OFF THE TOP OF MY HEAD...

Last Monday, the priests of the diocese took part in a “formation day” devoted to the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, which is the updated version of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. The most obvious update may be in the name, and therefore the abbreviation. (Now, “RCIA” is “OCIA.”)

One of the suggestions made by the presenter was to avoid using either “official” title or abbreviation in our parishes. He referred to one of the pastorates in our diocese which uses “Why Be Catholic?” as the title for their process of preparing adults for initiation into the Catholic Church through Baptism, Confirmation, and First Eucharist. That’s a topic to discuss here in the Anderson-Alexandria Pastorate.

The updated translation of the original Latin term is not all that important, and there are no dramatic changes to the process itself, although there are some changes. These will be implemented in a gradual way in the months (and possibly years) to come.

Meanwhile, I want to emphasize one particular element of the updated process is this statement, regarding the Church’s expectations of adults who are preparing for baptism, or “catechumens.” Those who become catechumens are responsible to participate in the Liturgy of the Word with the community, and to “continually purify their motivation for baptism, live an upright life, and be ready to witness to their conversion to Christ....”

The presenter made the point that those preparing for baptism, who have the responsibility to share their personal experience of faith in Christ, should therefore be formed, or “trained” to become evangelists.

And if those preparing for baptism have the responsibility to evangelize, all the more do we who are baptized share in that responsibility. And if catechumens should be formed as evangelists, we baptized Catholics should certainly be equipped to evangelize, or share the good news of Jesus Christ. You may remember our three-year Pastorate Vision Plan, now in its second year. We accomplished many of the Year One strategies, but others not been addressed. One of the latter is to adopt a program in the Pastorate to equip our parishioners to share the good news of Jesus Christ. I hope we do not lose this strategy as we move forward.

Even without this strategy in the Plan, the Rite (or Order) of Christian Initiation of Adults calls all of us to be evangelists. How are we doing?

PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE TOM...

El lunes pasado, los sacerdotes de la diócesis participaron en un “día de formación” dedicado al Ritual de Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos, que es la versión actualizada del Rito de Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos. La actualización más obvia puede estar en el nombre, aunque la abreviatura (en español), RICA, sigue siendo la misma,

Una de las sugerencias hechas por el presentador fue evitar el uso de títulos o abreviaturas “oficiales” en nuestras parroquias. Se refirió a uno de los pastorados de nuestra diócesis que usa “¿Por qué ser católico?” como título para su proceso de preparación de adultos para la iniciación en la Iglesia Católica a través del Bautismo, la Confirmación y la Primera Eucaristía. Ese es un tema para conversar aquí en el Pastorado Anderson-Alexandria.

La traducción actualizada del término original en latín no es tan importante, y no hay cambios dramáticos en el proceso en sí, aunque hay algunos cambios. Estos se implementarán de manera gradual en los próximos meses (y posiblemente años).

Mientras tanto, quiero enfatizar un elemento particular del proceso actualizado: esta declaración sobre las expectativas de la Iglesia respecto de los adultos que se están preparando para el bautismo, o “catecúmenos”. Aquellos que se convierten en catecúmenos son responsables de participar en la Liturgia de la Palabra con la comunidad y de “purificar continuamente su motivación para el bautismo, vivir una vida recta y estar listos para dar testimonio de su conversión a Cristo....”. El presentador señaló que quienes se preparan para el bautismo, quienes tienen la responsabilidad de compartir su experiencia personal de fe en Cristo, deben por lo tanto ser formados o “entrenados” para convertirse en evangelistas.

Y si quienes se preparan para el bautismo tienen la responsabilidad de evangelizar, con mayor razón nosotros, los bautizados, compartimos esa responsabilidad. Y si los catecúmenos deben ser formados como evangelistas, nosotros, los católicos bautizados, ciertamente debemos estar equipados para evangelizar, o compartir la buena noticia de Jesucristo. Tal vez recuerden nuestro Plan de Visión Pastoral de tres años, ahora en su segundo año. Logramos muchas de las estrategias del Año Uno, pero otras no se han abordado. Una de estas últimas es adoptar un programa en el Pastorado para equipar a nuestros feligreses para compartir la buena noticia de Jesucristo. Espero que no perdamos esta estrategia a medida que avancemos.

Incluso sin esta estrategia en el Plan, el Rito (o Ritual) de Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos nos llama a todos a ser evangelizadores. ¿Cómo nos está yendo con eso?

Food Pantry

In 1967, a St. Vincent de Paul Society soup kitchen volunteer watched a single mother rummage for food in a dumpster behind a grocery store to feed her children. That year, St. Mary's Basilica in Phoenix, AZ lent him \$3000 to open a place for unwanted food to be distributed instead of thrown into dumpsters. The nation's first Food Bank was born. Today there are over 61,000 food pantries and meal programs; about half are faith-based organizations.

The need is still great. We serve a variety of people here at St. Mary - some are newly unemployed for the first time in their lives. Some are trying to stretch social security or disability checks. Some are homeless and cook over open fires. Many are single mothers. They're struggling with rent, food and often medicine. As of the end of October, this year we have served 4,443 people from the pantry, and 5,385 people from our twice-a-month drive through.



