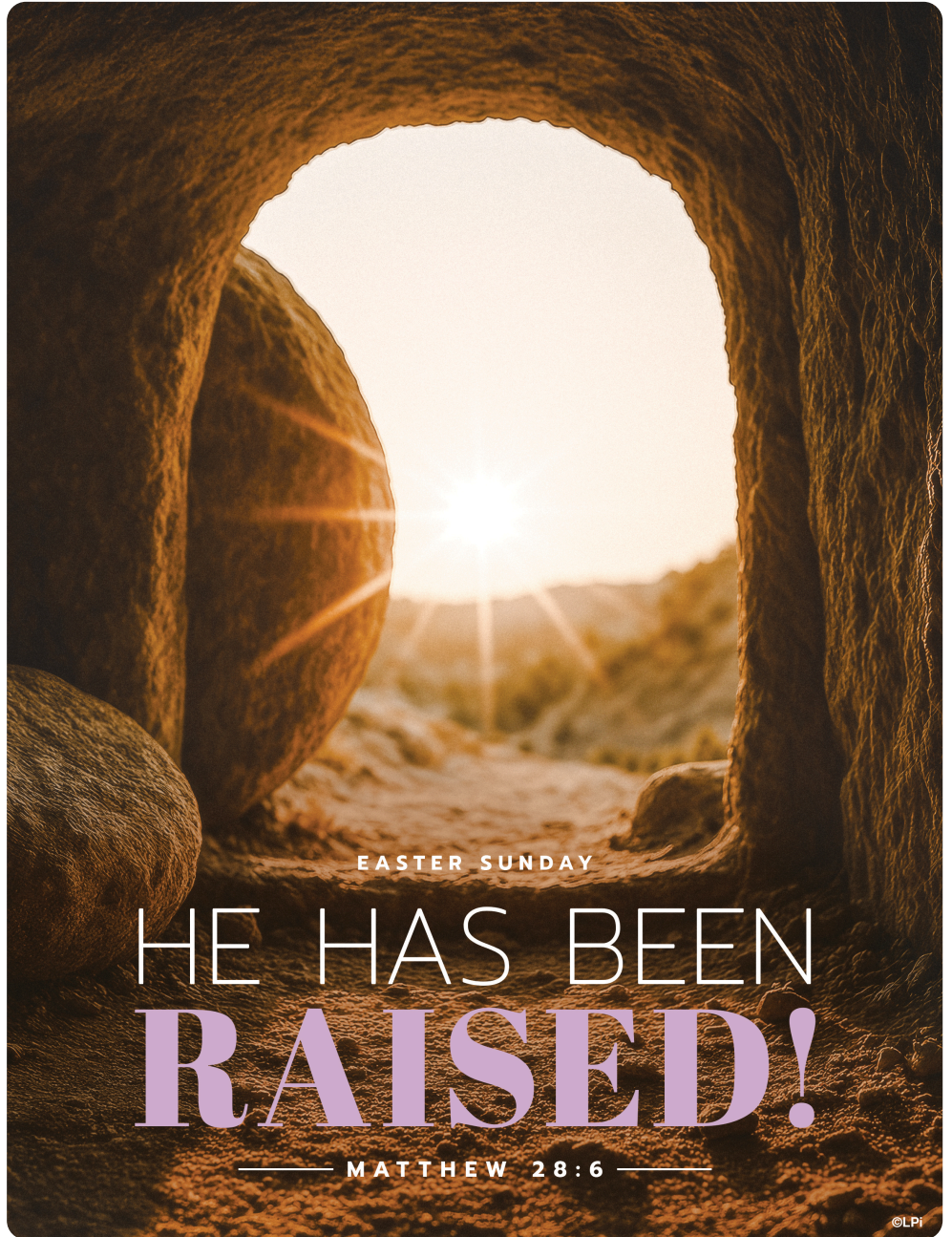

Information from a letter from the Archbishop on March 17th. Read the full letter in last weekend's bulletin: After months of prayer and collaboration, a new pastorate plan has been finalized to support strong parish life and pastoral care. The plan includes consistent weekend Mass schedules (no more rotations) and guidelines to help priests balance their responsibilities. Final pastorate structures and priest assignments will be announced April 11, with more details shared by local pastors that weekend. The Archbishop acknowledged that change can bring questions but emphasized that the process has been guided by prayer and a commitment to keeping parishes strong for the future.



Dear Trinity Cluster family, Happy Easter!

I pray this message finds you well in the grace of Christ's Resurrection from the dead. May you and your family be filled where it is needed most in your lives with all the heavenly riches of Christ's triumph over the grave.

Christ is alive and dies no more. He has passed over from death to life. In our lives, we make such a passage through, with, and in Christ too.
