DID YOU KNOW....


"When you look at the priest in your parish, think about *who* you see rather than *what* you see. The *who* is the man that at some stage in his life felt that God wanted him to become a priest. The *who* is the one who knows uncertainty, doubt and disappointment, but one who still finds faith rewarding and ministry his chosen way of life. The *who* is one that appreciates a kind word and absolutely needs the support of your prayers. If we see the priest as *what*, he becomes a function, a dispenser of services and something just to be contacted when a service is required. When JESUS sent out the Twelve, He knew that people needed them just as much as they needed the people. That truth remains unchanged.

Think now of the priests you know, the religious you know, and remember their interactions with you in life. Moments of sadness and grief, moments of uncertainty or fear, or sickness or tension – moments too of celebration and joy, where was he or she? Chances are, very close to you and yours. Maybe when you hear criticism of priests or religious, when you feel it is not justified you could say, 'That hasn't been my experience' – in this, at least, you are acknowledging the path chosen in response to God's call because JESUS noticed people and felt that they needed ministers in their midst. Maybe have a word after Mass; a smile, handshake and, 'Thanks for that, we're glad you are here among us. By the way, I said a prayer for you this weekend.'"

**CATHOLIC QUIZ:**

This week's Question: "What is a 'Chancel'?"

The answer to last week's Question: "What are the 'Steps' to the altar?"

The sanctuary of the church (the altar area) is approached by a series of steps, symbolic of the ascent to Christ. The 'altar platform' is spiritually understood to be a 'mountain top' – recalling Mount Sinai, Mount Carmel, Mount Tabor, the Mount of Olives, and, of course, Calvary. The Latin word for "steps" – 'graduale' – from which we get the English words, 'gradual', 'graduation', 'grade' – gave their name to the Psalm verses sung between the Epistle and the Gospel, as the Deacon or Priest 'ascended' the steps of the altar to proclaim the Gospel, hence in the Missal: 'the Gradual'. (The number of steps is not fixed in liturgical law, but it is usually no less than three – the three altar steps at St. Andrew's are marked with the words "Santos, Santos, Santos" – "Holy, Holy, Holy".)







PADRE KINO RELIC/PRAYER CARDS



With the designation of *Padre Kino, the “Padre on Horseback”* “*The Apostle of the Pimeria Alta*”- as “Venerable” by Pope Francis in 2020, the Kino Heritage Society has been looking for more ways to make better known *Padre Kino*’s name and ‘career’ as a “Bridge-builder” between peoples and cultures!

In order to further the Cause of *Padre Kino*’s beatification, the Kino Heritage Society sought to obtain 3rd Class relics, to be shared through holy cards, inviting his intercession.

After a number of delays and postponements, permission was finally secured, for a very rare opening of the crypt in Magdalena, SON, to allow the placement of several rolls of black ribbon in near proximity to *Padre Kino*’s remains – the ribbon then becoming 3rd Class relics.

This happened on 30 March 2022!

The mausoleum and *Padre Kino*’s remains have been the centerpiece of a very popular pilgrimage every October, drawing crowds from all over southern Arizona, northern Sonora, and the Native American tribal lands – the scene of *Padre Kino*’s apostolic labors for twenty-four years.

The ribbon is cut into small pieces and affixed to holy cards, with the prayer for *Padre Kino*’s beatification. Under Sister Doris Jurgenson, a wonderful ‘team’ assembled these holy cards for distribution in 2022.

We are now in need of VOLUNTEERS to help assemble a new supply of the Relic/Prayer Cards!

Regarding our Live-Stream Masses:



We have been so blessed since the start of the pandemic in March 2020 to offer a live stream of our daily and weekend Masses.


