

A REFLECTION BY FR. HERIC

Dear Friends in Christ,

Two important anniversaries occur this week that are worth noting. The first is the formal celebration on May 31 of a special Mass commemorating the **175th anniversary of the founding of the Catholic Church in Western Washington**. Officially known now as the Archdiocese of Seattle, this milestone reminds us that we belong to a large and diverse history of Catholic faith with a mission to witness to the love of Christ to all in our region. This is not a task we undertake by ourselves, but always as a continuation of the faith lived by generations before our own. Isaac Newton put it well when he said, "If I have seen further than others, it is by standing upon the shoulders of giants."



The other milestone of note this past May 24 is the **10th anniversary of the signing by Pope Francis** of the encyclical **"Laudato Si,"** which spoke of the need to address climate change and to see planet Earth as our common home. As Catholics, along with others, we have a duty and responsibility to do the following:

- 1. **Protect the planet:** This includes responding to the "Cry of the Earth," which focuses on reducing carbon emissions, protecting biodiversity, and ensuring access to clean water for all.
- 2. **Address social justice:** This involves responding to the "Cry of the Poor," advocating for the rights of marginalized communities, and promoting a more equitable distribution of resources.
- 3. **Foster ecological economics:** This emphasizes sustainable production, ethical consumption, and investments that prioritize the well-being of both people and the planet.

These goals are not isolated but rather interconnected, recognizing that environmental degradation and social injustice are deeply intertwined. By working towards these goals, Laudato Si' calls for a holistic approach to creating a more sustainable and just world.

These two anniversaries are not only moments to look back to where we came from, but also to look forward to the future that God's peace and justice calls us to create for ourselves and future generations come. May it be so.

Camillus Ministry

Our Camillus ministers are specially trained lay volunteers who work with the hospital chaplains at Seattle Children's Hospital to serve the spiritual needs of Catholic children and their families. We visit the hospital regularly to bring Christ's healing presence to those in need through the Sacrament of the Eucharist, prayers, and a listening ear. The experience for the ministers is uplifting and spiritually fulfilling.

Training consists of a Hospital Ministry course and shadowing a Camillus minister to learn how to minister independently. Ministers must also complete Seattle Children's Hospital and Seattle's Archdiocese requirements.

The ACA: Frequently Asked Questions

Each week we will answer a question about the ACA!

Q: How are parish ACA goals calculated?

A: Parish goals are calculated based on the past year's giving and how much the parish provides to its school (if it is connected to one). The Archdiocese then has a percentage that is calculated based on its operations costs to support priests, faith formation, and many ministries throughout the Seattle Archdiocese.

Here's an example: Parish Giving \$500,000 minus School Support \$100,000 equals Adjusted Giving \$400,000. Archdiocese percentage: 11.90% of Adjusted Giving, equaling a Parish Goal of \$47,600.

This is why the goals for each parish in our family are different; they take into account the unique communities of each parish and their ability to provide support for the Archdiocese's work.
