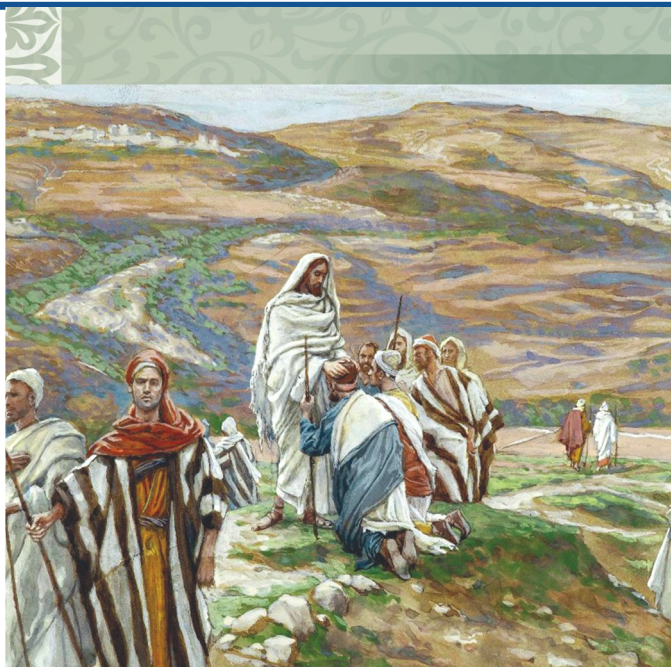

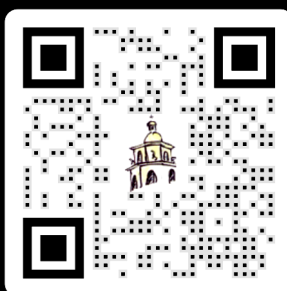

that our “Building Our Church Fund” makes possible many necessary repairs and up-grades on our two Parish campuses?

When we paid-off the mortgage on the “new” church back in 2013, it was decided that we would continue to collect funds for the “Building Our Church Fund” to help care for our aging buildings and grounds, especially unexpected (un-budgeted) repair expenses, as well as providing emergency funding to our foreign Mission partners. (“Our Church” is not simply our Parish – but the Universal Church!)

IF you are an envelope-user (or on-line donor), we take this collection on the Third Sunday of each month! During the past few months, we have been able to install new flooring in *Madonna Hall*, upgrade the computers in our Sound System in the church, repair skylights, and prepare for the resurfacing of the parking lots (probably in October), as well as many other repairs/upgrades - without having to ask for special collections!

We are able to address the needs in a very timely and cost-effective way, because the funds which you provide each month are available with little or no delay!

Our Buildings and Grounds Committee, chaired by *Maryann Hockstad*, meets on the third Tuesday of each month, to assess the needs of repairing and up-grading for our aging facilities, and then recommend various projects to the Parish/Finance Council for approval. The great work of this Committee, in doing long-range assessment and prioritizing planning of repairs and upgrades, as well as reviewing bids and proposals, has saved our Parish many, many thousands of dollars! The Committee, with our great Maintenance Staff ensures the best use of the funds available from the “Building Our Church Fund”! They are great stewards of the Funds which you entrust to them in your monthly donations to the “Building Our Church Fund”!

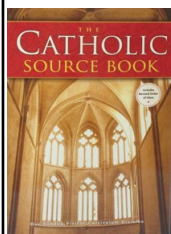
It is your generosity which makes possible the best care and stewardship of the wonderful facilities which are ours at St. Andrews’/Good Shepherd!

An interesting legend about Peter led to a book, and decades later, a movie. As Peter was fleeing Rome during Nero’s persecution, the tradition says, he met Christ going into Rome. ‘*Quo vadis?*’ Peter asked him (Latin for “Where are you going?”) Christ replied, ‘*I am coming to be crucified again for My sheep.*’ Peter, ashamed of abandoning his flock, returned to Rome, where he was crucified on a cross turned up-side down, at his request, because, he said, he was not worthy to be crucified in the same manner as the Lord. The legendary question was used by the Polish author, *Henryk Sienkiewicz*, as the title for an 1895 novel on the life of the early Christians in Rome during Nero’s persecution.

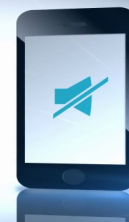

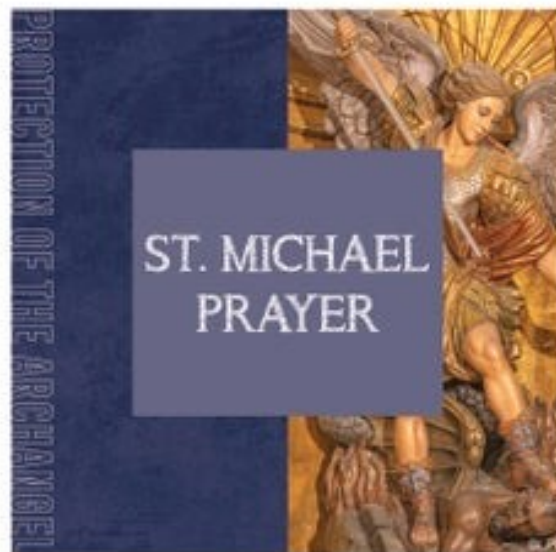

Fr. Greg called the meeting to order at 5:32 p.m. and led the group in an opening prayer. There were no changes or corrections to the May minutes.

**Budget approval:** The Council voted to approve the fiscal year 2026 budget as amended from last month's meeting. Additionally, the capital budget was adjusted down to \$50,000 because of better cost estimates for parking lot repaving and renovations to the Youth Wing.

**Finance** (Kate): Income for May was \$132,865. This includes a bequest from Ed and Margaret Harms. Donations from Good Shepherd Mission totaled \$1,235. Expenses were \$79,508.

The average weekly offering for May was \$17,497. The Parish General Fund level is \$652,729 and the Building Our Church balance is \$90,234.

**Ladies of St Andrew** (Fran): Donations have been steadily coming in for the annual Bazaar. The Ladies received a report from Joan Martin regarding their support of the Haiti Mission.

**Youth Ministry News** (Yvonne): Fundraisers have generated \$5,000 in donations for the Steubenville West conference. A pancake breakfast fundraiser is scheduled within the coming weeks.
