Because of the responsibilities of the Confirmation Sponsor, the Catholic Church has some minimum requirements it asks of all sponsors to fulfill in order to serve in this role. These are set forth in accordance with the Code of Canon law.

1. Religious Denomination: A sponsor must be a Roman Catholic because of the religious duties of sponsors.
2. Minimum Age: A sponsor must be 16 years of age by the date of Confirmation.
3. Sacraments of Initiation: A Sponsor is a Baptized Catholic who has received Confirmation and Holy Eucharist in the Catholic Church.
4. Freedom to Receive the Sacraments: The Sponsor is a practicing Catholic who is free to receive Holy Communion when he/she comes to Mass.
5. Marital Status: A Catholic Sponsor who is married must be in a marriage that is recognized by the Catholic Church.
6. Unmarried Status: If unmarried, a sponsor must be living a life consistent with a single person as defined by the Catholic Church. Anyone cohabitating with another person (i.e. living in a romantic relationship or as a couple) is ineligible to serve.
