A REFLECTION BY FR. HERIC

Dear Friends in Christ,

This Sunday, November 23, the church celebrates the great solemnity of **Our Lord Jesus** Christ, King of the Universe, which ends the church's liturgical year. This is the annual reminder that Christians live by two calendars; the one that orders time by days, weeks and months beginning January 1, and ending Dec. 31; the other one that orders our lives around



the church's various liturgical seasons and feasts, most importantly the weekly celebration of the eucharist. Next Sunday November 30 begins the church's new year with the first Sunday of Advent. The intersection of these calendars is an opportunity St. Augustine of Hippo reminds us of what Christians should do all the seasons of their lives:

- 1. Leave the past in God's mercy. The mistakes, regrets and really bad moments of your life are over. Confess them and move on.
- 2. Leave the future to God's providence. Jesus has promised "I am with you always,". Don't dwell in fear of what might happen, get on with your life.
- 3. Leave the present to God's love which is everlasting. Stay focused on that above all things. You will receive that love when you give it to others.
