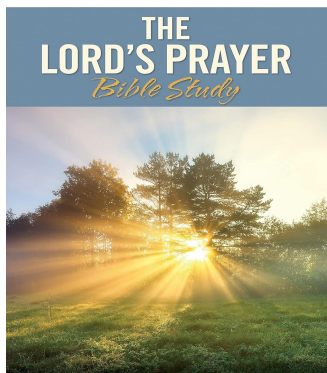


Blanket Raffle!
