OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

This will be the last weekend in the Anderson-Alexandria Pastorate for Fr. Matthew Jakupco, who will move to his new assignment at St. Mary Cathedral in Lafayette on Wednesday, June 19.

As much as anyone in the pastorate, I was very disappointed to learn that Fr. Matthew would be leaving us. And you can believe me when I say that I did everything I could to keep this change from happening. You can also make your own conclusions about the amount of influence I have with diocesan leadership!

I can remember my first assignment, which has some elements in common with that of Fr. Matthew. I was assigned to St. Mary Anderson (before the concept of “Pastorate” existed, when there were three priests and two deacons at this one parish alone). It was inconceivable to me that a good, warm, supportive relationship could exist between a newly ordained Associate Pastor and a Pastor who was in his sixties.

Functional, yes. Non-adversarial, yes. Warm and supportive? I had a hard time imagining that. I’m sure much of that was due to my lack of imagination.

The roles were reversed this time, and I am very pleased that I don’t have to use my imagination now that I am the Pastor in his sixties. “Warm and supportive” is a good way of describing the relationship between Fr. Matthew and me. (Now, don’t expect too much emotion here....”Warm and supportive” is about as sentimental as I get!)

We had a good working relationship, we were good housemates, and I’ll go out on a limb to say that we developed a real friendship. And while the old priest may be expected to mentor the young priest, I learned plenty from Fr. Matthew.

I know that Fr. Matthew will be missed here at St. Ambrose, St. Mary Alexandria, St. Mary Anderson, St. Mary School, and Holy Cross School. And I know that I can promise, on behalf of all of you, many prayers for Fr. Matthew Jakupco.

On the same day that Fr. Matthew leaves, Fr. Christian DeCarlo will be arriving. Fr. DeCarlo will live in the rectory at St. Mary in Alexandria and is looking forward to fully engaging in ministry here in the Anderson-Alexandria Pastorate. You’ll be hearing more about (and from) Fr. DeCarlo soon. For now, join me in offering him a warm welcome!

Me asignaron a St. Mary Anderson (antes de que existiera el concepto de “Pastorado”, cuando había tres sacerdotes y dos diáconos solo en esta parroquia). Para mí era inconcebible que pudiera existir una relación buena, cálida y de apoyo entre un pastor asociado recién ordenado y un pastor de unos sesenta años.

Funcional, sí. No contenciosa, sí. ¿Cálida y solidaria? Me costó mucho imaginar eso. Estoy seguro de que mucho de eso se debió a mi falta de imaginación.

Esta vez los papeles se invirtieron y estoy muy contento de no tener que usar mi imaginación ahora que soy el pastor y tengo sesenta y tantos años. “Cálida y solidaria” es una buena manera de describir la relación entre el P. Matthew y yo. (Ahora, no espere usted demasiada emoción aquí... ¡“Cálido y comprensivo” es lo más sentimental a lo que llego yo!)

Teníamos una buena relación de trabajo, éramos buenos compañeros de casa y me arriesgaría a decir que desarrollamos una verdadera amistad. Y si bien se puede esperar que el sacerdote anciano sea el mentor del sacerdote joven, aprendí mucho del P. Matthew.

Sé que extrañaremos al P. Matthew aquí en St. Ambrose, St. Mary Alexandria, St. Mary Anderson, St. Mary School y Holy Cross School. Y sé que puedo prometer, en nombre de todos ustedes, muchas oraciones por el P. Matthew Jakupco.

El mismo día que el P. Matthew se va, el P. Christian DeCarlo llegará. P. DeCarlo vivirá en la rectoría de St. Mary en Alexandria y espera participar plenamente en el ministerio aquí en el Pastorado de Anderson-Alexandria. Escuchará más sobre (y de parte de) el P. DeCarlo pronto. ¡Por ahora, únase a mí para ofrecerle una cálida bienvenida!
