

A REFLECTION BY FR. HERIC

Dear Friends in Christ,

In July 2024, the Archdiocese of Seattle formed 60 parish families from 136 parishes. This was a milestone in the **Partners of the Gospel** strategic pastoral planning process focused on re-envisioning parish life. As a parish family, we have begun asking ourselves: How can we look at the resources we have – people, properties, finances – and use them to support the mission of Jesus Christ: to go make disciples? How can we ensure this mission remains at the heart of the Catholic Church in Western Washington? Partners in the Gospel is an opportunity to renew our commitment to this mission, while re-envisioning parish life in a new structure.



It's been a year since our parish family formed, and we have made progress in this first phase of our journey focused on welcoming and getting to know each other. I have enjoyed my time getting to know our four parishes and three schools, which all have many gifts to share. Thank you for the welcome you have extended to myself and Fr. Duc, and also Fr. Bob and Fr. Daniel when they serve you. We are grateful to collaborate with all those on our staff, and the lay leaders and volunteers that serve in our parish family. One of our Parish Family Advisory Council (**PFAC**) members, Eric, often reminds me that in the midst of organizational change, which can be difficult, it is very important to celebrate successes. So let me mention a few I see from our first year together.

- The hiring of staff shared by all four parishes has been a great boon to our facilities management, financial services, communications, and liturgy resources, which includes the sharing on occasion of music ministers.
- Our shared sacramental prep programs which helped form about 60 of our children for first **Reconciliation and Eucharist**, 40 of our youth for the sacrament of **Confirmation**, and 23 people who were initiated into the church at **Easter**. The highlight of that was the celebration of a common **Triduum** together with liturgical ministers from all four parishes, and a combined choir of 35 people who led the music in a most wonderful way. Many people commented that this year's combined Triduum was possibly more beautiful than if we held four separate ones as done in the past.



 Our people have by and large accepted the challenges that come with the process of merging our four parishes into one faith community. I am grateful to see a growing number of individuals and families who feel comfortable attending Mass at other parishes beyond their own. Here's to our shared commitment to becoming places of welcome and support for all who join us! May it be so!




