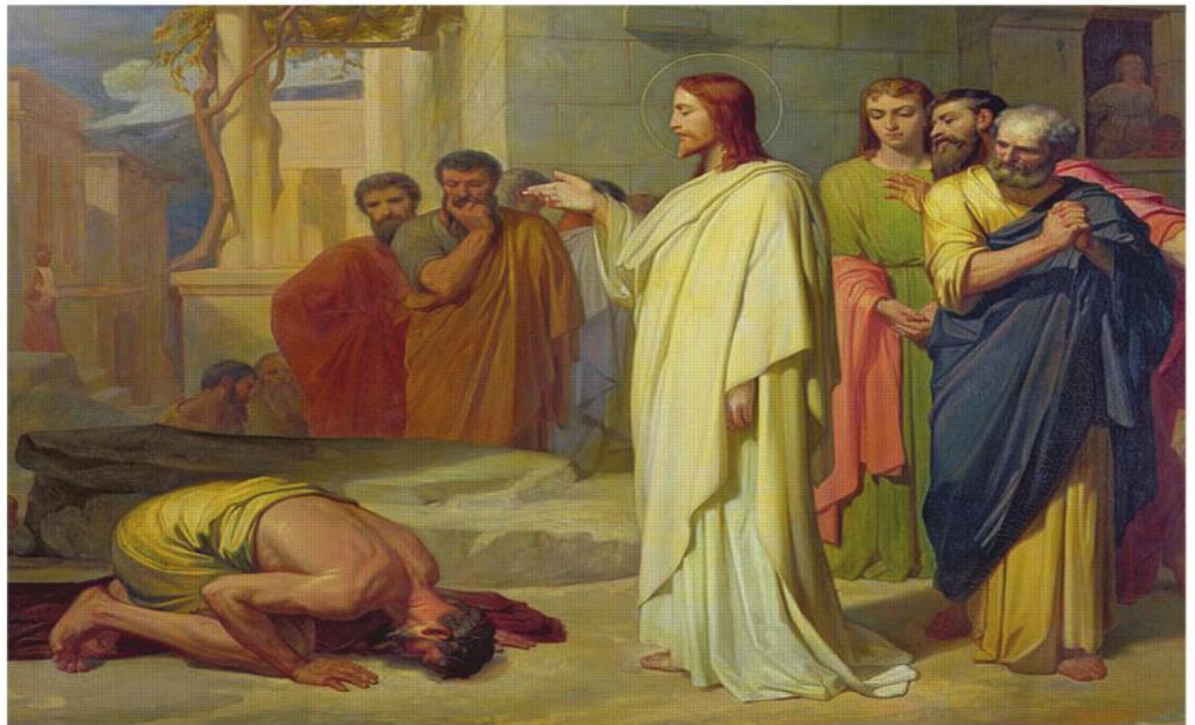

OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

The Season of Lent begins this Wednesday, and there are seven Ash Wednesday Masses in the Pastorate: Two at each parish and one at Ascension St. Vincent Hospital. (Check the bulletin for the schedule.)

During the Lenten Season, there will be a few simple changes to our weekend Masses. Two of these changes happen every year. Due to the more solemn tone of the Lenten season, we don't sing (or recite) the Glory to God or the Alleluia (Gospel acclamation) during the Lenten Season. In fact, we don't use the "A-word" at all during the liturgies of Lent.

We will also conclude our Masses in silence, instead of singing a hymn during the departure of the priest and altar servers. This will also reinforce the tone of solemnity that is essential to the Lenten season.

(During the Advent season, through a miscommunication, the Masses at St. Mary Alexandria began and concluded in silence. I've been asked why this change was implemented, and the question was sometimes accompanied by the observation that this kind of liturgical practice might make more sense during Lent. That observation was on target!)

Silence during (or at the end of) Mass can be a very rich and sacred experience, but it may take some spiritual discipline for that to be the case. It can be very easy, when there is no concluding hymn, to begin putting on coats and gathering possessions so we can exit the pew as soon as the priest is past us.

But during that 30-45 seconds as the altar servers and priest walk down the middle aisle, it doesn't take much more effort to remain silent, to allow the Mass just experienced to take root in us, and to prepare ourselves to go forth on mission.

On a completely different note, I want to offer my gratitude, and my Mom's, to all those who sent her cards on the occasion of her 99th birthday. She received over 150 cards from many different locations, and from many people she has never met (and never will) who were so kind to send such lovely greetings. At my most recent visit with her, I took a quick pass through the cards, and was pleased to see so many from our parishioners here in Anderson and Alexandria.

PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE TOM...

El Tiempo de Cuaresma comienza este miércoles y habrán siete misas de Miércoles de Ceniza en el Pastorado: dos en cada parroquia y una en el Hospital Ascension St. Vincent. (Consulte el boletín para saber el horario).

Durante la temporada de Cuaresma, habrá algunos cambios simples en nuestras misas de fin de semana. Dos de estos cambios ocurren cada año. Debido al tono más solemne de la Cuaresma, no cantamos (ni recitamos) el Gloria a Dios o el Aleluya (aclamación del Evangelio) durante la Cuaresma. De hecho, no utilizamos la "palabra A" en absoluto durante las liturgias de Cuaresma.

