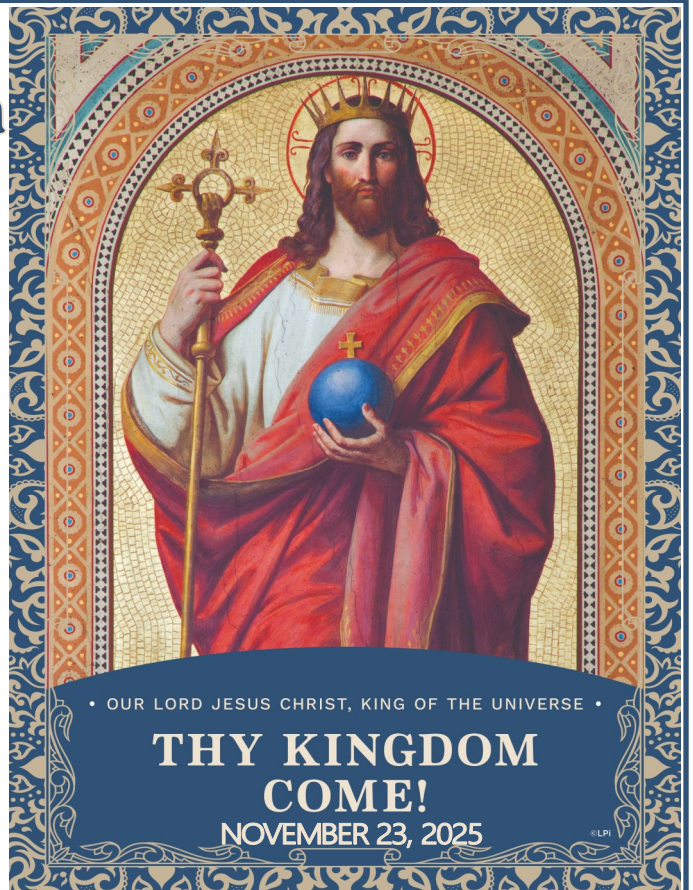

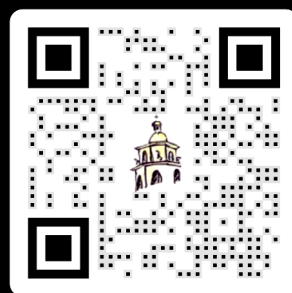

that there are only seven days remaining in the Jubilee Year 2025?

Pope Francis opened the Holy Door at St. Peter's Basilica on the First Sunday of Advent 2024, inaugurating the Jubilee Year "Pilgrims Together in Hope". During this Jubilee Year many of our own parishioners – including our Youth Pilgrims last April and a group who just returned three weeks ago – joined the millions who journeyed to Rome to celebrate the Jubilee!

For those who were not able to make the Pilgrimage to Rome for the Jubilee, each Diocese had designated "Jubilee Churches" where the Faithful could participate in the spiritual benefits of the Jubilee. St. Andrew the Apostle was one of the four churches so designated for our Diocese (which included St. Augustine Cathedral, San Xavier del Bac Mission, and Sacred Heart in Nogales).

Our Divine Mercy Chapel was the focal point of the Jubilee and many Pilgrims from around the Diocese have made a visit during this Year of Grace. There is a Jubilee indulgence granted to those who make such a visit to a "Jubilee Church" and 1) go to Confession, 2) attend Mass and receive Communion, and 3) pray for the special intentions of the Pope.

Please take advantage of this graced opportunity -- offered here in your own Parish church, and participate in the Jubilee as it comes to a close on 29 November!

We will celebrate the national Thanksgiving holiday this coming week.

Join us for the ONE MASS at 10:00 AM on Thanksgiving Day. And before you begin your Thanksgiving dinner, you might go around the table and ask everyone to mention for what or for whom they are most thankful. Then remember in your family prayer your family members and friends who have gone to their rest and those who are not in attendance. Celebrating Thanksgiving for us, Catholics, is to remember with gratitude the Source of all blessings, and to pray for one another, with "an attitude of gratitude."

