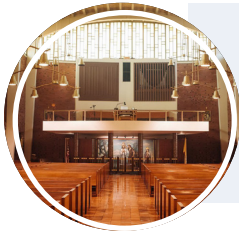

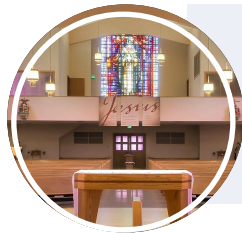

## Liturgy Corner

### Stations of the Cross

The 14 Stations of the Cross adorn the walls of almost every Catholic church and chapel. Many parishes commemorate the Fridays of Lent with a prayerful remembrance of the passion of Christ by walking the stations with him.

Throughout our history, Christians have longed to literally walk in the footsteps of Christ. The shrines of the holy places in and around Jerusalem have drawn pilgrims inspired by the life and death of their master.

However, not everyone is able to travel to the Holy Land. So, ever since the middle ages, churches and chapels began erecting images devoted to an aspect of the passion. By the 15th century, the Franciscans had developed a devotion they called "stations." The word means a place where people stand still or gather together. So even though it implies something "stationary," the service obviously must include the movement of pilgrims following the footsteps of Christ. It took a while to fix the number and the names of the stations, but in 1731 Pope Clement XII established the 14 we know today.

We still find some variations on the number. Many places add a 15th station, for example, the resurrection of Jesus. Discontent with leaving Christ in the tomb when our faith expresses so much more, worshipers have found consolation in completing the story of the cross.

Over the years our church has authorized various versions of the stations for different occasions. For example, Pope John Paul II altered the traditional stations for his Good Friday service in Rome. He eliminated some stations that derived from tradition, and substituted them with events from the Gospels. Here are the stations he used: 1. Jesus in the Garden of Olives; 2. Jesus betrayed by Judas; 3. Jesus condemned to death by the Sanhedrin; 4. Jesus denied by Peter; 5. Jesus judged by Pilate; 6. Jesus flogged and crowned with thorns; 7. Jesus carries his cross; 8. Jesus is helped by Simon of Cyrene; 9. Jesus encounters the women of Jerusalem; 10. Jesus is crucified; 11. Jesus promises the kingdom to the good thief; 12. Jesus on the cross; 13. The mother of Jesus and his disciple at the cross; 14. Jesus is placed in the tomb.

The stations inspire us all to follow Christ through suffering to peace.

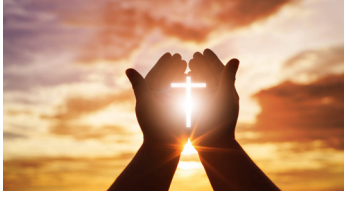

## Camillus Ministry- Catholic Hospital Ministry

Our Camillus ministers are specially trained lay volunteers who work with the hospital chaplains at Seattle Children's Hospital to serve the spiritual needs of Catholic children and their families. We visit the hospital regularly to bring Christ's healing presence to those in need through the Sacrament of the Eucharist, prayers and a listening ear. The experience for the ministers is uplifting and spiritual fulfilling.



Training consists of a Hospital Ministry course and shadowing a Camillus minister to learn how to minister independently. Ministers must also complete Seattle Children's Hospital and Seattle's Archdiocese requirements.

## Homebound Ministry

Our Homebound Ministers bring the Holy Eucharist to those in the NE Family Parish who are unable to attend Mass. This includes our seniors, the sick, and those disabled or recovering from an injury who are living at home or in a local care facility.

Homebound Ministers also provide companionship and serve as an essential link between the homebound and their parish community. This helps those who are unable to attend Mass stay connected with their parish family and allows our Eucharistic Ministers to keep a careful eye on the health and safety of our homebound friends. All of our ministers are trained and certified by the Seattle Archdiocese to work with vulnerable people.

## CRS Rice Bowl

### Stories of Hope: Ghana

One thousand days: From conception to a child's second birthday, every day is vital for their development. But in rural Ghana, poverty prevents access to essential health and nutrition services, causing children to miss critical milestones. This can lead to serious health issues, academic struggles and limited job opportunities in adulthood.

To address this, Catholic Relief Services teamed up with the Sisters of Charity of St. Anne on a project in Walewale, Ghana, to help children up to 3 years old live happy and healthy lives by improving early childhood development. The project began more than four years ago when the sisters met with the chiefs and elders of the community about establishing a space at the Our Lady of Rocio Clinic to provide mothers and children with health education services and early childhood development activities. Today, the space teaches caregivers new ways to support their families, offers mental health services for moms, empowers communities through savings groups and strengthens families to build a brighter future together.

As part of the project, community volunteers were trained in skills like making early learning toys and starting savings and lending groups. Some of the toys the mothers learned to make include sensory shakers crafted from plastic bottles and stones or buttons, and fabric balls from scraps around the home. Sister Yvonne says that a sensory shaker is like music for a child. "It helps the child develop mentally and build muscle strength," she adds. Georgina was one of the first volunteers and is now a lead mother in her community who trains female neighbors in what she has learned. A mother of three, Georgina brings two of her children to the space to learn how to make simple, inexpensive toys that engage children's senses and stimulate learning and development. She says that her children are seeing the benefits.

"They teach them how to count: one, two, three. ABCs," Georgina says. "Compared to those in the house that I live with [who don't attend the space], they are very smart indeed."

Sister Yvonne emphasizes, however, that early childhood development cannot stop at the walls of the center. Mothers must make play spaces at home for their children and volunteers must teach new mothers what they've learned so that this knowledge will spread and other children can thrive.

"This program has helped us change our lives and our children," Georgina says.

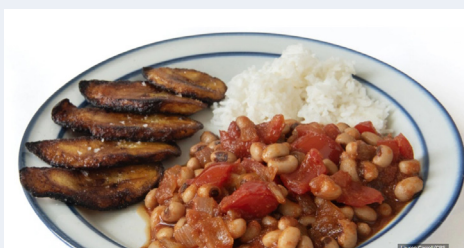


## Lent Recipes

### Red Red Bean Stew - Ghana

**Ingredients:** 2cups canned beans; 1/2cup veg oil; 2 med onions, chopped; 2 cloves of garlic, minced; 1-inch piece of grated ginger; 1-2tbsp tomato paste; 1tsp smoked paprika; 1tsp cayenne pepper; 2 med tomatoes, chopped; salt to taste; 2-3 ripe plantains, peeled & sliced; oil for frying.

**Method:** Drain and rinse the beans. In a large pot over medium heat, heat the veg oil. Add the chopped onions, garlic, and ginger. Saute until fragrant and translucent. Stir in the tomato paste and smoked paprika. Add cayenne pepper. Cook for 2-3min. Add the chopped tomatoes and simmer until the tomatoes break down into a sauce. Add the beans to the stew and mix well. Simmer for another 10-15 min. Season with salt to taste. In a frying pan over medium heat, heat the oil. Sprinkle a pinch of salt over the plantain slices and fry them until golden brown on both sides. Drain on paper towels. Enjoy the stew over rice with the plantains on the side.
