

On an average November day, we welcome 62 shoppers and serve a total of 155 clients. This adds up to approximately 1,100 shoppers and 3,100 clients per month. As you can see, volunteers are essential! There are many ways to help: serving coffee, sorting and organizing donations, or working directly with clients in the clothing rooms