También concluiremos nuestras misas en silencio en lugar de cantar un himno durante la salida del sacerdote y los monaguillos. Esto también reforzará el tono de solemnidad que es esencial para la temporada de Cuaresma.

(Durante la temporada de Adviento y debido a una falta de comunicación, las misas en St. Mary Alexandria comenzaron y concluyeron en silencio. Me preguntaron por qué se implementó este cambio, y la pregunta a veces fue acompañada por la observación de que este tipo de práctica litúrgica podría tener más sentido durante la Cuaresma. ¡Esa observación fue acertada!)

El silencio durante (o al final de) la misa puede ser una experiencia muy rica y sagrada, pero puede que se requiera cierta disciplina espiritual para que ese sea el caso. Puede ser muy fácil, cuando no hay un himno final, comenzar a ponernos los abrigos y reunir nuestras pertenencias para poder salir del banco tan pronto como el sacerdote pase junto a nosotros.

Pero durante esos 30 a 45 segundos mientras los monaguillos y el sacerdote caminan por el pasillo central, no nos cuesta mucho más esfuerzo permanecer en silencio, para permitir que la misa que acabamos de vivir se arraigue en nosotros y para prepararnos para seguir adelante. en misión.

Pasando a otro tema completamente diferente, quiero expresar mi gratitud y la de mi mamá a todos aquellos que le enviaron tarjetas con motivo de sus 99 años. Recibió más de 150 tarjetas de muchos lugares diferentes y de muchas personas que nunca había conocido (y que nunca conocerá) que fueron tan amables de enviarle saludos encantadores. En mi visita más reciente con ella, leí rápidamente las tarjetas y me complació ver a tantas de nuestros feligreses aquí en Anderson y Alexandria.

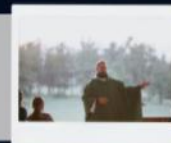

ASH WEDNESDAY - A DAY OF FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

As in years past when this has been the case, no dispensation will be extended regarding the Ash Wednesday fast or abstinence from meat per Bishop Doherty. It is his hope that the faithful might begin Lent with the appropriate focus on and welcome of Christ's saving work.

Fasting is obligatory from age 18 until age 59 (unless medically unable to fast). When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meatless meal, as well as two smaller meatless meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted.

El ayuno es obligatorio desde los 18 hasta los 59 años (a menos que médicamente no se pueda ayunar). No está permitido comer entre comidas.

On the five Wednesdays of Lent following Ash Wednesday, Fr. Tom will present “EUCCHARIST IS A VERB,” a series on the Eucharist not only as the Real Presence of Christ, but as the action of the Church (and Christ) in which we are called to actively participate. There will be a mix of history, theology, Scripture discussion, and faith sharing.

The sessions will be from 1:00 to 2:30 at St. Ambrose (Assembly Hall) and from 7:00 to 8:30 pm at St. Mary Alexandria (Zimmer Hall, in the church basement; park on the north side of the building). The dates are February 21 and 28, and March 6, 13, and 20.

If you have a personal missal, a Magnificat or other “Mass guide,” bring it, but if not, you don’t need to purchase one. The sessions will be conducted in English only.

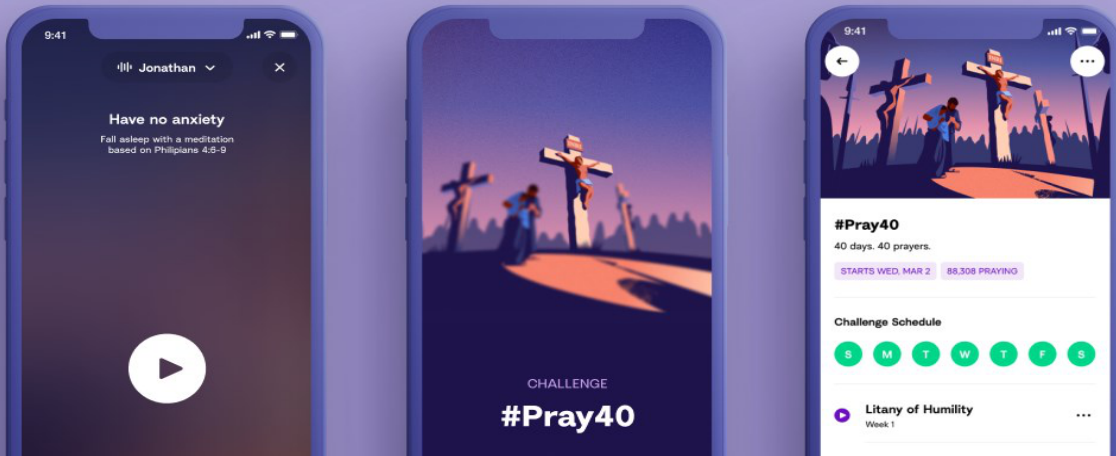
