Programs without Academic Credit: Letter of Completion Programs (LOC) are Non-Credit Participation (P/F) programs. All requirements of the program and the individual courses must be satisfied to receive a letter of completion. Students must complete each course in the program with a passing score (70%).

Continuing Education: The final option is to enroll as a Continuing Education (CE) student. Select your academic level:

Audit Continuing Education: Audit students are invited to attend lectures and participate as much as they may like. There are no course requirements for these students.

Spiritual Direction CE P/F Option: Students who are considering applying for the Spiritual Direction Letter of Completion Programs (LOC) program and want to take *The Art of Accompaniment* before deciding should register as a CE P/F student. This option requires full participation in the course and the completion of all course requirements. To enter the Spiritual Direction Letter of Completion Program, students must complete the course in the program with a passing score (70%). This option is available for the following courses only: *The Art of Accompaniment* and SD2: *Directing Prayer*.

For-Credit Continuing Education: This option is for students who are seeking transferable academic credits or who want to take courses for credit before applying to a Program for Academic Credit.
