Reflection from Theology Club

On the Fifth Sunday of Easter, Jesus tells us "Do not let your hearts be troubled. Believe in God, believe also in me." We often tend to overly worry about so many unnecessary things; school, marks, what people think about us, how we can fit in, whether our friends have the same opinion as us, and so on. These worries trouble us and bog us down. They make us question ourselves, and pressure us to conform to what everyone else does, or at least not oppose what they do, even if it is wrong. Our Lord provides us with the answer, as He so often does. Belief in God can free us from unnecessary worry, because through our belief, we recognize that these things we worry about are nothing to trouble our hearts about, for they do not change the fact that the Father loves us, and that Jesus has prepared a place for us. Belief in God helps us to know the way to the place where Jesus is going. This can seem preposterous, because Jesus has not told us where he is going. As Thomas said, "Lord, we do not know where you are going. How can we know the way?" Again, Jesus provides us with the answer. "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. If you know me, you will know my Father also. From now on you do know him and have seen him." Let us all learn to trust in Him.

Lord Jesus, you are the way, the truth, and the life. Help us to seek you always, and bring us to the place you have prepared for us. Help us to love you, and to bring you to other people, that they might know the way as well. Amen.
