This week is the feast day of *St. John Marie Vianney*, the Patron Saint of Parish Priests, and you are invited to join them this coming Wednesday at the 12:05 Noon Mass, as they concelebrate the Mass in thanksgiving for the Priesthood! As *St. John Vianney* said: *"Without the Sacrament of Holy Orders, we would not have the Lord present to us in the Eucharist. Who places Him in the Tabernacle? The Priest! 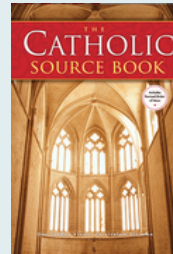

CATHOLIC QUIZ:

This week's question:

"What is the 'Falling Asleep of the Mother of God'?"



The answer to last week's Question: "Did St. Joseph have another wife?"

An ancient tradition, which is accepted by the Eastern Orthodox Churches as authoritative, says that Joseph was an elderly widower with a grown-up family of sons and daughters at the time when he became betrothed to Mary. This account appears in the second-century apocryphal gospel – the *Protoevangelium of James*. This was quoted by the early Christian theologian *Origen*, as well as the Church Father, *St. Clement of Alexandria*, and the early Christian apologist and martyr, *St. Justin*. On the basis of this tradition, the Scriptural references to the "brothers and sisters of the Lord," would refer to the children of St. Joseph's first marriage, who would be the stepchildren of Mary. While the Roman Catholic Church has never made a doctrinal declaration on the matter and proposes that the Aramaic "brothers and sisters of the Lord" applies to cousins as well as siblings, the Eastern Churches hold the understanding of Joseph as a widower with children as the Orthodox belief. In Christian art up until the present time, St. Joseph was usually depicted as an older man, based on this tradition.

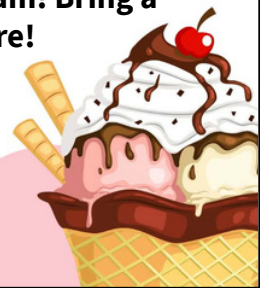

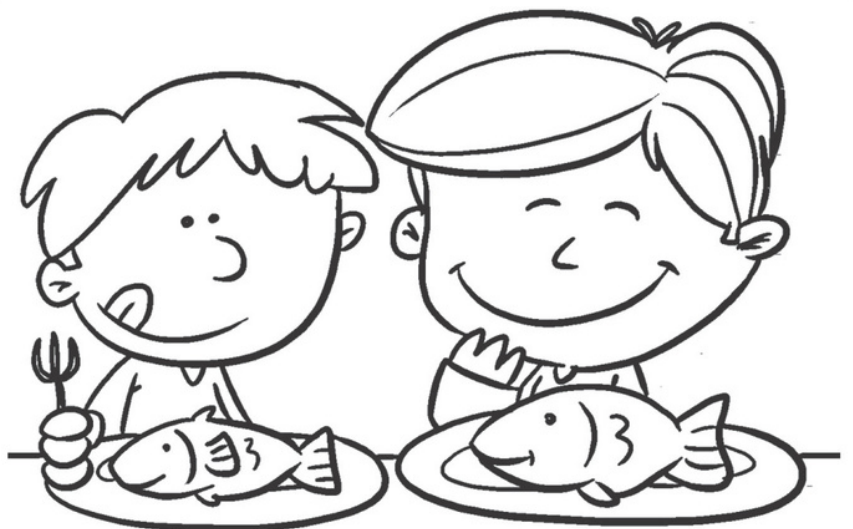
Sharing the Gospel
