



The ACA: Frequently Asked Questions

Each week we will answer a question about the ACA!

Q: I already donated earlier this year, why are we being asked to donate again now?

A: If you donated to the ACA prior to May 2025, that donation was applied to the 2024 ACA campaign. We start a new ask every year in May, and any donations between May 1 - April 30 will be applied to that year's campaign, not the new campaign. So while the current ask is titled "2025", it only applies to May 2025 - April 2026.

Q: I already donate to St Vincent de Paul - does that count?

A: No, it does not. Your giving to St Vincent de Paul is not connected to the ACA. It goes directly to St Vincent de Paul Society. The ACA funds the work of the Archdiocese, and any extra money we raise over our parishes' goals will be donated to St Vincent de Paul society, for this year only (2025-2026).
