OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

Last week's bulletin column by Fr. Matthew outlined the progress on one of our Pastorate Vision Plan (PVP) strategies. This particular strategy calls for the development of a more effective and vigorous preparation process for the baptism of children (outside the RCIA process.) We will be sharing more information on the other PVP strategies in upcoming bulletins. Stay tuned!

Meanwhile, let me share my plan for an adult faith formation series during the Lenten Season. It is being presented in support of the National Eucharistic Revival, an ongoing process in the U.S. Catholic Church which concludes on Pentecost, June 8, 2025. The series will overlap in some ways with the recent series presented by Fr. Matthew.

My working title, "Eucharist as Verb," is based on the importance, for all Catholics, of full, conscious, and active participation in the Mass. In the 1960's, the Second Vatican Council based its reform of the liturgy on the need for this full, conscious, and active participation. Some believe that we still have a long way to go before we approach that goal.

We will consider how we participate in the Eucharist, and how we can better participate in the Eucharist, and a third question: "What does the Eucharist do?" Maybe we can define or describe the Eucharist ("as noun") as the Real Presence of the Body and Blood of Christ, although I don't think that definition or description says enough.

In any case, if we can say what the Eucharist IS, can we say what the Eucharist DOES?

If we have a better understanding of what the Eucharist DOES ("Eucharist as verb"), then we may be able to participate in the Eucharist more fully, actively, and consciously.

The sessions will take place on the five Wednesdays of Lent between Ash Wednesday and Holy Week (February 21st through March 20). They will be presented twice each Wednesday, from 1:00 to 2:30 pm at St. Ambrose and from 7:00 to 8:30 pm at St. Mary Alexandria. Look for more information in the bulletin and on our website in the near future.

We welcome Deacon Ed Boes, who will be preaching at the Anderson city parishes this weekend and at St. Mary Alexandria next weekend. He will be sharing information about The Third Option, a program presented in our diocese which is aimed at building better marriages.

PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE TOM...

La columna del boletín de la semana pasada del P. Matthew describió el progreso de una de nuestras estrategias del Plan de Visión del Pastorado (PVP). Esta estrategia particular exige el desarrollo de un proceso de preparación más efectivo y vigoroso para el bautismo de niños (fuera del proceso de RICA). Compartiremos más información sobre las otras estrategias de PVP en próximos boletines. ¡Manténganse al tanto!

Mientras tanto, permítanme compartirles mi plan para una serie de formación en la fe para adultos durante la temporada de Cuaresma. Se presenta en apoyo del Avivamiento Eucarístico Nacional, un proceso en curso en la Iglesia Católica de EE. UU. que concluye en Pentecostés, el 8 de junio de 2025. La serie tendrá algunas cosas en común con la serie reciente presentada por el P. Mateo.

Mi título provisional, "Eucaristía como verbo", se basa en la importancia, para todos los católicos, de la participación plena, consciente y activa en la Misa. En la década de 1960, el Concilio Vaticano Segundo basó su reforma de la liturgia en la necesidad de esta participación plena, consciente y activa. Algunos creen que todavía nos queda un largo camino por recorrer antes de acercarnos a ese objetivo.

Consideraremos cómo participamos en la Eucaristía y cómo podemos participar mejor en la Eucaristía, y una tercera pregunta: "¿Qué hace la Eucaristía?" Quizás podamos definir o describir la Eucaristía ("como sustantivo") como la Presencia Real del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo, aunque no creo que esa definición o descripción diga lo suficiente.

En cualquier caso, si podemos decir qué ES la Eucaristía, ¿podemos decir qué HACE la Eucaristía?

Si comprendemos mejor lo que HACE la Eucaristía ("Eucaristía como verbo"), entonces podremos participar en la Eucaristía de manera más plena, activa y consciente.

Las sesiones se llevarán a cabo los cinco miércoles de Cuaresma entre el Miércoles de Ceniza y la Semana Santa (del 21 de febrero al 20 de marzo). Se presentarán dos veces cada miércoles, de 1:00 a 2:30pm en St. Ambrose y de 7:00 a 8:30pm en St. Mary Alexandria. **La serie se presentará únicamente en inglés.**

Damos la bienvenida al diácono Ed Boes, quien predicará **en las misas en inglés** en las parroquias de la ciudad de Anderson este fin de semana y en St. Mary Alexandria el próximo fin de semana. Él compartirá información sobre La Tercera Opción, un programa presentado en nuestra diócesis que tiene como objetivo construir mejores matrimonios. **Esta serie también se presentará únicamente en inglés.**

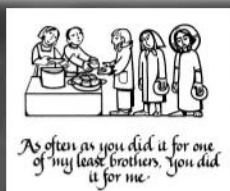

The Office of Pastoral Planning has been visiting with pastorates as they finish the first year of living out their Pastorate Vision Plans. The goal is to celebrate the many fruits and blessings that have taken place in the pastorate over the course of the past year. The One Year Review process begins with a meeting of the Missionary Pastor, members of the Pastorate Leadership Team and members of the Pastorate Pastoral Council. They are asked to evaluate each of their goals and identify if they are on track, if they've made adjustments, if there are fruits that have come from implementing

the goal and milestones and if they are in need of any chancery support. These onsite meetings have been guided by the Holy Spirit; often times it helps to take a step back from the daily tasks to hear from multiple people about impact and encounters with Our Lord and one another.

