RELIGION

LEVEL 2

STANDARD 1: CREED - Students will demonstrate understanding of core Catholic beliefs.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1. Identify that God reveals Himself to us in creation, in faith and through Jesus.
- 2. Reflect on the goodness of God's creation.
- 3. Build upon the ways that Jesus shows us God's love.
- 4. Explain that Jesus is our Savior, Friend, Brother and Teacher.
- 5. Retell that God sent the Holy Spirit to be with us and shows us how to live.
- 6. Identify the Church as the Body of Christ, the People of God.
- 7. Identify Mary as the mother of Jesus and our model of faith.

STANDARD 2: WORSHIP AND SACRAMENTS: - Students will demonstrate understanding and practice of Catholic worship and sacraments with an emphasis on the centrality of the Eucharist in the life of Catholics.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1. Worship God in word and action.
- 2. Understand the Sacrament of Baptism and being a child of God.
- 3. Understand the Sacrament of Reconciliation and God's forgiveness.
- 4. Understand the Sacrament of Eucharist as the Body and Blood of Jesus.
- 5. Understand and participate in the parts of the Mass.

STANDARD 3: MORALITY - Students will understand right from wrong and be able to make good moral choices in life decisions that are consistent with Church teachings and a Christian life style.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1. Understand they are children of God through words and actions.
- 2. Demonstrate an understanding of examination of conscience.
- 3. Explain the difference between a sin, an accident and a mistake.
- 4. Demonstrate how to express sorrow and forgiveness.
- 5. Explain what it means to love ones enemies.
- 6. Introduce and understand the Ten Commandments.
- 7. Understand the difference between original sin, venial sin, and mortal sin.

STANDARD 4: SOCIAL JUSTICE - Students will demonstrate understanding of Catholic social teaching and apply these principles to social and personal situations.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1. Demonstrate respect for all creation.
- 2. Demonstrate the dignity of the human person in work and play.
- 3. Explain their role as a member of a family.
- 4. Demonstrate and appreciate the diverse roles of members in a community.
- 5. Actively participate as members of a community.
- 6. Explain why some people live in poverty.
- 7. Respond to human tragedies.
- 8. Understand that God calls each of us to love one another and care for those who need help.

STANDARD 5: CORE SCRIPTURE - Students will read, interpret and apply Scripture to their own daily life situation.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1. Understand and retell stories of forgiveness: Prodigal Son, Good Shepherd, Lost sheep, etc.
- 2. Understand and retell: Feeding 5000, the Good Samaritan, Last Supper, Resurrection stories.
- 3. Continue to introduce and be familiar with Scripture verses.

STANDARD 6: FAMILY LIFE - Students will demonstrate their understanding of Christian family life and how it is nourished and passed on.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1. Know that God loves all families.
- 2. Understand that God gives everyone gifts to share and loves all people as they are.
- 3. Understand that as a person grows up, body, mind and feelings change.
- 4. Understand that all living things are gifts of God that should be cared for and that God wants all people to care for one another.
- 1. Can explain that a wedding is a time when a man and a woman make an important promise.
- 5. Understand that a baby is a gift of life from God.

STANDARD 7: LITURGICAL YEAR - Students will demonstrate their understanding of the Liturgical year and how it is celebrated.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1. Understand seasons of Advent and Christmas and how they are celebrated
- 2. Understand seasons of Lent, Holy Week and Easter and how they are celebrated.

3. Understand and celebrate ordinary time and colors, environment and liturgical vessels and vestments.

STANDARD 8: CHRISTIAN PRAYER AND PRACTICE - Students will be able to demonstrate, understand, use and identify traditional prayer forms in the Catholic tradition.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1. Refer to "Continuum of Prayers Taught" especially emphasizing the responses to the Mass.
- 2. Experience a variety of prayer forms including: silence, listening, song, gesture, spontaneous petitions and prayers of thanksgiving.

STANDARD 9: VOCABULARY - Students will be able to demonstrate understanding and use of religious vocabulary.

OBJECTIVES:

Refer to "Vocabulary to be Taught" and the Glossary.

STANDARD 10: VOCATION – LIFE STYLES - Students will demonstrate their understanding of different vocations and life styles to prepare them to respond to their own call.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1. Understand that God made each of us special.
- 2. Understand that each one is gifted with many talents.
- 3. Know and understand that there are people who reach out to help others. (mothers and fathers, priests, sisters, brothers, deacons, single adults and Catholic missionaries)

STANDARD 11: SERVICE - Students will engage in service to the community (family, parish, local, national, and global) by action and reflection on our response to the Gospel call.

OBJECTIVES

- 1. Understand their responsibility to help the members of their family.
- 2. Understand the importance of helping other students.
- 3. Understand that Jesus asks them to help others.
- 4. Actively participate in service projects in class, school, and community.

STANDARD 12: SAINTS - Students will explore the lives of the saints in order to expand their role models for Christian living.

- 1. Celebrate and understands feasts of Mary especially, Mother of God (1/1)
- 2. Celebrate and understands the feasts of Our Lord especially Christmas and Easter
- 3. Celebrate and understand the life and feast of canonized saints:
 - Patrick (3/17) Mary Magdalene (7/22) Lucy (12/13)

Michael (10/29) John the Baptist (6/24) John Bosco

 Celebrate and understand the life of modern day saints: Bishop of Salt Lake City Pastor of your parish

STANDARD 13: CHURCH HISTORY - Students will explore the development and history of the Roman Catholic Church.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1. Understand church leaders and structure of the Church from Jesus, Pope, Bishops, and priests/pastors.
- 2. Understand what the Church is and who founded it, Peter as first Pope, etc.
- 3. Introduce the Diocese the Bishop, pastor, and patroness, Mary Magdalene.

STANDARD 14: STEWARDSHIP – Students will demonstrate an understanding of Catholic stewardship and apply the knowledge by sharing their time, talent and treasure.

OBJECTIVES:

- Make children aware that all gifts come from God.
- Develop a spirit of gratitude of personal gifts.
- Demonstrate that diversity of gifts from God are not all given to one person but shared by the community.
- We need each other and all should be God's ministers in distributing graces and gifts received from God
- God's gifts must be taken care of
- Respect self as temples of the living God
