

that we are now in our “countdown” to Christmas and the end of the Year 2025?

This Wednesday evening we will celebrate 4 Masses for Christmas Eve – the *Children’s Mass* at 6:00PM – called the “*Shepherds and Angels Mass*” because families are invited to dress the little ones as either shepherds or angels for Mass. Whether they are actors or actresses in the Children’s Christmas Play or not – they can have their photo taken next to the Manger for Grandma and Grandpa back home! (Based on past experience, we do need to ask parents to ‘disarm’ the wooden staffs from the shepherds during Mass!)

At 6:30 PM we have *Mass at our Good Shepherd Mission* in Whetstone (a great option for those who would like a smaller setting for Mass) which is always so beautiful in its simplicity!

At 9:00PM our *LifeTeens* will give leadership and their musical ‘energy’ to the celebration of Christmas Eve! At 11:00 we will celebrate the *Midnight Mass*, the most solemn and, second only to the Easter Vigil as the most beautiful “Catholic moment” of the year! The Mass setting for the *Midnight Mass* is taken from Masses composed for use in the Franciscan Missions in the early 19th century – truly ‘heavenly music’ sung in our part of the world for over two centuries!

On Wednesday, Christmas Day, we have the 3 Holy Day Masses – at 8:00AM, 10:00AM and 12 Noon (in Spanish)! This is a great time to invite friends and family members who, for whatever reason, have been away from the Church – to “come Home for Christmas!”

The celebration of Christmas is, of course, 12 Days in length, and on the “4th Day of Christmas” – next Sunday, 28 December, we celebrate the “*Feast of the Holy Family*”. It is important to “keep Christ in Christmas” – and it is even more important to keep Christ in the ‘every day’ of our lives!

And remember, one of the best preparations for Christmas is to pray the *ANGELUS* during this holy Season – at 6:00, Noon, and 6:00!

Don’t forget to join us this Sunday evening at 7:00 PM for the 17th annual performance of the Advent and Christmas portions of Handel’s *MESSIAH* here in our own Sanctuary! (Another wonderful preparation for Christmas!)



CATHOLIC QUIZ: This week's Question:



“What is a ‘parochial vicar?’”
The answer to last week’s Question: “How many candles must be on/near the altar?”

The simple answer is at least two. The two candles represent the two Natures of Christ: Divine and Human, because JESUS is the “Light of the World”.

But typically four or six candles, especially for Sunday Mass or a holy day of obligation can be used. The six candles on the retablo (or high altar) recall the seven-branched candelabra in the Jewish Temple, with Christ Himself as the Seventh, again, because He is the Light of the World! Seven-branched candelabra are also used during Eucharistic exposition or adoration, but there is no specific number legislated.

If you would like to be as smart as the “Quiz Master” – pick up a copy of the Catholic Source Book, available in the Parish Office, for only \$15!)

SOUL FOOD:

“Every place the Mass is offered is transformed into a sort of Bethlehem, a place where heaven touches earth, where Christ becomes our food. St. Ephraim (306-373) thus sings: ‘You are, O Church, the everlasting Bethlehem, for within you is the Bread of Life.’”



The Hearing-Impaired device for St Andrews is called AudioFetch. This device is designed to interface between the church audio system and any smartphone. The setup procedure is really straight forward.

Simply follow the procedures listed below:

1. **Install the app on your smartphone. For android devices, go to the Google Play store and search for Audiofetch app and for Apple devices, go to Apple App Store.**
2. **Now ensure that your Bluetooth device (hearing aid, headphones or earbuds) is connected to your smartphone.**
3. **Open the “Settings” app on your smartphone and select “Network & Internet” then select “Wi-Fi”**
4. **Under “Wi-Fi” select “AudioFetchExpress”**
5. **Now select the “AudioFetch” app and wait for it to “Discover” the AudioFetchExpress” wi-fi signal.**
6. **If connected properly, a sound level / volume control bar will appear in the middle of the screen. Use this volume control bar to control the volume level. You can also use the Volume Up or Volume Down buttons on your smartphone to increase or decrease desired volume levels.**
7. **If your smartphone is functioning properly, the “AudioFetchExpress” Wi-Fi network should be saved on your smartphone automatically after first use. As long as your wi-fi setting is always set to “on”, each and every time you return to church, the “AudioFetchExpress” Wi-Fi should connect automatically. You should only have to start the Audiofetch app, referring to #5 and #6 above.**


