OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

Some of you know of the Pastorate's Care for Creation Committee. It was inspired by the 2015 encyclical letter of Pope Francis, "Laudato Si," designated in English as "On Care for Our Common Home." It is a fruit of the Pastorate Vision Plan, which called for the establishment of "a Pastorate Team to respond to the call of Pope Francis to enhance our care of God's beautiful creation on the part of our parishes, schools, students, and parishioners."

The committee's first project is called "Recycle Weekend." We are starting small, although Recycle Weekend will take place in all three parishes in the Pastorate and has the potential of involving many parishioners.

The project is simple: At St. Ambrose, St. Mary Alexandria, and St. Mary Anderson parishes, on October 26-27, we will be collecting cans for recycling before and after all the Masses. (That's all!)

Some parishioners already have curbside recycling service, and some do not. This is not an attempt to replace that service. And for those who DO have curbside recycling, holding back their cans to recycle at church might be a worthwhile inconvenience.

The main purpose of the project is not to raise money, although we will raise a little! Of the funds paid by the recycling company, 70% will be allocated to our two schools, and 30% will go to support the work of the Care for Creation Committee.

The main purpose, however, is simply to introduce the committee and its purpose to the Pastorate, and to begin the process of self-education in the Pastorate about how the care of God's creation is part of our God-given mission as Church.

There are some rules: Cans should be rinsed, crushed if possible, and securely bagged, with aluminum and other metal cans bagged separately.

We will need parishioners who can provide a truck and/or trailer at each parish and deliver the cans to the recycling center on Monday, October 28. We will also need volunteers to help load the cans into the trucks/trailers.

We will be actively recruiting these volunteers soon, but if you want to volunteer now (or if you would like to get involved in this committee), call your parish office.

I conclude with the first words of the prayer of Saint Francis, "Laudato Si": *"Praise be to you, my Lord, through our Sister, Mother Earth, who sustains and governs us."*

PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE TOM..

Algunos de ustedes ya conocen el Comité de Cuidado de la Creación del Pastorado. Se inspiró en la carta encíclica del Papa Francisco de 2015, "Laudato Si", designada en español como "Sobre el cuidado de la casa común". Es fruto del Plan de Visión Pastoral, que pedía el establecimiento de "un Equipo Pastoral para responder al llamado del Papa Francisco de mejorar nuestro cuidado de la hermosa creación de Dios por parte de nuestras parroquias, escuelas, estudiantes y feligreses."

El primer proyecto del comité se llama "Fin de semana de reciclaje". Estamos comenzando poco a poco, aunque el Fin de Semana de Reciclaje se llevará a cabo en las tres parroquias del Pastorado y tiene el potencial de involucrar a muchos feligreses.

El proyecto es simple: en las parroquias de St. Ambrose, St. Mary Alexandria y St. Mary Anderson, del 26 al 27 de octubre, antes y después de todas las misas, estaremos recolectando latas para reciclaje. (¡Eso es todo!)

Algunos feligreses ya cuentan con un servicio de reciclaje en la acera y otros no. Este no es un intento de reemplazar ese servicio. Y para aquellos que SÍ tienen reciclaje en la acera, retener sus latas para reciclarlas en la iglesia podría ser un inconveniente que vale la pena.

El objetivo principal del proyecto no es recaudar dinero, ¡aunque sí juntaremos un poco! De los fondos pagados por la empresa de reciclaje, el 70% se destinará a nuestras dos escuelas y el 30% se destinará a apoyar el trabajo del Comité de Cuidado de la Creación.

El objetivo principal, sin embargo, es simplemente presentar el comité y su propósito al Pastorado, y comenzar el proceso de autoeducación en el Pastorado sobre cómo el cuidado de la creación de Dios es parte de nuestra misión dada por Dios como Iglesia.

Hay algunas reglas: las latas deben enjuagarse, aplastarse de ser posible y embolsarse de forma segura; las latas de aluminio y las de otro metal deben embolsarse por separado.

Necesitaremos feligreses que puedan proporcionar un camión y/o remolque en cada parroquia y entregar las latas al centro de reciclaje el lunes 28 de octubre. También necesitaremos voluntarios para ayudar a cargar las latas a los camiones/remolques.

Pronto reclutaremos activamente a estos voluntarios, pero si desea ofrecerse desde ahora (o si desea participar en este comité), llame a su oficina parroquial.

Concluyo con las primeras palabras de la oración de San Francisco, "Laudato Si": *"Alabado seas, mi Señor, por nuestra hermana, la Madre Tierra, que nos sostiene y gobierna"*.

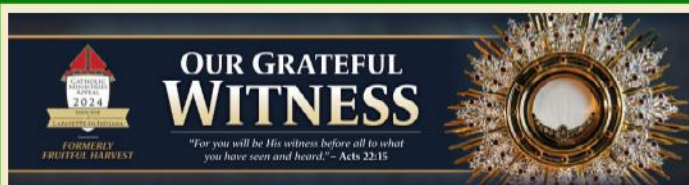

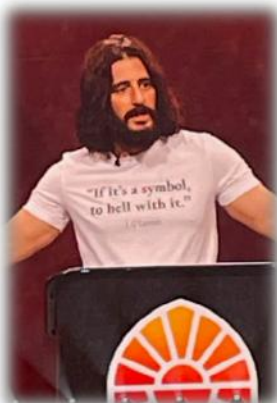
