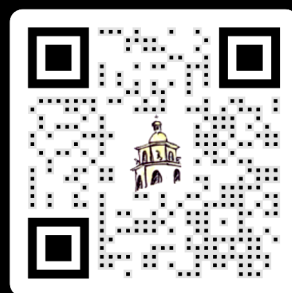

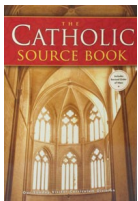
There are so many ways in which our lives and ministry together as a Diocesan Church are impacted by the *Annual Catholic Appeal*!

CATHOLIC QUIZ: This week's Question: "What is a 'Papal (or Apostolic) Bull'?"



The answer to last week's Question: "Who is the 'Black Pope'?" That's the nickname traditionally given to the Superior General of the Jesuits (the Society of JESUS) in recognition of his influence and power within the Church as the head of the largest religious Order! 'Black' refers to the color of his cassock, in contrast to the white cassock traditionally worn by the Pope! (Father Arturo Sosa Abascal, SJ, of Venezuela, was elected the 31st Superior General of the Society of Jesus in 2016.)

The nickname 'Black Pope' today is anachronistic – especially since *Pope Francis* was a member of the Society of JESUS – the first "Jesuit Pope"!

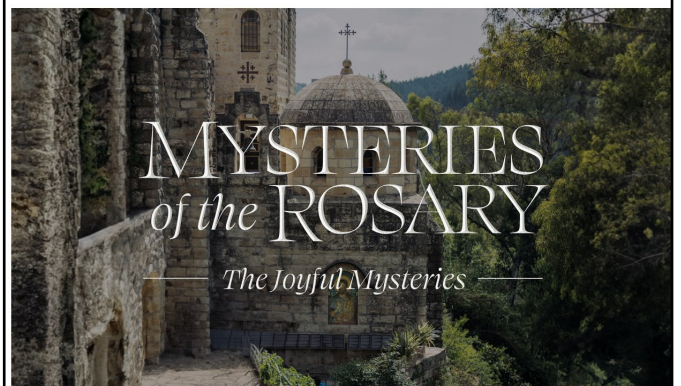

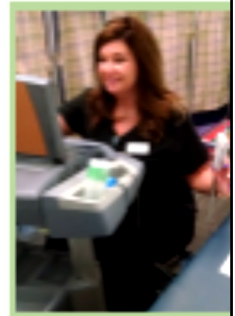
