OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

“Establish a Pastorate Team to respond to the call of Pope Francis to enhance our care of God’s beautiful creation on the part of our parishes, schools, students, and parishioners.”

This is one of the strategies included in the Pastorate Vision Plan (PVP) for the Anderson-Alexandria Pastorate. The committee consists of eight members from the three parishes in our pastorate, and I’m the staff liaison for the committee.

Most committees which are addressing PVP strategies will go out of existence after their work is completed. The “Care for Creation Committee,” however, is responsible for forming a continuing team to environmental issues in and through the Pastorate in an ongoing way. I anticipate that some of the current members will continue as members of the ongoing team, but we will probably be looking for other members of our parishes to join. This includes more Hispanic members, some of whom have a special connection with God’s creation as professional landscapers.

The current committee will also work on upgrading our recycling processes, developing more environmentally friendly policies and procedures in the pastorate, and education of themselves and our parishioners (especially related to Catholic teaching on the environment and caring for creation).

We recently had our first meeting and gave ourselves a couple of tasks: The team members will research websites devoted to faith communities (Catholic or otherwise) which have ministries dedicated to the environment and/or care for creation. We will choose the best of these websites, and from them we will learn more about these committees or ministries as we consider how to form our ongoing team.

I will also find resources for the study of *Laudato Si’*, the encyclical letter written by Pope Francis in 2015 on “Care for Our Common Home.” (This encyclical teaches that the care for our environment is not simply a political or social issue over which conservatives and liberals argue. It is an essential part of the mission of the Catholic Church.)

I’m sharing this information, first, to inform everyone in the Pastorate of the progress on this strategy, and, second, to invite the participation of anyone who is interested. We would not mind adding a few members.

PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE TOM...

“Establecer un Equipo Pastoral para responder al llamado del Papa Francisco para mejorar nuestro cuidado de la hermosa creación de Dios por parte de nuestras parroquias, escuelas, estudiantes y feligreses”.

Esta es una de las estrategias incluidas en el Plan de Visión del Pastorado (PVP) para el Pastorado Anderson-Alexandria. El comité está formado por ocho miembros de las tres parroquias de nuestro pastorado y yo soy el enlace del personal del comité.

La mayoría de los comités que abordan estrategias de PVP dejarán de existir una vez finalizado su trabajo. El “Comité de Cuidado de la Creación”, sin embargo, es responsable de formar un equipo continuo para abordar las cuestiones ambientales en y a través de la Pastoral de manera continua. Me imagino que algunos de los miembros actuales continuarán como miembros del equipo actual, pero probablemente buscaremos que otros miembros de nuestras parroquias se unan. Esto incluye a más miembros hispanos, algunos de los cuales tienen una conexión especial con la creación de Dios como jardineros profesionales.

El comité actual también trabajará para mejorar nuestros procesos de reciclaje, desarrollar políticas y procedimientos más respetuosos con el medio ambiente en el pastorado y la educación de ellos mismos y de nuestros feligreses (especialmente en relación con la enseñanza católica sobre el medio ambiente y el cuidado de la creación).

Recientemente tuvimos nuestra primera reunión y nos asignamos un par de tareas: los miembros del equipo investigarán sitios web dedicados a comunidades de fe (católicas o no) que tengan ministerios dedicados al medio ambiente y/o al cuidado de la creación. Elegiremos los mejores de estos sitios web y de ellos aprenderemos más sobre estos comités o ministerios mientras consideramos cómo formar nuestro equipo permanente.

También encontraré recursos para el estudio de *Laudato Si’*, la carta encíclica escrita por el Papa Francisco en 2015 sobre “El cuidado de nuestra casa común”. (Esta encíclica enseña que el cuidado de nuestro medio ambiente no es simplemente una cuestión política o social sobre la cual conservadores y liberales discuten. Es una parte esencial de la misión de la Iglesia Católica).

Comparto esta información, primero, para informar a todos en el Pastorado sobre el progreso de esta estrategia y, segundo, para invitar a la participación de cualquiera que esté interesado. No estaría de más añadir algunos miembros.

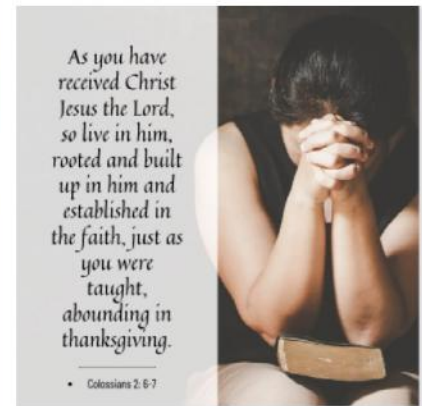