FOOD MINISTRIES

It can seem overwhelming and we might look around and echo the disciples - send these people away to get some food! The miracle of feeding the five thousand is the only of Jesus' miracles recorded in all four Gospels. We are probably supposed to pay attention! A child shared his lunch and, somehow, there was abundance. Our God calls us to mighty deeds! YOU have answered that call, and miracles continue to happen. We are open more hours than any other food pantry in Madison County.

It's time to prepare our Thanksgiving baskets to give away. \$50 enables us to get supplies for a family to have a nice meal. We try to meet the needs of people who are cooking in crock pots or don't have much, if any, freezer space. Thank you for your help! Whatever you can do directly helps our neighbors here in Anderson. It makes a difference. YOU make a difference! Thank you, and God bless us all!

Despensa de Alimentos

En 1967, un voluntario del comedor de beneficencia de la Sociedad de San Vicente de Paúl observó a una madre soltera buscar comida en un contenedor de basura detrás de una tienda de comestibles para alimentar a sus hijos. Ese año, la Basílica de Santa María en Phoenix, Arizona, le prestó \$3000 para abrir un lugar donde distribuir alimentos no deseados en lugar de tirarlos a los contenedores de basura. Nació el primer Banco de Alimentos del país. Hoy en día existen más de 61,000 despensas de alimentos y programas de alimentación; aproximadamente la mitad son organizaciones religiosas.

La necesidad sigue siendo grande. Atendemos a una variedad de personas aquí en St. Mary; algunos están desempleados por primera vez en sus vidas. Algunos están tratando de estirar los cheques de seguridad social o de discapacidad. Algunos no tienen hogar y cocinan al aire libre. Muchas son madres solteras. Están luchando con el alquiler, la comida y, a menudo, con las medicinas. Hasta finales de octubre, este año hemos atendido a 4,443 personas desde la despensa y a 5,385 personas desde nuestro evento "drive through" que se lleva a cabo dos veces al mes.

Puede parecer abrumador y podríamos mirar a nuestro alrededor y hacernos eco de lo que dijeron los discípulos: ¡envía a estas personas a buscar algo de comida! El milagro de alimentar a los cinco mil es el único de los milagros de Jesús registrado en los cuatro evangelios. ¡Probablemente significa que debemos prestar atención! Un niño compartió su almuerzo y, de alguna manera, hubo abundancia. ¡Nuestro Dios nos llama a obras poderosas! USTED ha respondido a ese llamado y los milagros continúan ocurriendo. Estamos abiertos más horas que cualquier otra despensa de alimentos en el Condado de Madison.



Bl. Fr. Miguel Agustín Pro, priest and martyr

November 23

Beato Miguel Agustín Pro, sacerdote y mártir

*All you holy men and
women of God, pray for us!*



Blessed Father Miguel Agustín Pro, born in Mexico in 1891, became a Jesuit priest at time when the Catholic Church was under great persecution in his country. Because churches were closed due to harsh anti-clerical laws, he and many other priests were forced to carry out their ministries underground, celebrating Mass clandestinely and visiting the faithful in disguise. On November 23, 1927, Fr. Pro was executed without a trial on trumped-up charges related to a presidential assassination attempt. As he was put before a firing squad, he forgave his captors. As his executioners raised their guns to fire, Fr. Pro outstretched his arms in an imitation of Jesus on the cross and uttered the cry that soon became indelibly linked to the story of his life and death: “*;Viva Cristo Rey!*”—that is, “*Long live Christ the King!*” Pope John Paul II beatified Fr. Pro in 1988 as a Catholic martyr killed “in hatred of the faith.” (*Beatification* is the last step in the process before someone is formally canonized, or declared a saint of the universal Church.)

El Beato Padre Miguel Agustín Pro, nacido en México en 1891, se hizo sacerdote jesuita en un momento en que la Iglesia católica sufría una gran persecución en su país. Iglesias se encontraban cerradas debido a las duras leyes anticlericales, así que el P. Pro y muchos otros sacerdotes se vieron obligados a llevar a cabo su ministerio en secreto; celebraban la misa clandestinamente y se disfrazaban para visitar a los fieles. El 23 de noviembre de 1927, el P. Pro fue ejecutado sin juicio por cargos falsos relacionados con un intento de asesinato presidencial. Cuando fue llevado ante un pelotón de fusilamiento, perdonó a sus captores. Mientras sus verdugos levantaban sus armas para disparar, el P. Pro extendió los brazos, imitando a Jesús en la cruz, y pronunció el grito que pronto quedó indeleblemente ligado a la historia de su vida y muerte: “;Viva Cristo Rey!*” El Papa Juan Pablo II beatificó al P. Pro en 1988 como mártir católico asesinado “por odio a la fe”. (La beatificación es el último paso en el proceso antes de que alguien sea canonizado formalmente, es decir, declarado santo de la Iglesia universal).*




