. We traveled over 2,000 miles to make home visits and pick up furniture. In December 2023, 28 families were provided with Christmas toys for children and special gifts for the mothers.
- This fall, we had a very successful "Walk for the Poor" event. We had over 225 walkers, many corporate sponsors, and individual donors participating. We made over \$40,000.00 to help the poor in Anderson.
- The Advent trees at both churches helped to restock our household goods, blankets, kitchen cookware, dishes, etc. into our inventory.

Everyone who helps at St. Vincent de Paul is a volunteer who donates their time which last year amounted to over 2500 hours. Our volunteers drive many miles to pick up donations and make individual home visits – all in the spirit of Christian charity. Every dollar donated to St. Vincent de Paul, except for warehouse and national conference expenses, goes directly to support the neediest families in our community. Likewise, all non-perishable food, household items, and furniture donations go only to those families who qualify.

The warehouse, located at 2115 West 25th Street, is open Tuesday and Thursday, from noon to 3:00 p.m. During that time, we distribute furniture, household items, toiletries, and non-perishable food. We also accept donations at that time. Any correspondence should be addressed to P.O. Box 951 Anderson, IN 46015. Usable furniture will be picked up if you call us at 642-5401 and leave a message. You are always welcome to visit the warehouse during the hours we are open.

Our continued work depends on your donations. Thank you for your help this past year and please consider helping us again this year.

ACTUALIZACIÓN DE SAN VICENTE DE PAÚL

San Vicente de Paúl tuvo un año muy exitoso ayudando a las personas en el área metropolitana de Anderson. Ayudamos a muchas personas gracias a su generosidad, tanto financieramente como con donaciones de muebles, artículos para el hogar, etc. Gracias nuevamente por su ayuda en asistir a tantos.

En los últimos doce meses, San Vicente de Paúl ha logrado lo siguiente:

- Suministrado más de \$36,000 en artículos para el hogar y productos no alimenticios a personas necesitadas.
- Proporcionado más de \$32,000 en muebles, camas, cómodas, lámparas, etc. a los menos afortunados.
- Ayudado a más de 800 familias necesitadas con aproximadamente \$120,000 para servicios públicos atrasados y alquiler.
- Voluntarios de San Vicente de Paúl realizaron más de 1,000 visitas domiciliarias a familias necesitadas. Recorrimos más de 2,000 millas para hacer visitas domiciliarias y recoger muebles. En diciembre de 2023, se proporcionaron juguetes navideños para niños y regalos especiales para las madres de 28 familias.
- Este otoño, tuvimos un evento muy exitoso de "Caminata por los Pobres". Participaron más de 225 caminantes, muchos patrocinadores corporativos y donantes individuales. Recaudamos más de \$40,000.00 para ayudar a los pobres en Anderson.
- Los árboles de Adviento en ambas iglesias ayudaron a reabastecer nuestro inventario de artículos para el hogar, mantas, utensilios de cocina, platos, etc.

Todos los que ayudan en San Vicente de Paúl son voluntarios que donan su tiempo, lo que el año pasado sumó más de 2500 horas. Nuestros voluntarios recorren muchas millas para recoger donaciones y hacer visitas domiciliarias individuales, todo en el espíritu de la caridad cristiana. Cada dólar donado a San Vicente de Paúl, excepto los gastos de almacén y conferencias nacionales, va directamente a apoyar a las familias más necesitadas de nuestra comunidad. De la misma manera, todas las donaciones de alimentos no perecederos, artículos para el hogar y muebles van únicamente a aquellas familias que califican.

El almacén, ubicado en 2115 West 25th Street, está abierto los martes y jueves, de mediodía a 3:00 p.m. Durante ese tiempo, distribuimos muebles, artículos para el hogar, artículos de tocador y alimentos no perecederos. También aceptamos donaciones en ese momento. Cualquier correspondencia debe dirigirse a P.O. Box 951 Anderson, IN 46015. Se recogerán muebles útiles si nos llama al 642-5401 y deja un mensaje. Siempre son bienvenidos a visitar el almacén durante las horas en que estamos abiertos.

Nuestro trabajo continuado depende de sus donaciones. Gracias por su ayuda el año pasado y por favor, considere ayudarnos nuevamente este año.
