OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

Last year, about halfway through Lent, I asked someone what they were doing for Lent. The response was, "I haven't really decided yet."

Maybe some of us haven't really decided yet. Here are some guidelines.

The actual rules for Lent are minimal: On the Fridays of Lent, Catholics are to abstain from eating meat. That's it!

But Catholics are called to make personal choices to embrace the three categories of Lenten practice (prayer, sacrifice, and works of charity). "Giving something up for Lent" is only one of three.

Sacrifice: Besides the popular option of chocolate or sweets, consider screen time, alcohol, meat, coffee, "recreational shopping," tobacco, soft drinks, snacks, fast food or restaurant meals, or desserts. Making sacrifices might mean consuming less, not totally abstaining from something, for example, three days a week without television.

Giving up some sinful habit (cursing, gossip, complaining, etc.) doesn't count! Giving up cursing for Lent implies that when Easter comes, the cursing can resume! Trying to counteract a sinful habit should be happening 365 days of the year, not just 40.

Prayer: Most of us struggle to keep a holy and healthy habit of daily prayer. So in this area, setting a reachable goal is important. If you're likely to fall short of praying the rosary every day, resolve to pray a decade a day. If daily Mass is not feasible, perhaps attending Mass one or two days between Sundays is a better option. Take a small step, and aim for building a habit. ("More and better prayer" is a practice that should continue into the Easter season and through the year!)

Works of Charity: For me, this is the hardest area to choose a sustainable practice. For others, it's the easiest. "Works of charity" means more than being nicer (although that's better than the alternative!). Options include making monetary donations to a worthy charity, with part of the donation coming from money saved on "sacrificed" items, like fast food or alcohol. Other options: Reconnecting with old friends, phone calls or visits to homebound members of the parish or community, volunteering with a community organization (again, with long-term, post-Lent continuity in mind), picking up litter in your neighborhood or a park, or donating food, clothing, or household items to an appropriate organization.

Lent has begun, but it's less than a week old. There's still time to choose your practices of sacrifice, prayer, and charity.

PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE TOM...

El año pasado, aproximadamente a mitad de la Cuaresma, le pregunté a alguien qué estaban haciendo durante la Cuaresma. La respuesta fue: "Realmente aún no lo he decidido".

Quizás algunos de nosotros aún no lo hayamos decidido realmente. A continuación doy algunas pautas.

Las verdaderas reglas de la Cuaresma son mínimas: los viernes de Cuaresma, los católicos deben abstenerse de comer carne. ¡Eso es todo!

Pero los católicos están llamados a tomar decisiones personales para abrazar las tres categorías de la práctica de la Cuaresma (oración, sacrificio y obras de caridad). "Renunciar a algo durante la Cuaresma" es sólo uno de tres.

Sacrificio: además de la opción popular del chocolate o los dulces, considere el tiempo frente a la pantalla, el alcohol, la carne, el café, las "compras recreativas", el tabaco, los refrescos, los refrigerios, la comida rápida o en restaurantes, o los postres. Hacer sacrificios puede significar consumir menos, no abstenerse totalmente de algo; por ejemplo, tres días a la semana sin televisión.

¡Renunciar a algún hábito pecaminoso (maldecir, chismear, quejarse, etc.) no cuenta! Dejar de maldecir durante la Cuaresma implica que cuando llegue la Pascua, ¡las maldiciones se pueden reanudar! Tratar de contrarrestar un hábito pecaminoso debería realizarse los 365 días del año, no sólo durante 40 días.

Oración: La mayoría de nosotros luchamos por mantener un hábito santo y saludable de oración diaria. Por eso, en esta área, es importante establecer una meta alcanzable. Si es probable que no pueda rezar el rosario todos los días, decídase a rezar una década al día. Si la misa diaria no le es posible, tal vez asistir a Misa uno o dos días entre los domingos sea una mejor opción. De un pequeño paso y apunte a desarrollar un hábito. ("¡Más y mejor oración" es una práctica que debe continuar durante la temporada de Pascua y durante todo el año!)

Obras de caridad: Para mí, este es el ámbito más difícil para elegir una práctica sostenible. Para otros, es lo más fácil. "Obras de caridad" significa más que ser más amable (¡aunque eso es mejor que la alternativa!). Las opciones incluyen hacer donativos monetarios a una organización benéfica digna, y que parte de la donación provenga del dinero ahorrado en artículos "sacrificados", como comida rápida o alcohol. Otras opciones: reconectarse con viejos amigos, llamadas telefónicas o visitas a miembros de la parroquia o comunidad confinados en sus hogares, ser voluntario en una organización comunitaria (nuevamente, teniendo en mente la continuidad a largo plazo después de la Cuaresma), recoger basura en su vecindario o en un parque, o donar alimentos, ropa o artículos para el hogar a una organización apropiada.

