





A REFLECTION BY FR. HERIC

Dear Friends in Christ.

One of the acclamations we offer in the Eucharistic prayer of the Mass goes like this: **"We proclaim your Death, O Lord, and profess your Resurrection until you come again."** This is a poignant reminder of a mystery that is a regular part of our human experience. That suffering and death are part of life, but God will always bring forth new life from these harsh realities. This is no abstraction but a part of everyday people's lives.





Where are we to recognize the signs of resurrection in the midst of this terrible tragedy? Certainly, in the efforts of first responders to do everything they can to look for survivors, and the many people who are coming together to offer support, compassion, and care to those who have suffered such terrible losses. Their extended communities, including those of the church, will be vitally important to help these folks go on with their lives. Finally, the time will come in moments such as this, to celebrate the lives of those who have died, especially the children, and to entrust their precious souls to the heart of the risen Lord, who once more tells us "Come to me all who labor and are burdened and I will give you rest...Do not let your hearts be troubled for I am with you."

SVDP Monthly Report

We helped a 69-year-old neighbor who has been legally blind since birth and has other physical ailments. First, we helped him with a move-in when he was approved for HUD housing in late 2024. Once settled, we were able to help with his request for a "Closed Circuit TV", an electronic magnification device. The Lighthouse for the Blind and an optometrist helped him pick out an appropriate unit. With a cost in the thousands, we asked the SVdP Council Esterman Fund for a grant to purchase the unit and it was approved. AP - Carolyn Breysse cbreysse9@ With nearly herculean effort, the Conference president oversaw the purchase, delivery, and installation of the equipment. The neighbor has reported that it works great for him and STB - Alex Chopyak alex@ has given him the ability to read more easily than every before. Camillus Ministry

Our Camillus ministers are specially trained lay volunteers who work with the hospital chaplains at Seattle Children's Hospital to serve the spiritual needs of Catholic children and their families. We visit the hospital regularly to bring Christ's healing presence to those in need through the Sacrament of the Eucharist, prayers, and a listening ear. The experience for the ministers is uplifting and spiritually fulfilling.

Training consists of a Hospital Ministry course and shadowing a Camillus minister to learn how to minister independently. Ministers must also complete Seattle Children's Hospital and Seattle's Archdiocese requirements.
