Brothers and sisters in Christ,

Recently, many in our community have received a book in the mail titled *The Great Controversy*. While it claims to present the "true history" of Christianity, it tragically distorts both our Catholic faith and the story of the Church that Christ Himself founded.

As Catholics, we affirm with confidence that the Church was established by Jesus on the rock of Peter, guided by the Holy Spirit, and promised His abiding presence until the end of time. The Church's mission has always been to preserve the fullness of truth, to hand on Sacred Scripture and Sacred Tradition faithfully, and to lead souls to salvation through Christ.

The Great Controversy portrays the Catholic Church as a corrupt institution that turned away from the Gospel. This is not history — it is an attack and propaganda. While the Church, made up of human beings, has faced sin and struggle, she has never ceased to be the Body of Christ, safeguarded by His Spirit. Our saints, our councils, our liturgy, and our unbroken witness to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist stand as testimony to God's enduring faithfulness.

We must not respond with anger, but with charity and truth. We pray for unity among all Christians, that together we may seek the fullness of Christ's truth and love. Let us remember that our faith is not built on controversy or accusation—but on the living Word of God, on grace, and on the peace that only Christ can give.