Another part of the review process includes asking the parish to consider how they are living out the fourteen different elements of the Uniting in Heart 2030 plan. The goal of this preparation is to help the team discern the ways the Lord is working in their pastorate and celebrate together!

Two members of the Office of Pastoral Planning travel on behalf of Bishop Doherty, Missy Krockover and Katie Herzing, to visit with each Pastorate Pastoral Council and discuss the following five questions:

1. What are some of the blessings that your pastorate has experienced while carrying out the Pastoral Vision Plan?
2. What are some insights that you have gained that will be helpful for the future?
3. What are some of the challenges that your pastorate experienced as it worked to implement your Pastoral Vision Plan?

4. Which areas of your plan are the most important for years 4 and 5?
5. What other areas of Uniting in Heart 2030 could your pastorate engage in for years 4 and 5?

After the onsite Pastorate Pastoral Council meeting the fruits, blessings, insights, challenges, and any requests for support are shared with Bishop Doherty, the Uniting in Heart Core Team, and other Chancery staff as requested.

To share these blessings with the entire diocese, we will have a feature story highlighting one of their fruits and blessings in *The Catholic Moment* this upcoming year. You will also see a feature for each pastorate in this space in your bulletin during the upcoming year. Additionally, the Communications Team will post these One Year updates on the diocesan website below the pastorate's original Pastorate Vision Plan at this link: <https://dol-in.org/uih-pvp>. We hope this will spark the Holy Spirit in you to celebrate your neighboring pastorates, join another pastorate for a future event, or even bring a new ministry or outreach effort to your pastorate!

La Oficina de Planificación Pastoral ha estado visitando a los pastores mientras terminan su primer año de vivir los Planes de Visión Pastoral. El objetivo es celebrar todos los frutos y bendiciones que han tenido lugar en el pastorado, a lo largo de este año pasado. El proceso de Revisión de un Año comienza con una reunión del Pastor Misionero, los miembros del Equipo de Liderazgo del Pastorado y los miembros del Consejo Pastoral del Pastorado. Se les pide que evalúen los resultados de cada uno de los objetivos marcados a principios de año, e identifiquen si van por buen camino. Si han hecho ajustes, si es que se han obtenido frutos de la implementación de las nuevas

metas, y si necesitan algún apoyo extra de la cancillería. Estas reuniones presenciales han sido guiadas por el Espíritu Santo; Muchas veces ayuda dar un paso atrás en las tareas diarias para escuchar a varias personas sobre el impacto y los encuentros con Nuestro Señor y entre nosotros.

Otra parte del proceso de revisión incluye pedir a la parroquia que considere cómo están viviendo los catorce elementos diferentes del plan *Uniting in Heart 2030*. El objetivo de esta preparación es ayudar al equipo a discernir las formas en que el Señor está trabajando en su pastorado y celebrar juntos.

Dos miembros de la Oficina de Planificación Pastoral (Missy Krockover y Katie Herzingviajan) viajan en nombre del Obispo Doherty y visitan cada Consejo Pastoral para discutir las siguientes preguntas:

- 1-¿Cuáles son algunas de las bendiciones que su pastorado ha experimentado al llevar a cabo el Plan de Visión Pastoral?
- 2-¿Cuáles son algunos de los conocimientos que ha adquirido que serán útiles para el futuro?
- 3-¿Cuáles son algunos de los desafíos que experimentó su pastorado mientras trabajaba para implementar su Plan de

Visión Pastoral?

4-¿Qué áreas de su plan son las más importantes para los años 4o y 5o?

5-¿En qué otras áreas de *Uniting in Heart 2030* podría participar su pastorado durante los años 4o y 5o?

Después de la reunión del Consejo Pastoral de cada Pastorado, los frutos, las bendiciones, las ideas, los desafíos y cualquier solicitud de apoyo que se haya recogido, se comparten con el Obispo Doherty, el Equipo Central de *Uniting in Heart* y el personal de la Cancillería.

Para compartir estas bendiciones con toda la diócesis, tendremos un artículo que resalte los frutos y bendiciones obtenidas en "El Catholic Moment", este próximo año. También encontrará una característica de cada pastorado en este espacio en su boletín durante el próximo año. 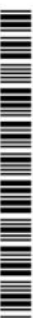

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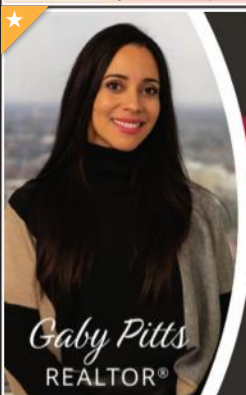
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
