

A REFLECTION BY FR. HERIC

Dear Friends in Christ.

One of the things we do every year is to file an annual report to the archdiocese that describes the metrics of our life as a Catholic Community. In working on this report for Fiscal Year 2024-205, I discovered that we celebrated a total of **11 weddings in our four parishes**. That is twice as many as we celebrated in each of the previous 3 years. That's good news and a hopeful trend. If you or someone in your family is becoming engaged to marry, please know that we are glad to offer our support for you to enter this beautiful sacrament. One trend that has grown in recent years is Catholics who choose not to marry in the church. The reasons for this are personal, often involving the desire to celebrate the wedding in another venue that the couple finds more suitable. Still, it is the hope of the Catholic Church that couples bring this important moment to the sacramental life of our community. If you are Catholic but only civilly married, I encourage you to have your marriage **convalidated or blessed** by the church. These are simpler ceremonies, but can be meaningful opportunities for couples to renew their commitment to each other. Contact Kristin above for more information.

Another reality for some people is the painful experience of a marriage ending in **divorce**. We wish to offer compassion and support to the parties going through this, and also encouragement for them to provide for the needs of their children born in the marriage. We are also glad to offer our help to those previously married who wish to marry again in the church, or become Catholic through the sacraments of Initiation. The Dignity of Work and the Rights of Workers: How our Church's rich social doctrine informs today's faith-labor landscape

Some people refer to Catholic Social Teaching as the "best kept secret" of the Catholic Church. Hidden within that "secret" is another unknown reality: the social doctrine of the Church has its foundation in labor and the dignity of working people. In 1891, Pope Leo XIII released Rerum Novarum ("On the Condition of Labor"), the first social encyclical of the Catholic Church. Since then, popes including St. John Paul II and Benedict XVI have continued this emphasis on the dignity of work and the rights of workers to organize for safe and dignified working conditions. As we approach Labor Day in early September, come learn about this principle of Catholic Social Teaching, exploring its historical and theological foundations, as well as the landscape and practice of Church-Labor partnerships today.


Nursery Resumes on September 7 at St. Bridget
