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OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

Today I continue last week's discussion of the Sacraments of Initiation. For 1900 years, the norm was that these sacraments were received in this order: Baptism, then Confirmation, then First Eucharist.

In 1910, Pope St. Pius X lowered the age of First Communion to age 7. (It had been celebrated as late as age 14.) St. Pius made this change to encourage more frequent reception of Holy Communion. But he didn't mandate a lower Confirmation age.

So the norm (for us) of Baptism, then First Eucharist, then Confirmation, is actually a novelty, against the backdrop of 2000 years of history.

The Second Vatican Council, the worldwide gathering of all Catholic Bishops from 1963 to 1965, called for the restoration of the "catechumenate." This was the process in the early church that prepared adults for the Sacraments of Initiation. Today we know this process as the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, through which we prepare adults for Baptism, then Confirmation, and then First Communion. This usually takes place during the Easter Vigil Mass on Holy Saturday night.

There are many valid ways to understand the word "adult," but the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults applies to anyone **OVER THE AGE OF SEVEN YEARS**, which is generally considered the age of reason.

So now we have two different forms for baptizing children. For a child under age seven, we celebrate the Rite of Infant Baptism. After infant baptism, First Communion is celebrated at about age seven, and Confirmation comes later.

Children aged seven or older are baptized, then confirmed, and then receive First Communion, almost always at the same Mass, following the original order of the celebration of these sacraments.

So we have two different approaches to the Sacrament of Confirmation. They are not contradictory, but they do have different emphases. In the RCIA process, Confirmation is the "seal," or "finishing touch" of Baptism, leading to the Eucharist. For most children baptized as infants (under the age of seven), Confirmation, celebrated after First Communion, is emphasized as the completion of the sacramental initiation process.

Confusing and messy? Yes! But it's a tension we must live with - and a tension which can bring us to a deeper understanding of this sacrament.

And we congratulate Nathan, Cindy, Mia, and Nora Trueblood, who celebrate the Sacraments of Initiation this weekend at St. Mary, Alexandria!

PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE TOM..

Hoy continúo con la discusión de la semana pasada sobre los Sacramentos de Iniciación. Durante 1900 años, la norma era que estos sacramentos se recibieran en este orden: Bautismo, luego Confirmación, y luego Primera Eucaristía.

En 1910, el Papa San Pío X redujo la edad de la Primera Comunión a los 7 años (se había celebrado hasta los 14 años). San Pío hizo este cambio para alentar la recepción más frecuente de la Sagrada Comunión. Pero no ordenó una edad más baja para la Confirmación.

Por lo tanto, la norma (para nosotros) del Bautismo, luego la Primera Eucaristía y luego la Confirmación, es en realidad una novedad, en el contexto de 2000 años de historia.

El Concilio Vaticano Segundo, la reunión mundial de todos los obispos católicos de 1963 a 1965, pidió la restauración del "catecumenado". Este era el proceso en la iglesia primitiva que preparaba a los adultos para los Sacramentos de Iniciación. Hoy conocemos este proceso como el Rito de Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos, mediante el cual preparamos a los adultos para el Bautismo, luego la Confirmación y luego la Primera Comunión. Esto generalmente tiene lugar durante la Misa de Vigilia Pascual en la noche del Sábado Santo.

Hay muchas maneras válidas de entender la palabra "adulto", pero el Rito de Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos se aplica a cualquier persona **MAYOR DE SIETE AÑOS**, que generalmente se considera la edad de la razón.

Así que ahora tenemos dos formas diferentes para bautizar a los niños. Para un niño menor de siete años, celebramos el Rito del Bautismo Infantil. Después del bautismo infantil, la Primera Comunión se celebra alrededor de los siete años, y la Confirmación viene más tarde.

Los niños de siete años o más son bautizados, luego confirmados y luego reciben la Primera Comunión, casi siempre en la misma misa, siguiendo el orden original de la celebración de estos sacramentos.

Así que tenemos dos enfoques diferentes para el Sacramento de la Confirmación. No son contradictorios, pero sí tienen diferentes énfasis. En el proceso de RICA, la Confirmación es el "sello" o "toque final" del Bautismo, que conduce a la Eucaristía. Para la mayoría de los niños bautizados cuando eran bebés (menores de siete años), la Confirmación, celebrada después de la Primera Comunión, se enfatiza como la finalización del proceso de iniciación sacramental.

¿Confuso y desordenado? ¡Sí! Pero es una tensión con la que debemos vivir, y una tensión que puede llevarnos a una comprensión más profunda de este sacramento.

¡Y felicitamos a Nathan, Cindy, Mia y Nora Trueblood, quienes celebran los Sacramentos de Iniciación este fin de semana en St. Mary, Alexandria!

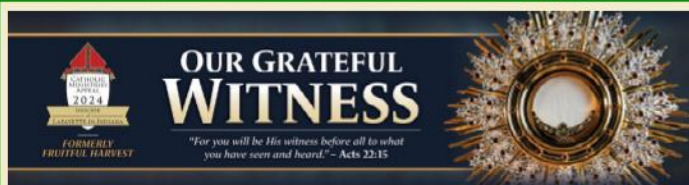
