### **Jesus, I trust in You**

This past Sunday was Divine Mercy Sunday. Divine Mercy is a devotion that was requested by Jesus himself to the Polish nun, St. Faustina Kowalska, who received many visions of Him. Jesus appeared to St. Faustina with one hand raised in blessing, and with two rays, a red ray and a pale ray, shining from under his garment. Jesus told St. Faustina the meaning of the rays:

“The rays represent the Blood and Water which gushed forth from the depths of my Mercy when My agonising Heart was pierced on the cross. The pale rays symbolise the water, which cleanses and purifies the soul; the red rays represent the blood, which gives new life to the soul.”