La Cuaresma ha comenzado, pero además hace menos de una semana. Todavía está a tiempo de elegir sus prácticas de sacrificio, oración y caridad.

Father John Riccardo to lead Pastors and Leadership Team Formation Day on February 26: "The Answer to the Question"

Well-known for his work with The Rescue Project, Father Riccardo, a Catholic apostolate and priest of the Archdiocese of Detroit since 1996, has over 20 years of experience in parish ministry. He currently serves as the executive director of ACTS XXIX; a mission he founded in 2019, with the hope of helping transform the Church

by proclaiming the Gospel to all in a new and compelling way.

Comprised of missionaries, ACTS XXIX is a 501(c)3, that seeks to help renew the Church through four missions: The Rescue Project, reviving and equipping clergy, leadership immersives and leveraging media and events.

Father Riccardo's visit to the diocese speaks to the diocese's mission of Uniting in Heart (UiH) through the three pillars of Mission, Community and Witness.

Father Riccardo, with help from Mary Guilfoyle, will be leading a Diocesan Leadership Day for all parish leaders and active priests and deacons throughout the diocese. The title of the session is, "The Answer to the Question." One hundred and eighty-six people are registered for this day event. Those leaders are Bishop Doherty and his Operations Team, Pastors and Administrators, all active priests and permanent deacons, principals, high school presidents, chaplains, directors of operation and evangelization, commonly referred as Pastor and Leadership team

members (PLT). Each pastorate has a Leadership team.

Guilfoyle said the intent of the day is to share with those who have gathered the essentials they have found that help bring transformation to the Church. "We hope that those who come will leave with a new way of making decisions, a desire to be reconfigured for apostolic leadership and to be fired up anew for the mission we were all born for," she said. "We're looking forward to being with all of you!"

Father Riccardo once said, "The single greatest need in the Church is a compelling and attractive proclamation of the Gospel." In this way Acts XXIV aligns well with Uniting in Heart's Vision for leadership. Our teams are looking forward to the opportunity to learn from a Father Riccardo and his team as we strive to be apostolic in our mission to share the message of Jesus Christ with all.

El Padre John Riccardo dirigirá el Día de Formación de Pastores y Equipos de Liderazgo el 26 de febrero: "La respuesta a la pregunta"

Conocido por su trabajo con *The Rescue Project* (Proyecto Rescate), el Padre J. Riccardo, apóstol católico y sacerdote de la Arquidiócesis de Detroit desde 1996, tiene más de 20 años de experiencia en el ministerio parroquial. Actualmente es director ejecutivo de ACTS XXIX; una misión que fundó en 2019 con la esperanza de ayudar a transformar la Iglesia, proclamando el Evangelio a todos

de una manera nueva y convincente.

Compuesta por misioneros, ACTS XXIX es una 501(c)3, que busca ayudar a renovar la Iglesia a través de cuatro misiones importantes: El Proyecto Rescate, Revivir y equipar al clero, Inmersiones de liderazgo y Aprovechamiento de los medios y eventos.

La visita del padre Riccardo a la diócesis habla de la misión de la diócesis de Unidos en el Corazón (UiH) a través de los tres pilares: Misión, Comunidad y Testimonio.

El Padre Riccardo, con la ayuda de Mary Guilfoyle, dirigirá un Día de Liderazgo Diocesano para todos los líderes parroquiales, sacerdotes y diáconos activos en toda la diócesis. El título de la sesión será: "La respuesta a la pregunta". 186 personas están ya inscritas en esta jornada de trabajo. Entre los líderes se encuentran el obispo Doherty y su equipo de operaciones, pastores y administradores, todos sacerdotes activos y diáconos permanentes. Directores, presidentes de escuelas secundarias, capellanes, directores de operaciones y evangelización, comúnmente conocidos

como pastores, y miembros del equipo de liderazgo (PLT). Cada pastorado tiene un equipo de Liderazgo.

Guilfoyle comentó que la intención del día será compartir con todas las personas que han reunido elementos esenciales que ayudan a transformar la Iglesia cada día. "Esperamos que quienes vengán se vayan con una nueva forma de tomar decisiones, un deseo de reconfigurarse para el liderazgo apostólico y de estar renovados para la misión para la que todos nacimos", - dijo. "¡Estamos deseando estar con todos ustedes!".

El padre Riccardo una vez dijo que: "La mayor necesidad de la Iglesia era una proclamación convincente y atractiva del Evangelio". De esta manera, Hechos XXIV se alinea bien con la visión de liderazgo de Unidos en el Corazón. Nuestros equipos esperan tener la oportunidad de aprender del Padre Riccardo y su equipo mientras nos esforzamos por ser apóstoles en nuestra misión de compartir el mensaje de Jesucristo con todos.