For Catholics, Thanksgiving is not simply the 4th Thursday of November, it is our approach to all of life! It is our "lifestyle" as a "Eucharistic People"!

"In every circumstance give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ JESUS!" (1 Thessalonians 5:18)

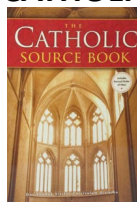

This week's Question: "What is the 'orientation' of a church building?"

The answer to last week's Question: "What is a 'basilica'?"

Originally, one of the seven main churches of Rome, which were housed in a large Roman law courts/administration building (called a 'basilica'- from its architectural style), after the Church emerged from persecution. It was customary to position a basilica over the grave of a martyr.

Much later, 'basilica' became the designation of a major pilgrimage church or otherwise historically/spiritually important church. These are known as "minor basilicas". ("Old Saint Mary's" (1881) in Phoenix is the nearest "basilica.")

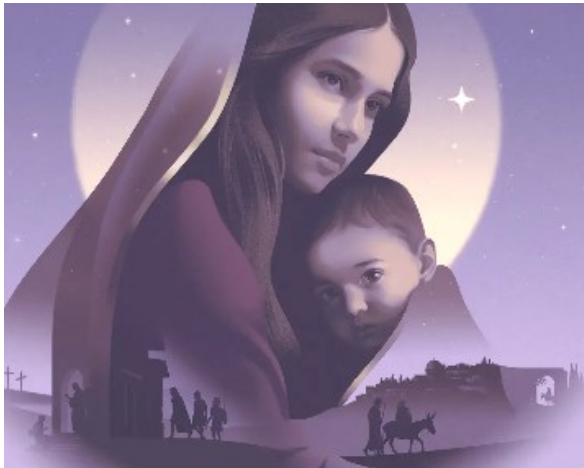

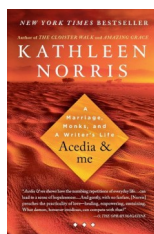

Mi casa ya no es mi casa

Milton tiene 35 años y fue detenido cuando regresaba de llevar a sus hijos a la escuela. Lo detuvo una patrulla alegando que había cometido una infracción por exceso de velocidad. “Nunca he incumplido con las reglas de tránsito. Soy padre de familia y lo menos que quiero en mi vida son problemas” expresa Milton.

Llevaba viviendo desde los 7 años en Estados Unidos. Allí nacieron sus dos hijos y en la ciudad de Tucson construyó una casa cuando contrajo matrimonio hace 10 años con su esposa Azucena. “Mi casa ya no es mi casa. Ahora me espera una realidad que es muy diferente a lo que ha sido mi vida. Me preocupa muchísimo que Azucena tenga que hacerse cargo de todo sola. Ese no era el plan”.

Conversa todas las mañanas con Dios antes de levantarse de la cama. Milton comparte que “Dios es mi mejor amigo de toda la vida, y espero que en estas nuevas circunstancias él recuerde esa amistad que tenemos, porque ahora creo que es lo único que me puede sostener”.

November is National Diabetes Month



- * 38 million people have diabetes in the United States
- * Nearly 1/3 of those over 65 have diabetes BUT it can affect ANY-ONE, including kids
- * Diabetes is the 8th leading cause of death in the United States
- * Diabetes can affect the eyes, kidneys, heart, and feet, among other things
- * Common symptoms include excessive hunger, thirst, and urination, fatigue, blurry vision, and numbness/tingling in hands or feet
- * Risk factors include being overweight—and losing just 10-15 pounds can make a big difference
- * Diabetes can be silent for years or produce only very mild, vague symptoms—therefore, getting checked regularly (especially if you have risk factors or a family history) is very important
- * The A1C test is a 3 month measure of your blood sugar levels and a very reliable way to screen for diabetes
- * Diabetes is a very treatable disease so get checked today!
