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OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

Our Pastorate Leadership Team took part in a two-day "working retreat" on June 12-13, guided by Sandi Patel, a diocesan consultant to parishes and pastorates.

Who is the Pastorate Leadership Team and what do we do?

I'll answer the simplest question first. The Pastorate Leadership Team is made up of Buddy LeRose, our Director of Operations; Christine Vincent-Rodas, our Director of Evangelization; our two Principals (Rachel Duckworth, St. Mary's, and Rob Frey, Holy Cross); Associate Pastor Fr. Matthew Jakupco (now succeeded by Fr. Christian DeCarlo); and me.

What do we do? In its two years of existence, the team has struggled with that very question. We have not functioned as effectively as we wanted to, and we needed to refocus and reprioritize. With Buddy preparing to retire and Fr. Matthew being succeeded by Fr. DeCarlo, this transition period seemed like the opportune time to address this need.

We have developed a purpose statement, and, although it may simply sound like a formal or flowery statement that won't really have an impact, we will be using this statement to determine how we function, how we work together, and what we seek to accomplish. Along with this, we are also acknowledging what we won't be doing and what our responsibilities are not. Here is our Purpose Statement:

"We, the Pastorate Leadership Team seek to model Christ as servant leaders in our discernment, ministry support, and stewardship for the Anderson-Alexandria Pastorate, to proclaim the Gospel and help build the Kingdom of God."

Notice that we call this our Purpose Statement, not our Mission Statement. Our Pastorate and its parishes, schools and ministries already have a mission, expressed well in the commandment given by the Risen Christ to his disciples: "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." (Matthew 28:19-20)

The team's mission, which is the Pastorate's mission, is expressed in the preceding words. But the team has a particular purpose in helping our Pastorate and all its subgroups to fulfill that mission.

You may not feel very "enlightened" by this basic description. I will be sharing more in the future, as I also share more information on our Pastorate's current financial challenges.

PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE TOM..

Nuestro equipo de liderazgo pastorado participó en un "retiro de trabajo" de dos días los días 12 y 13 de junio, guiado por Sandi Patel, una consultora diocesana para parroquias y pastorados.

¿Quiénes son el Equipo de Liderazgo Pastorado y qué hacemos?

Responderé primero a la pregunta más sencilla. El Equipo de Liderazgo Pastorado está compuesto por Buddy LeRose, nuestro Director de Operaciones; Christine Vincent-Rodas, nuestra Directora de Evangelización; nuestros dos Directores (Rachel Duckworth, de St. Mary's, y Rob Frey, de Holy Cross); el Pastor Asociado Padre Matthew Jakupco (ahora sucedido por el Padre Christian DeCarlo); y yo.

¿Qué hacemos? En sus dos años de existencia, el equipo ha luchado con esa misma pregunta. No hemos funcionado tan efectivamente como queríamos y necesitábamos reenfocarnos y replantear prioridades. Con Buddy preparándose para jubilarse y el Padre Matthew siendo sucedido por el Padre DeCarlo, este período de transición parecía el momento oportuno para abordar esta necesidad.

Hemos desarrollado una declaración de propósito y, aunque pueda sonar simplemente como una declaración formal o florida que no tendrá un impacto real, utilizaremos esta declaración para determinar cómo funcionamos, cómo trabajamos juntos y qué buscamos lograr. Junto con esto, también estamos reconociendo lo que no haremos y cuáles no son nuestras responsabilidades. Aquí está nuestra Declaración de Propósito:

"Nosotros, el Equipo de Liderazgo Pastorado, buscamos modelar a Cristo como líderes servidores en nuestro discernimiento, apoyo ministerial y administración para la Pastorado de Anderson-Alexandria, para proclamar el Evangelio y ayudar a construir el Reino de Dios."

Nótese que llamamos a esto nuestra Declaración de Propósito, no nuestra Declaración de Misión. Nuestra Pastorado y sus parroquias, escuelas y ministerios ya tienen una misión, bien expresada en el mandamiento dado por Cristo Resucitado a sus discípulos: "Vayan, pues, y hagan discípulos de todas las naciones, bautizándolos en el nombre del Padre, y del Hijo, y del Espíritu Santo, enseñándoles a observar todo lo que les he mandado. Y he aquí, yo estoy con ustedes todos los días, hasta el fin del mundo." (Mateo 28:19-20)

La misión del equipo, que es la misión de la Pastorado, se expresa en las palabras precedentes. Pero el equipo tiene un propósito particular en ayudar a nuestra Pastorado y todos sus subgrupos a cumplir esa misión.

Puede que no te sientas muy "iluminado" por esta descripción básica. Compartiré más en el futuro, así como más información sobre los desafíos financieros actuales de nuestra Pastorado.

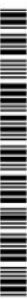

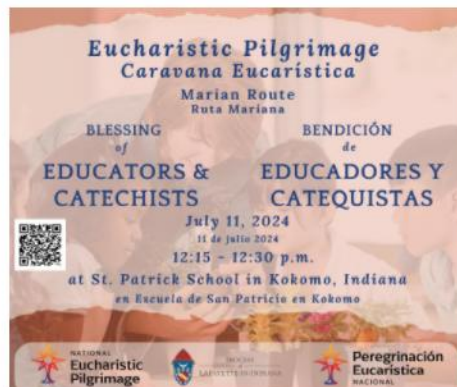
