DID YOU KNOW....

that Pope Benedict XVI said that “the season of Advent invites us to approach the Mystery of the Incarnation through the faithful response of Mary.”

When the Shepherds and the Wise Men found JESUS, they found Him in the arms of His Mother – this is not a ‘coincidence’.

There are many reminders of Mary’s faithfulness in the art and architecture of our church!

The church bells sound forth the daily Angelus from the “*Ave Maria Tower*” (a gift of the *Knights of Columbus*), while an image of Our Lady of Guadalupe graces the south façade of the church, as well as in the shrine located on the west end of *Kino Hall*, depicting *St. Juan Diego* knelling before the Apparition. Another image of Our Lady of Guadalupe is enshrined above the entrance of *Madonna Hall*. A beautiful statue of Our Lady of Grace stands in the *Memorial Prayer Garden*, and many visit the Shrine to the Holy Family in the south parking lot.

In the Gathering Room of the church is the image of Our Lady Who Unties Knots. The special significance of this image is that ours was only the second dedicated parish shrine to Her in the United States! Pick up a ‘holy card’ and pray the prayer written especially for our Parish’s use!


When you enter the church itself, you see that a Rosary ‘railing’ in cast stone rounds around the whole Sanctuary, a detail repeated in the *Divine Mercy Chapel*. The principal image of Our Lady in the church is the Madonna and Child carved in Oberammergau for the original church, enshrined at the front of the Sanctuary. The image of Our Lady of Guadalupe on the first niche on the east side is paralleled by an image of Our Lady of Mount Carmel on the west side. In the *Divine Mercy Chapel* are images of Our Lady of Perpetual Help, Our Lady of La Vang, and Our Lady of Czestochowa – each important to our Filipino, Vietnamese, and Polish communities!

We are a “Marian” Parish, and we will honor Our Lady’s Immaculate Conception, a Holy Day of Obligation with Masses on Monday, 8 December at 9:00 AM (livestreamed), 12:05 Noon, and 7:00 PM (bi-lingual).

On Thursday, 11 December, we will honor Our Lady of Guadalupe, with the Procession (5:30), Rosary (6:00), and Mass and Mañanitas, bi-lingual Spanish and English Details in the bulletin!

The Simbang Gabi (Filipino Christmas Novena) begins this Saturday evening at 4:00, bi-lingual English and Tagalog! Thank you -- for your love for God, for your love for Our Lady, and, for your love for your Church – and for entering into the spirit of this beautiful Marian Season of Advent!

AND remember to PRAY the *ANGELUS* each day during this Holy Season!


The “West Front” or ‘main entrance’ of churches was the most deliberated and decorated feature of cathedrals and larger churches. This large façade, incorporating the entrance to the building, was thought to represent the gates of heaven. Large windows are typical on its upper face. The “West Front” of St. Andrew’s (actually the north end of the church) features the large ‘Holy Spirit’ window in the upper face, and is, indeed, arranged to suggest large gates – the gates of heaven!



REFLECT

The Advent season is a time in which the Church invites us to prepare our hearts and minds for the second coming of Christ and the memorial of Jesus' birth at Christmas. During this season of preparation, we can ponder the preparations Mary and Joseph were making to welcome the Infant Jesus. The Holy Family found themselves on a journey from Nazareth to Bethlehem when they took refuge in a humble manger and welcomed the Son of God. The Newborn King did not arrive in a palace of riches, but in poverty and simplicity among the livestock.

Today, mothers in our communities find themselves in similar circumstances, unexpectedly pregnant and facing many challenges. Like the Holy Family, they are in great need and in search of a place of refuge to bring their child into the world. They may find themselves alone, scared, and overwhelmed, not knowing where to turn for help and dependent on the kindness and service of others.

The story of the first Christmas should remind us of our call to care for mothers and their children when they are in their hour of need. In assisting a mother

to prepare for the birth of her child, we share in a profound way in preparing for the coming of Christ. In such an act of loving support and encouragement, we recall those who came to aid of the Holy Family and ultimately beheld the Son of God. In helping mothers to welcome their children we can help them to encounter the joy, hope, and peace offered through the advent of the Infant Jesus, seeing in their child, the face of God himself.

ACT (choose one)

- On December 8, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Offer Pope Francis' Prayer for the Immaculate Conception for this month's intention: usccb.org/prayers/pope-francis-prayer-immaculate-conception.
- Contact your local pregnancy resource center or diocesan/parish pregnancy support ministry. Ask about ways you can help, such as volunteering or donating baby items.
- Offer some other sacrifice or prayer that you feel called to do for this month's intention.
