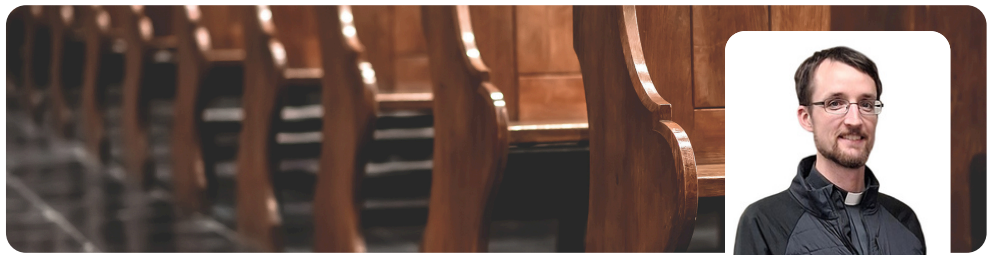
BULLETIN CONTENT

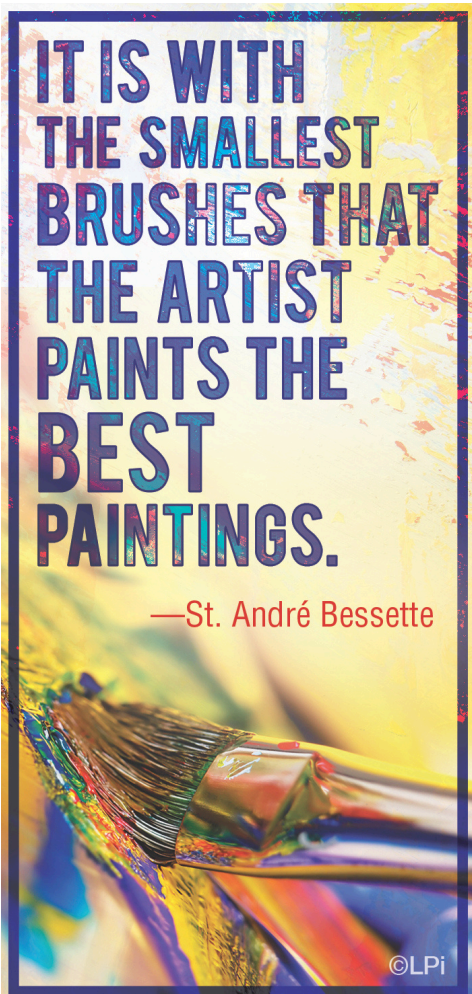
Mark your calendar for February 21 and March 21. We will be having a light meal after the 4:00 Mass on those dates. More to come on the menu for those dates.

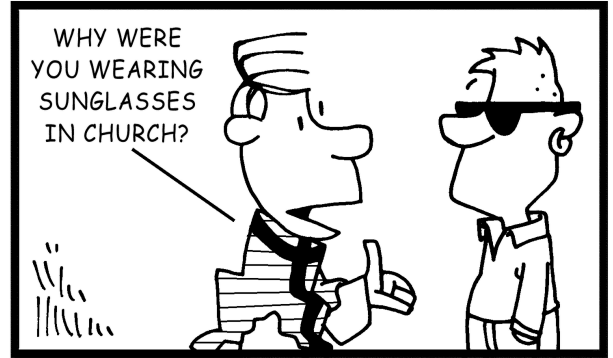
Christmas Flowers & Decor

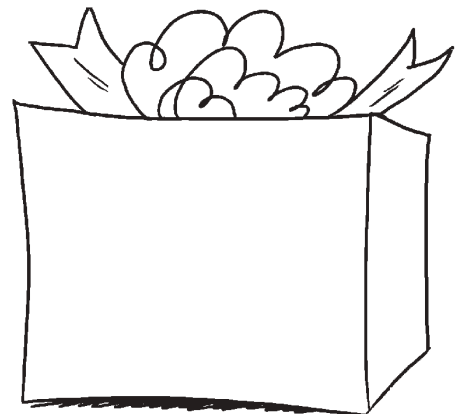
