Secretary's report given: M/S/A

Treasurer report per Debby Kurz: Starting balance=\$12,289.65. Income included monies from coffee, soup suppers and flower fund totalling \$841.00. Expenses were to Rosanne Gregory to reimburse for lemonade and Tabaka's for honey totalling \$51.14. Ending balance=\$13,079.51. M/S/A.

Deb Stock gave the following report: the updated security system to include hard wired fire alarms that will have direct hook up to the 911 system. Kitchen alarms will also be fitted with heat sensors. There will be sensors for water leaks and problems with the furnaces. We (finance committee) are exploring options for a possible new rectory here on church property.

The church cemetery will be getting a new sign per request of the family of the child buried there.

Events at St. Pauls include a funeral on the 17th and confirmation on the 18th.

Parishioner Carol Hartnick is having a cardiac procedure done at Mayo Clinic; a Mass has been said for her benefit.

Flowers: MaryEllen reported she purchased 2 large palms for Easter. Total donations for flowers for Easter=\$383, total cost was \$680+. Accessories=\$790.40 (fabrics and cross). Balance=\$407.40 She will be ordering a new May crown for Mary.
